(100 grs), 3 (4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7) balls #6889 Lady's Slipper

# HOOKS and NOTIONS

Crochet hook, size 4.00 mm (G) or size to obtain gauge 3 locking stitch markers (or safety pins)

#### **GAUGE**

One Motif = 4" across  $6\frac{1}{2}$  V's and 9 rows = 4" in V-Stitch Pattern

16 dc = 4"

*To save time and ensure accurate* measurements, take time to check gauge.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Standing sc: Yo hook (hold yarn in place with your finger so it doesn't fall off), insert hook where indicated and pull up a loop, yo and pull through both loops on hook
V: [Dc, ch 1, dc] in indicated st or ch-1 sp

#### V-StitchITCH PATTERN

(Worked in the round)

**Note:** In first round, work into either the sc or the ch indicated.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch-1), dc in same stitch, \* skip 2 sts, [dc, ch 1, dc] all in next stitch, rep from \* around, skip last 2 sts, join with a sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

Rnd 2: SI st in next dc and in ch-1 sp, ch 4, dc in same ch-sp (counts as V), \* skip 2 dc, [dc, ch 1, dc] in ch-1 sp, rep from \* around, join with a sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4. Rep Rnd 2 for V-Stitch Pattern.

#### NOTE

A strip of Motifs is worked and joined to form the circular yoke. The upper yoke is then worked in the round from the top of the Yoke Motifs up to the neckline; the lower yoke is then worked from the bottom of the Yoke Motifs to the underarm, with raglan increases. You will then divide for body and sleeves, working each of these sections in the round from the top down.

#### YOKE MOTIES


First Motif: Start with a sliding loop.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 16 sc in loop, join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Pull tail to tighten loop.

Rnd 2: \* Ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch from hook to form picot, ch 2, skip next sc, sc in next sc, rep from \* 6 times more, ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch from hook to form picot, ch 2, join with a sl st in first ch of beg ch-5—8 loops total.

Rnd 3: SI st to center of next picot, [ch 6, sc in center of next picot] 7 times, ch 3, dc in first ch-6 sp.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 2 dc in same ch-6 sp, [3dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in each of the next 7 ch-6 sp around, end with 3 dc in first ch-6 sp, ch 2, join with a sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.







Next 8 (8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12, 12) Motifs: Work Rnds 1–3 as for First Motif.

Rnd 4 (Joining Rnd): Ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 1, sl st in a ch-2 sp of last Motif, 3 dc] in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp of last Motif, 3 dc] in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in each remaining ch-6 sp around, end with 3 dc in first ch-6 sp, ch 2, join with a sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

**Note:** As you join each subsequent Motif, be sure to join in the side of the hexagon directly across from the side where you joined the last Motif so hexagons are in a straight line. **Final Motif:** Work Rnds 1–3 as for First Motif.

Rnd 4 (Joining Rnd): Ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 1, sl st in a ch-2 sp of last Motif, 3 dc] in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp of last Motif, 3 dc] in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in each of the next 2 ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 1, sl st in ch-2 of First Motif, being careful not to twist Motif strip, 3 dc] in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp of First Motif, 3 dc] in next ch-6 sp, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in next ch-6 sp, end with 3 dc, ch 2, join with a sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

**Note:** You should now have a total of 10 (10, 11, 11, 12, 12, 13, 13, 14, 14) motifs joined in a circle.

**Upper Yoke:** Join yarn with a standing sc in ch-2 sp corner before top side of any Motif.

Rnd 1: Sc in each of the 6 dc along top side of Motif, sc in next ch-2 sp of same Motif, ch 9, \* sc in ch-2 sp of next Motif, sc in each of the 6 dc along top side of same Motif, sc in ch-2 sp of same Motif, ch 9, rep from \*, working across each Motif around, join with a sl st in first sc—80 (80, 88, 88, 96, 96, 104, 104, 112, 112) sc and 90 (90, 99, 99, 108, 108, 117, 117, 126, 126) ch's.

