BERROCO VINTAGE CHUNKY

(100 grs): 9 (11, 12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18) hanks #6185 Tide Pool (MC) and 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4) hanks #6167 Dewberry (CC)

NEEDLES and NOTIONS

29" length circular needle, size 10 (6.00 mm) *or size to obtain gauge* Tapestry needle 3 stitch holders Four 1½" buttons

GAUGE

14 sts and 21 rows = 4" in St st To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

BACK

Lower Section: Using CC, cast on 70 (77, 84, 91, 98, 105, 113, 119) sts. Work even in St st for 3½", end on WS. Change to MC and work 3 rows, end on RS. Knit 1 row on WS for turning ridge. Work even in St st until piece measures 17 (17, 17½, 17½, 18, 18, 18, 18)" from beginning, end on WS. Dec Row (RS): [K3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 6), k2tog] 8 (7, 7, 7, 6, 7, 13, 7) times, then [k4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7), k2tog] 5 (7, 6, 7, 7, 7, 1, 7) times—57 (63, 71, 77, 85, 91, 99, 105) sts. Purl 1 row. Bind off.

Upper Section: With RS facing, using MC, pick up and knit 57 (63, 71, 77, 85, 91, 99, 105) sts across bound-off edge of lower section. Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st for 1", end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 3" once more—53 (59, 67, 73, 81, 87, 95, 101) sts. Work even until piece measures 6" from picked-up stitches, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1R, k to last st, M1L, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Inc Row every 3" once more—57 (63, 71, 77, 85, 91, 99, 105) sts. Work even until piece measures 10" from picked-up sts, end on WS.

Shape Armholes: Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5, 7, 8) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then 0 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—53 (53, 61, 65, 73, 77, 81, 85) sts. Dec 1 st each side every RS row 2 (2, 4, 4, 7, 7, 7, 7) times—49 (49, 53, 57, 59, 63, 67, 71) sts. Work even until armholes measure 7½ (8, 8, 8½, 8½, 9, 9½, 10)", end on WS. Shape Shoulders: Bind off 3 (3, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12, 14) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, end on WS. Slip remaining 43 sts to holder.

LEFT FRONT

Lower Section: Using CC, cast on 31 (34, 38, 41, 45, 48, 52, 55) sts. Work even in St st for 3½", end on WS. Change to MC and work 3 rows, end on RS. Knit 1 row on WS for turning ridge. Work even in St st until piece measures 17 (17, 17½, 17½, 18, 18, 18, 18)" from beginning, end on WS. Dec Row (RS): [K3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 6, 6, 7), k2tog] 5 (2, 4, 1, 3, 6, 2, 5) time(s), then [k4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 0, 7, 8), k2tog] 1 (4, 2, 5, 3, 0, 4,



1) time(s)—25 (28, 32, 35, 39, 42, 46, 49) sts. Purl 1 row. Bind off.

Upper Section: With RS facing, using MC, pick up and knit 25 (28, 32, 35, 39, 42, 46, 49) sts across bound-off edge of lower section. Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st until piece measures 1" from picked-up sts, end on WS. **Dec Row (RS):** K1, k2tog, knit to end—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 3" once more—23 (26, 30, 33, 37, 40, 44, 47) sts.

Work even until piece measures 6" from picked-up sts, end

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1R, knit to end—1 st inc'd. Rep Inc Row every 3" once more—25 (28, 32, 35, 39, 42, 46, 49) sts. Work even until piece measures 10" above picked-up sts, end on WS.

Shape Armhole: Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5, 7, 8) sts at beginning of the next RS row, then 0 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) sts at beginning of the next RS row—23 (23, 27, 29, 33, 35, 37, 39) sts. Dec 1 st at armhole edge every RS row 2 (2, 4, 4, 7, 7, 7, 7) times—21 (21, 23, 25, 26, 28, 30, 32) sts. Work even until armhole measures 7½ (8, 8, 8½, 8½, 9, 9½, 10)", end on WS. Shape Shoulder: Bind off 3 (3, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12, 14) sts at beginning of the next row—18 sts. Purl 1 row. SI remaining 18 sts to holder.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front until upper section measures 1" from picked-up stitches, end on WS—25 (28, 32, 35, 39, 42, 46, 49) sts.

