Bust: (28, 30, 32, 36) [40, 44, 48, 52] {56, 60, 64, 68}" / (71, 76, 81, 91.5) [101.5, 112, 119, 134.5] {143.5, 152.5, 167, 174.5} cm Length: (22, 22, 22½, 23) [23½, 24, 24, 24½] {24½, 25, 25, 25½}" / (56, 56, 57, 58.5) [59.5, 61, 61, 62] {62, 63.5, 63.5, 65} cm Shown in girl's size Large (28" / 71 cm). Recommended ease: 2-4" /5-10 cm positive ease.

#### YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 grs): (3, 3, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {7, 8, 8, 9} hanks #5103 Mocha (MC) and (1, 1, 2, 2) [2, 2, 2, 2] {2, 2, 2, 2} hanks #5187 Dungaree (CC)

**NEEDLES and NOTIONS** Knitting needles, size 8 / 5 mm or size to obtain gauge 24" / 60 cm circular needle, size 8 / 5 mm Three ½" buttons

## **GAUGE**

18 sts and 24 rows = 4'' / 10 cm in

#### STRIPE SEQUENCE

\* Working in St st, work 2 rows MC, 2 rows CC; rep from \* for Stripe Sequence.

#### **BACK BODICE**

Using MC, cast on (64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 108, 118] {126, 136, 144, 154} sts. Work even in St st following Stripe Sequence for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS.

Shape Armholes: Bind off (3, 4, 4, 6) [6, 7, 8, 9] {9, 10, 10, 11} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—(58, 60, 64, 70) [78, 86, 92, 100] {108, 116, 124, 132} sts. Dec 1 st each side every RS row (4, 5, 5, 8) [10, 11, 12, 13] {15, 17, 19, 20} times—(50, 50, 54, 54) [58, 64, 68, 74] {78, 82, 86, 92} sts. Work even until armholes measure (6½, 6½, 7, 7½) [8, 8½, 8½, 9] {9, 9½, 9½, 10}" / (16.5, 16.5, 18, 19) [20.5, 21.5, 21.5, 23] {23, 24, 24, 25.5} cm, end on WS.

**Shape Shoulders:** Bind off (3, 3, 5, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {9, 9, 9, 10} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then (4, 4, 4, 4) [5, 6, 7, 8] {8, 9, 10, 11} sts at beginning of the next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 28 sts for back neck.

#### LOWER BACK

With RS facing, using MC, pick up and knit (64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 108, 118] {126, 136, 144, 154} sts along cast-on edge of back bodice. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row, end on WS.

**Eyelet Row (RS):** K1, \* k2tog, yo, rep from \* to last stitch, end k1. Purl 1 row. [Knit 1 row, purl 1 row] twice, end on WS.

Joining Row (RS): Fold piece in half at eyelet row with WS together, forming picots. \* Insert point of RH needle through first stitch on LH needle, then under first stitch in row directly above picked-up stitches, yo and pull up a loop, drawing loop through first stitch on LH needle; rep from \* until all stitches on LH needle have been worked— (64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 108, 118] {126, 136, 144, 154} sts. Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st until piece measures 12½" / 32 cm from picked-up sts, end on WS. Knit 4 rows. Bind off.



#### LEFT FRONT BODICE

Using MC, cast on (30, 32, 34, 39) [43, 48, 52, 57] {61, 66, 70, 75} sts. Work even in St st following Stripe Sequence for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS.

Shape Armhole: Bind off (3, 4, 4, 6) [6, 7, 8, 9] {9, 10, 10, 11} sts at beginning of the next row—(27, 28, 30, 33) [37, 41, 44, 48] {52, 56, 60, 64} sts. Dec 1 st at beginning of every RS row (4, 5, 5, 8) [10, 11, 12, 13] {15, 17, 19, 20} times—(23, 23, 25, 25) [27, 30, 32, 35] {37, 39, 41, 44} sts. Work even until armhole measures (4, 4, 4½, 5) [5½, 6, 6, 6½] {6½, 7, 7, 7½}" / (10, 10, 11.5, 12.5) [14, 15, 15, 16.5] {16.5, 18, 18, 19} cm, end on RS.

**Shape Neck:** Bind off 5 sts at neck edge, then dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 7 times. Work even on (11, 11, 13, 13) [15, 18, 20, 23] {25, 27, 29, 32} sts until armhole measures (6½, 6½, 7, 7½) [8, 8½, 8½, 9] {9, 9½, 9½, 10}" / (16.5, 16.5, 18, 19) [20.5, 21.5, 21.5, 23] {23, 24, 24, 25.5} cm, end on WS. Bind off (3, 3, 5, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {9, 9, 9, 10} sts at armhole edge once, then (4, 4, 4, 4) [5, 6, 7, 8] {8, 9, 10, 11} sts twice for shoulder.

**Left Front Band:** With RS facing, using CC, pick up and knit (18, 18, 20, 22) [24, 26, 26, 28] {28, 32, 32, 34} sts along front edge of left front bodice. Work even in Garter St for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS. Bind off.

#### RIGHT FRONT BODICE

Work as for left front bodice until piece measures 1" / 2.5 cm from beginning, end on RS.