Next Rnd: Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc throughout), dc in each of the next 2 sc, dc2tog over next 2 sc, dc in each of the next 3 sc, work [dc, dc2tog, 3 dc, dc2tog, dc] in ch-9 sp, \* dc in each of the next 3 sc, dc2tog over next 2 sc, dc in each of the next 3 sc, work [dc, dc2tog, 3 dc, dc2tog, dc] in ch-9 sp, rep from \* to end. Join with a sl st in top of first dc—140 (140, 154, 154, 168, 168, 182, 182, 196, 196) dc.

Next 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4) Rnd(s): Ch 3, dc in each dc around. Join with a sl st in top of first dc.

Next Rnd: Ch 3, dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, \* dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, rep from \* to last 0 (0, 2, 2, 0, 0, 2, 2, 0, 0) dc, dc in last 0 (0, 2, 2, 0, 0, 2, 2, 0, 0) dc. Join with a sl st in top of first dc—105 (105, 116, 116, 126, 126, 137, 137, 147, 147) dc.

Next 1 (1, 1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) Rnd(s): Ch 3, dc in each dc around. Join with a sl st in top of first dc.

For Sizes 32" and 35½" ONLY: Next Rnd: Ch 3, dc in each of the next 3 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, [dc in each of the next 3 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, dc in each of the next 4 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] 9 times. Join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3—86 dc.

For Sizes 39¼" and 43" ONLY: Next Rnd: Ch 3, dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, [dc in each of the next 3 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, dc in each of the next 2 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] 12 times, dc in each of the next 2 dc, dc2tog over last 2 dc. Join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3—90 dc.
For Sizes 46¾" and 50½" ONLY: Next Rnd: Ch 3, dc in next dc. dc2tog over next 2 dc. \* dc in next dc. dc2tog over next.

dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, \* dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, [dc in each of the next 2 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] 4 times, rep from \* 5 times more, [dc in each of the next 2 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] twice. Join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3—93 dc.

For Sizes 54" and 57¾" ONLY: Next Rnd: Ch 3, [dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] 3 times, \* dc in each of the next 2 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc; rep from \* 16 times more, [dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] 3 times. Join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3—97 dc.

For Sizes 61½" and 65¼" ONLY: Next Rnd: Ch 3, [dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] 5 times, \* dc in each of the next 2 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, [dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] twice; rep from \* 11 times more, [dc in next dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc] 4 times. Join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3—102 dc.

For ALL Sizes: Next Rnd: Ch 1, sc in each dc around. Join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Fasten off.

#### LOWER YOKE

Join yarn with standing sc in ch-2 corner sp on bottom of same Motif where you joined for Upper Yoke.

Rnd 1: Sc in each of the 6 dc along bottom of Motif, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 11, \* sc in ch-2 corner sp before bottom side of next Motif; sc in each of 6 dc along bottom of Motif, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 11, rep from \*, working into each Motif around, and working 1 extra ch in last 2 (2, 1, 1, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0) reps. Join with a sl st in first sc—80 (80, 88, 88, 96, 96, 104, 104, 112, 112) sc and 112 (112, 122, 122, 132, 132, 142, 142, 152, 152) ch.

**Next Rnd:** Work Rnd 1 of V-Stitch Pattern—64 (64, 70, 70, 76, 76, 82, 82, 88, 88) Vs.

Next 2 (1, 2, 1, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4) Rnds: Work Rnd 2 of V-Stitch Pattern.

\*Count 20 (19, 22, 23, 26, 27, 30, 31, 34, 37) Vs for Back and mark last V; count 12 (13, 13, 12, 12, 11, 11, 10, 12, 7) Vs for Right Sleeve and Mark last V, rep from \* for Front and Left Sleeve.

For Sizes 35½", 39¼", 54", and 65¼" ONLY: Inc Rnd (Front and Back only): SI st in between last dc of previous rnd and first dc of this rnd, ch 4, dc in same place, work in pattern up to and including marked ch-sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, move marker into last V (end of Back); work in pattern up to and including marked ch-sp, move marker into last V (end of Sleeve), [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, work in pattern up to and including marked ch-sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, move marker into last V (end of Front), work in pattern to last V (end of Sleeve). Join with a sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 2 Vs inc'd in each Front and Back—4 Vs inc'd total (2 Vs on each sleeve only).

