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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Scarf: Approximately 72" / 183 cm long x 6" / 15 cm wide Hat: Approximately 17" / 43 cm around x 9" / 23 cm high (with brim folded back)

YARN

BERROCO DASH (100 g): 1 ball #3859 Kilimanjaro for hat, 2 balls for scarf

NEFDLES

32" / 80 cm circular needle, size 13 / 9 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

14 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Garter St Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Hat is worked flat sideways using short rows to shape top. Scarf is worked from one long side to the other.

HAT

Cast on 42 sts. Do not join.

Note: Top of hat is shaped with short rows. On Rows 7 and 9 the stitches that were wrapped on Row 1 and 3 will be wrapped a second time. There is no need to pick up the wraps.

Row 1 (RS): Knit 38, w&t.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Knit.

Row 3: Knit 34, w&t.

Row 5: Knit 30, w&t.

Row 7: Knit 34, w&t.

Row 9: Knit 38, w&t.

Rows 10-12: Knit.

Rep Rows 1-12 six times more, then rep Rows 1-11 once more. Bind off knitwise on RS.

FINISHING

Break yarn, leaving a tail at least 3 times the length of the bind-off edge. Use tail to seam cast-on edge to bind-off edge, then sew into the garter edges at the top of the hat to close it up. Weave in all ends and block as desired.





Cast on 238 sts.

Work in Garter St (knit all sts) until piece measures approximately 6" / 15 cm, or until yarn is almost used up (leave at least 3 times the width of scarf for bind-off). Bind off using a sewn bind-off, or preferred bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

k: knitrep: repeatRS: right side

st(s): stitch(es)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side
