FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 38½" / 98 cm x 54" / 137 cm

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE HANDPAINT (100 g): 7 hanks #5213 Royal Amethyst (C1), and 2 hanks #5230 Blushing Rose (C2)

NEEDLES

40" / 100 cm circular needles, sizes 5 / 3.75 mm and 7 / 4.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

18 sts and 28 rows = 4"/ 10 cm in Pattern St on larger needle

Gauge shown is after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

This blanket is a rectangle, knit from one short end to the other in a slip stitch pattern. When working pattern stitch, yarn not in use can be carried up the side between stripes.

PATTERN STITCH

Multiple of 2 sts + 1

Rows 1 and 3 (RS): With C1, knit.

Rows 2 and 4 (WS): With C1, purl.

Row 5: With C2, k1, * sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from * across.

Row 6: With C2, purl.

Row 7: With C1, k2, * sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 8: With C1, purl.

Rep these 8 rows for Pattern Stitch.

BLANKET INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needle and C1, cast on 185 sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * across.

Row 2 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across.

Work in ribbing as established for 2" / 5 cm, end after completing a WS row.

Change to larger needle.

Begin working in pattern stitch, joining C2 when needed, repeating Rows 1–8 until blanket measures approximately 50" / 127 cm from cast-on, end after completing Row 4 of pattern. Break C2 and change to smaller needle.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across.

Row 2 (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * across.

Work in ribbing as established for 2" / 5 cm, end after completing a WS row. Bind off in ribbing.

FINISHING

Side Edging: With RS facing, using smaller needle and C1, pick up and knit approximately 2 sts for every 3 rows along entire side edge of blanket. Exact number of stitches is not crucial, but it needs to be an odd number.

Set Up Rib: Next Row (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * across.

Work in ribbing as established for 2" / 5 cm, end after completing a WS row. Bind off in ribbing. Repeat on other side of blanket.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeatRS: right side

sl: slip

st(s): stitch(es)WS: wrong side

wyif: with yarn in front of work
