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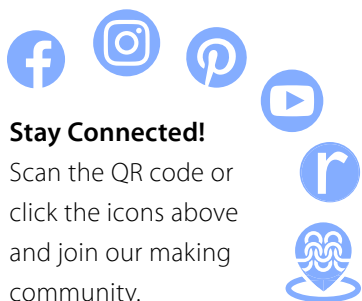

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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 4½" / 11.5 cm wide x 36" / 91.5 cm long

YARN

BERROCO IRIS (100 g): 1 hank #11603 Turmeric

NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7 / 4.5 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

GAUGE

20 sts and 22 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern Stitch

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

INSTRUCTIONS

Increase Section:

Cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p1, sl 1 wyif.

Row 3: Kfb, k1, kfb. 5 sts.

Row 4: Sl 1 wyif, p3, sl 1 wyif.

Row 5: Kfb, k1, yo, SSK, kfb. 7 sts.

Row 6: Sl 1 wyif, p2, k1, p2, sl 1 wyif.

Row 7: Kfb, k2, p1, k2, kfb. 9 sts.

Row 8: Sl 1 wyif, p3, k1, p3, sl 1 wyif.

Row 9: Kfb, k7, kfb. 11 sts.

Row 10: Sl 1 wyif, p9, sl 1 wyif.

Row 11: K4, yo, k3, yo, k4. 13 sts.

Row 12: Sl 1 wyif, [p3, k1] twice, p3, sl 1 wyif.

Row 13: Kfb, [k3, p1] twice, k3, kfb. 15 sts.

Row 14: Sl 1 wyif, p4, k1, p3, k1, p4, sl 1 wyif.

Row 15: Kfb, k13, kfb. 17 sts.

Row 16: Sl 1 wyif p15, sl 1 wyif.

Row 17: K3, yo, k5, yo, SSK, k4, yo, k3. 19 sts.

Row 18: Sl 1 wyif, p2, [k1, p5] twice, k1, p2, sl 1 wyif wyif.

Row 19: Kfb, k2, [p1, k5] twice, p1, k2, kfb. 21 sts.

Row 20: Sl 1 wyif, p3, [k1, p5] twice, k1, p3, sl 1 wyif.

Row 21: Kfb, knit to last st, kfb. 23 sts.

Row 22: Sl 1 wyif wyif, purl to last st, sl 1 wyif.

Row 23: K3, yo, k5, [yo, SSK, k4] twice, yo, k3. 25 sts.

Row 24: Sl 1 wyif wyif, p2, k1, [p5, k1] three times, p2, sl 1 wyif.

Row 25: K3, p1, [k5, p1] three times, k3.

Row 26: Rep Row 24.

Establish Pattern Stitch:

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Sl 1 wyif, purl to last st, sl 1 wyif.

Row 3: K6, [yo, SSK, k4] 3 times, k1.

Row 4: Sl 1 wyif, [p5, k1] 3 times, p5, sl 1 wyif.

Row 5: K6, [p1, k5] 3 times, k1.

Row 6: Rep Row 4.

Row 7: Rep Row 1.

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Row 9: K3, [yo, SSK, k4] 3 times, yo, SSK, k2.

Row 10: Sl 1 wyif, p2, [k1, p5] 3 times, k1, p2, sl 1 wyif.

Row 11: K3, [p1, k5] 3 times, p1, k3.

Row 12: Rep Row 10.

Rep rows 1–12 ten times more (eleven times total), then rep Rows 1–11 of pattern once more, end after completing a RS row. 25 sts.

Decrease Section:

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, [k1, p5] 3 times, k1, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 23 sts.

Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Row 3: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 21 sts.

Row 4: [K4, yo, SSK] 3 times, k3.

Row 5: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, p1, [k1, p5] twice, k1, p1, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 19 sts.

Row 6: K3, [p1, k5] twice, p1, k3.

Row 7: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, [k1, p5] twice, k1, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 17 ts.

Row 8: Knit.

Row 9: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 15 sts.

Row 10: K5, yo, SSK, k2, yo, SSK, k4.

Row 11: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, p2, k1, p3, k1, p2, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 13 sts.

Row 12: K4, p1, k3, p1, k4.