Dec Row (RS): Knit to the last 3 sts, SSK, k1—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 3" once more—23 (26, 30, 33, 37, 40, 44, 47) sts. Work even until piece measures 6" from picked-up sts, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): Knit to the last stitch, M1L, k1—1 st inc'd. Rep Inc Row every 3" once more—25 (28, 32, 35, 39, 42, 46, 49) sts. Work even until piece measures 10" above picked-up sts, end on RS.

Shape Armhole: Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5, 7, 8) sts at beginning of the next WS row, then 0 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) sts at beginning of the next WS row—23 (23, 27, 29, 33, 35, 37, 39) sts. Dec 1 st at armhole edge every RS row 2 (2, 4, 4, 7, 7, 7, 7) times—21 (21, 23, 25, 26, 28, 30, 32) sts. Work even until armhole measures 7½ (8, 8, 8½, 8½, 9, 9½, 10)", end on RS. Shape Shoulder: Bind off 3 (3, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12, 14) sts at beginning of the next row—18 sts. Purl 1 row. SI remaining 18 sts to holder.

SLEEVES

Using CC, cast on 35 sts. Work even in St st for 2½", end on WS. Change to MC and work 3 rows, end on RS. Knit 1

row on WS for turning ridge. Work even in St st until sleeve measures 6" from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1R, knit to last stitch, M1L, k1—1 st inc'd. Rep Inc Row every 24th (24th, 18th, 12th, 8th, 8th, 6th, 4th) row 3 (3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 11, 13) times more—43 (43, 45, 49, 53, 55, 59, 63) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 18" from turning ridge, end on WS.

Shape Cap: Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5, 7, 8) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then 2 sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—33 (33, 35, 37, 41, 41, 41, 43) sts. Dec 1 st each side every 4th row 1 (1, 0, 0, 0, 0, 2, 2) time(s), every RS row 7 (9, 11, 12, 10, 12, 10, 10) times, then EVERY row 4 (0, 0, 0, 4, 0, 0, 0) times, end on WS—9 (13, 13, 13, 17, 17, 19) sts. Bind off 2 sts at beg of the next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 5 (9, 9, 9, 9, 13, 13, 15) sts.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Neckband: With RS facing, using MC, join yarn at right front edge, knit 18 sts from right front holder, 43 sts from back holder, then 18 sts from left front holder—79 sts. Purl 1 row. **Dec Row 1(RS):** K7, * k2tog, k7; rep from * across—71 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Dec Row 2 (RS): K7, * k2tog, k6; rep from * across—63 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Dec Row 3 (RS): K7, * k2tog, k5; rep from * across—55 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Dec Row 4 (RS): K7, * k2tog, k4; rep from * across—47 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, end on RS. Knit 1 row on WS for turning ridge. Knit 1 row, purl 1 row, knit 1 row. Change to CC and purl 1 row, end on WS.

Inc Row 1 (RS): K7, * M1, k5; rep from * across—55 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Inc Row 2 (RS): K7, * M1, k6; rep from * across—63 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Inc Row 3 (RS): K7, * M1, k7; rep from * across—71 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.


Inc Row 4 (RS): K7, * M1, k8; rep from * across—79 sts. Bind off purlwise on WS.

Left Front band: With RS facing, using circular needle and MC, begin at turning ridge on left edge of collar, pick up and knit 125 (127, 129, 131, 133, 135, 137, 139) sts along left front edge to turning ridge at lower edge. Knit 17 rows. Bind off.

Right Front band: Beginning at turning ridge at lower edge, work to correspond to left front band until 7 knit rows have been completed, end on WS.

Buttonhole Row (RS): K49 (51, 53, 55, 57, 59, 61, 63), bind off 2 sts, * k21, bind off 2 sts; rep from * twice more, knit to end.

Next Row: Knit, cast on 2 sts over each pair of stitches bound off on previous row. Complete to correspond to left front band. Fold neckband in half to WS along turning ridge and sew in place. Sew on sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Fold lower edge of sleeves to WS along turning ridge and sew in place. Fold lower edge of back and fronts to WS along turning ridge and sew in place. With tapestry needle and CC, work running stitch along top edge of hem on lower edge and sleeves and along lower edge of hem on neckband as in photo. Sew on buttons. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s) p2tog: purl 2 stitches together p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

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