For ALL Sizes: Inc Rnd (Front, Back and Sleeves): SI st in between last dc of previous rnd and first dc of this rnd, ch 4, dc in same place, work in pat up to and including marked ch-sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, move marker into last V (end of Back), [dc, ch 1, dc[ in next ch-1 sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, work in pat until last V before marked ch-sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, [dc, ch 1, dc] in next ch-1 sp, move marker into last V (end of Sleeve), [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, work in pat up to and including marked ch-sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, move marker into last V (end of Front), [dc, ch 1, dc] in next ch-1 sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, work in pat to just before last V, [dc, ch 1, dc] in between next 2 dc, [dc, ch 1, dc] in last ch-1 sp, (end of Sleeve). Join with a sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 2 Vs inc'd in each Front, Back and Sleeves—8 Vs inc's (2 each in Back and Front and 2 in each sleeve).

Rep Inc Rnd (Front, Back and Sleeves) 1 (2, 1, 3, 2, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4) time(s) more—80 (92, 90, 102, 100, 108, 118, 122, 128, 132) Vs total [24 (27, 28, 31, 32, 35, 38, 41, 44, 47) each in Back and Front and 16 (19, 17, 20, 18, 19, 21, 20, 22, 19) in each sleeve].

Divide for Body and Sleeves: Next Rnd: SI st in next dc and in ch-1 sp, work in pattern up to and including first marked V, ch 6 (6, 12, 12, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18) for underarm, skip all Vs up to and including next marked V, work in pattern, starting with next V, up to and including following marked V, ch 6 (6, 12, 12, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18) for underarm, join with a sI st in 3rd ch at beg of rnd, skipping all remaining Vs (for Sleeve). Remove all makers.

#### **BODY**

Next Rnd: \* Work in pattern to underarm ch, skip 1 ch, [dc, ch 1, dc] in next ch, \*\* skip 2 ch, [dc, ch 1, dc] in next ch, rep from \*\* 0 (0, 2, 2, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) times more, skip next ch, rep from \* once more—52 (58, 64, 70, 76, 82, 88, 94, 100, 106) Vs. Cut yarn. Join yarn with a sl st in 2nd (2nd, 3rd, 3rd, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th) V of underarm; this is the new begof-rnd. Work even in V-Stitch Pattern until piece measures approximately 13½" from underarm. Fasten off.

# **SLEEVES**


Join yarn with a sl st in center of 2nd (2nd, 3rd, 3rd, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th, 4th) V of underarm, ch 4, dc in same sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in center of next 0 (0, 1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) Vs of underarm, work [dc, ch 1, dc] into side of dc at corner of underarm, work in pattern across Vs from yoke, [dc, ch 1, dc] into side of dc at corner of underarm, [dc, ch 1, dc] in center of next 1 (1, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3) Vs of underarm, join with a sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

Work 1 more round in V-Stitch Pattern, then fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

**B** (Neck Circumference): 21½ (21½, 22½, 22½, 23¼, 23¼, 24¼, 24¼, 25½, 25½)"

C (Length to Underarms): 131/2"

D (Yoke Length): 8¾ (9½, 9½, 10, 10½, 11½, 12, 13, 13, 13½)"

**E** (Sleeve Circumference): 11 (13, 13, 14¾, 14¾, 15¼, 16½, 16, 17¼, 16)"

F (Sleeve Length): 1/2"

# STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning CC: contrasting color

cont: continue ch: chain dec: decrease dc: double crochet dtr: double treble crochet

est: established

hdc: half double crochet

inc: increase MC: main color pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker rep: repeat rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sc: single crochet

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

sp: space st(s): stitch(es) tog: together tr: treble

sl st: slip stitch

WS: wrong side yo: yarn over