Shape Armhole: Bind off (3, 4, 4, 6) [6, 7, 8, 9] {9, 10, 10, 11} sts at beginning of the next row—(27, 28, 30, 33) [37, 41, 44, 48] {52, 56, 60, 64} sts. Dec 1 st at end of every RS row (4, 5, 5, 8) [10, 11, 12, 13] {15, 17, 19, 20} times—(23, 23, 25, 25) [27, 30, 32, 35] {37, 39, 41, 44} sts. Work even until armhole measures (4, 4, 4½, 5) [5½, 6, 6, 6½] {6½, 7, 7, 7½}" / (10, 10, 11.5, 12.5) [14, 15, 15, 16.5] {16.5, 18, 18, 19} cm, end on WS. Shape Neck: Bind off 5 sts at neck edge, then dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 7 times. Work even on (11, 11, 13, 13) [15, 18, 20, 23] {25, 27, 29, 32} sts until armhole measures (6½, 6½, 7, 7½) [8, 8½, 8½, 9] {9, 9½, 9½, 10}" / (16.5, 16.5, 18, 19) [20.5, 21.5, 21.5, 23] {23, 24, 24, 25.5} cm, end on RS. Bind off (3, 3, 5, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {9, 9, 9, 10} sts at armhole edge once, then (4, 4, 4, 4) [5, 6, 7, 8] {8, 9, 10, 11} sts twice for shoulder.

**Right Front Band:** With RS facing, using straight needles and CC, begin at lower edge of right front bodice, pick up and knit (18, 18, 20, 22) [24, 26, 26, 28] {28, 32, 32, 34} sts along front edge of right front bodice. Knit 1 row, end on WS.

**Buttonhole Row (RS):** K2, k2tog, yo, \* knit (4, 4, 5, 6) [7, 8, 8, 9] {9, 11, 11, 11}, k2tog, yo; rep from \* once more, knit to end. Complete as for left front band.

#### LOWER FRONT

Lap right front band over left front band and pin in place. With RS facing, using straight needles and MC, pick up and knit (64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 108, 118] {126, 136, 144, 154} sts across lower edge of front bodices, picking up sts along lower edge of right front band and leaving left front band free. Work as for lower back until Joining Row has been completed and all sts on LH needle have been worked— (64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 108, 118] {126, 136, 144, 154} sts. Purl 1 row.

Inc Row (RS): Knit (14, 16, 18, 23) [27, 32, 36, 41] {45, 50, 54, 59}, [M1, k1] 36 times, knit (14, 16, 18, 23) [27, 32, 36, 41] {45, 50, 54, 59}—(100, 104, 108, 118) [126, 136, 144, 154] {162, 172, 180, 190} sts.

Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st until piece measures 12½" / 32 cm from picked-up sts, end on WS. Knit 4 rows. Bind off.

#### **SLEEVES**

Using CC, cast on (28, 28, 32, 32) [32, 32, 36, 36] {36, 36, 40, 40} sts. Knit 4 rows. Change to MC and work even in Garter St (instead of St st), following Stripe Sequence until sleeve measures 4" / 10 cm from beginning, end on WS.




Shape Cap: Bind off (3, 4, 4, 6) [6, 7, 8, 9] {9, 10, 10, 11} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—(40, 38, 42, 42) [46, 50, 52, 54] {58, 60, 66, 68} sts. Dec 1 st each side every 4th row (0, 0, 2, 4) [5, 5, 4, 5] {3, 4, 1, 1} time(s), then every RS row (11, 11, 11, 7) [5, 5, 7, 7] {11, 9, 15, 16} times, end on WS—(18, 16, 16, 20) [26, 30, 30, 30] {30, 34, 34, 34} sts. Bind off (3, 2, 0, 0) [0, 0, sts at beginning of the next 2 rows. Bind off remaining (12, 12, 16, 20) [24, 30, 30, 30] {30, 34, 34, 34} sts.


#### **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder seams. Sew lower edge of left front band in place.

**Neckband:** With RS facing, using circular needle and CC, begin at left neck edge, pick up and knit 22 sts along right front neck edge, 27 sts across back neck edge, then 22 sts along left front neck edge—71 sts. Work even in Garter St for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS. Bind off. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

C (Shoulder Width): (2½, 2½, 3, 3) [3¼, 4, 4½, 5] {5½, 6, 6½, 7}" / (6, 6, 7.5, 7.5) [8.5, 10, 11.5, 12.5] {14, 15, 16.5, 18} cm

D (Length to Underarms): 14½" / 37 cm

E (Armhole Length): (6½, 6½, 7, 7½) [8, 8½, 8½, 9] {9, 9½, 9½, 10}" / (16.5, 16.5, 18, 19) [20.5, 21.5, 21.5, 23] {23, 24, 24, 25.5} cm

F (Front Neck Depth): 3½" / 9 cm

beg: beginning **CC**: contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to

k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needle dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row. end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase k: knit

**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s) k2tog: knit 2 stitches together k3tog: knit 3 stitches together

**kfb:** knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s) p2tog: purl 2 stitches together p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when

working in the round.

RH: right hand

**RLI:** Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together. **SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

**St st:** Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round

**tbl**: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over















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