Row 13: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 11 sts.

Row 14: Knit.

Row 15: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 9 sts.

Row 16: K4, yo, SSK, k3.

Row 17: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, p1, k1, p1, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 7 sts.

Row 18: K3, p1, k3.

Row 19: Sl 1 wyif, p2tog, k1, SSP, sl 1 wyif. 5 sts.

Row 20: Knit.

Row 21: P2tog, k1, SSP. 3 sts.

Row 22: Sl 1 wyif, k1, sl 1 wyif.

Row 23: Purl.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



ROSEATE CHART

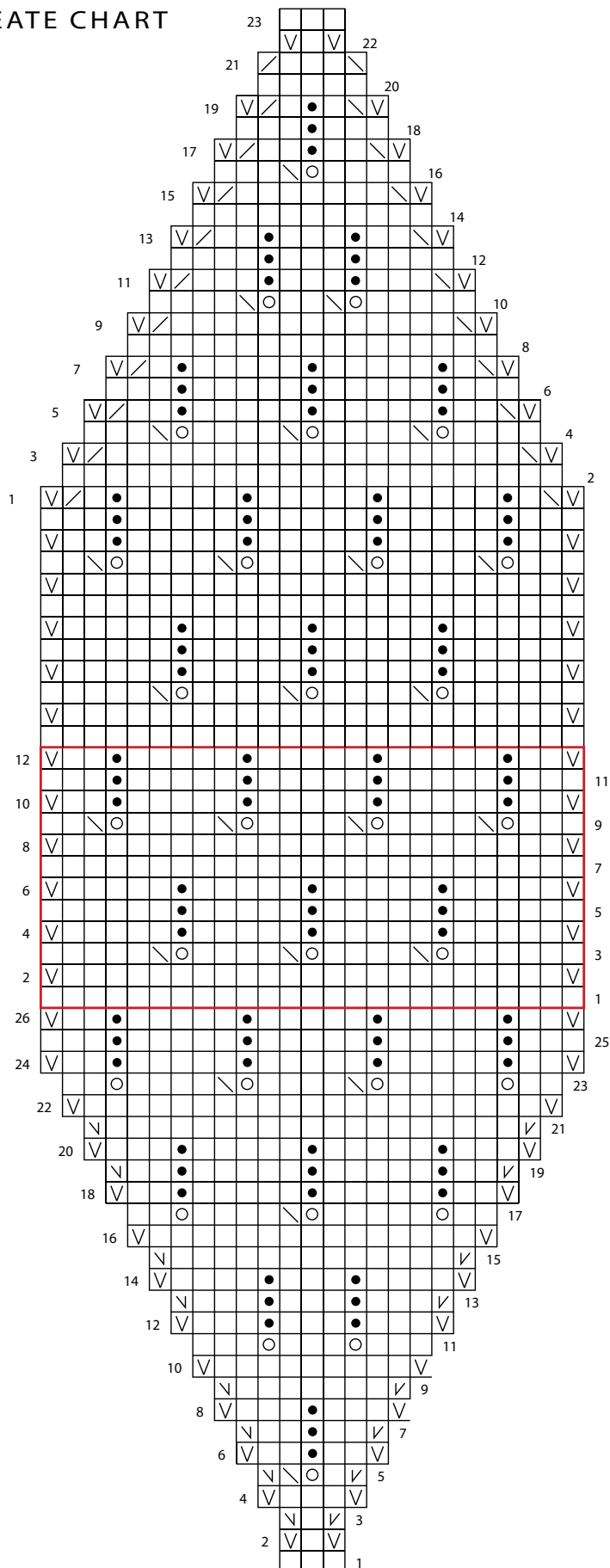


CHART NOTES

Work from right to left on RS rows
and from left to right on WS rows.

KEY TO CHART

pattern repeat

knit on RS; purl on WS
knit

• purl on RS; knit on WS
purl

∨ RS: slip as if to purl, with yarn in back
WS: slip as if to purl, with yarn in front

∕ kfb

∕ k2tog on RS; p2tog on WS

∖ SSK on RS; SSP on WS

○ yarn over

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

dec: decrease

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

inc: increase

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

p: purl

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s)

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sl: slip

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over
