FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Approximately 20" / 51 cm wide x 11" / 28 cm high (not including strap)

YARN

BERROCO ULTRA WOOL DK

(100 grs): 1 ball each #8301 Cream (C1) and #8329 Butternut (C2) and 2 balls #8311 Dove (C3)

HOOKS and NOTIONS Size 7 (US) / 4.5 mm crochet hook or size to obtain gauge Size J / 7 mm crochet hook

GAUGE

15 hdc and 12 rows = 4'' / 10 cm in hdc using smaller hook Gauge shown is after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

Back and front panels are worked separately from bottom to top. Overlaid chain accents are then added. Top border is added, then side panels are crocheted on.

FRONT AND BACK PANELS (Make 2)

Using smaller hook and C1, ch 59.

Set-Up Row: Dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc), dc in next ch, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in each of the next 5 ch; rep from * 5 times more, ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in each of the last 3 dc—43 dc and 14 ch-1 sp. Turn.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each of the next 2 dc, * ch 1, skip ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip ch-1 sp, dc in each of the next 5 dc; rep from * 5 times more, ch 1, skip ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip ch-1 sp, dc in each of the last 3 dc. Turn.

Row 2: Rep Row 1.

Row 3: Using C2, rep Row 1.

Row 4: Using C3, rep Row 1.

Rows 5 and 6: Using C1, rep Row 1.

Repeat Rows 3–6 four times more, then repeat Rows 5 and 6 once more. Fasten off.

Overlaid Chain Accents: Cut 14 strands each 170" / 430 cm long of C2 and C3. You will be working your chain vertically from the bottom of the panel to the top.





Chain 1: Using larger hook and with 2 strands of C3 held together, holding yarn in the back of the work, join yarn to foundation ch of panel under the first ch sp. Insert hook from RS to WS of work in first ch sp and ch 1, lengthen loop on hook to match the next row. Insert hook from RS to WS in ch sp on next row, ch 1, lengthen loop on hook to match the next row. Work in this manner to top of panel and fasten off.

Chain 2: Work as for Chain 1, using C2 instead of C3. Repeat chains 1 and 2 across the work, filling in all chainspaces on both back and front panels.

Top Border: Rejoin C2 in first st top of panel.

Row 1: Using smaller hook, ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Repeat Row 2 twice more. Fasten off. Mark center of foundation chain on both back and front panels.

FINISHING

Align side panel with back and front panels so that the center seam of the side panel is at the marker on bottom of the front and back panels. With right sides facing out, start at the upper right corner of side panel. Using smaller hook and C3, work in sc through both thicknesses of panels to attach side panel to back panel, then to front panel. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

SIDE PANEL / STRAP

With smaller hook, using C3, ch 17.

Side Panel: Set Up Row: Hdc in 3rd chain from hook (counts as 2 hdc), hdc in each ch across. Turn.

Row 1: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc and in each hdc across—16 hdc. Turn.

Repeat Row 1 until piece, slightly stretched, reaches from marker on foundation ch to top of top border. Place a marker on last st worked for beginning of strap.

Strap: Row 1—Dec Row: Ch 2, hdc2tog, hdc in each hdc to last 2 hdc, hdc2tog—14 hdc. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc and in each hdc across. Turn. Row 3—Dec Row: Ch 2, hdc2tog, hdc in each hdc to last 2 st, hdc2tog—12 sts. Turn.

Mark end of last row.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc and in each hdc across. Turn. Repeat Row 4 until piece measures 30" / 78 cm from marker. Inc Row 1: Ch 2, hdc in same hdc, hdc in next hdc and in

each hdc across to last hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc—14 sts. Turn. Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc and in each hdc across. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in same hdc, hdc in next hdc and in each

hdc across to last hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc—16 sts. Turn. Place a marker on last st worked for end of strap.

Side Panel: Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc and in each hdc across. Turn.

Repeat Row 4 until this side panel section, slightly stretched, reaches from top border to marker on foundation chain of back or front panel. Join to foundation chain of side panel using slip st, being careful not to twist piece.

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.
