

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hat: Approximately 4" / 10 cm around x 3½" / 9 cm high, with unfolded hem, not including pompon

Sweater: Approximately 3¼" / 8.5 cm across body x 2¾" / 7 cm high

#### YARN

**BERROCO LANAS LIGHT (100 g):**

Version 1 (3 colors): small amount each #7843 Dark Denim (MC), #7801 Cream (CC1) and #7850 Berries (CC2) for both hat and pullover

Version 2 (2 colors): small amount each #78145 Shoal (MC) and #7821 Sunny (CC1) for both hat and pullover

#### NEEDLES

1 set double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences in the round, size 4 / 3.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

#### NOTIONS

Stitch markers, waste yarn to hold stitches, optional 1" / 2.5 cm pompom maker, optional key clasp

#### GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in St st

*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

#### Berroco Lanas® Light

#### HAT

With CC1, cast on 24 sts. Place marker for BOR and join for working in the round.

Work 12 rnds in k1, p1 ribbing.

Knit 15 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 1:** \* K4, k2tog; rep from \* around. 20 sts.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \* K3, k2tog; rep from \* around. 16 sts.

**Dec Rnd 3:** \* K2, k2tog; rep from \* around. 12 sts.

**Dec Rnd 4:** \* K1, k2tog; rep from \* around. 8 sts.

Break yarn, leaving an 8" / 20.5 cm long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts, pull tight and fasten off.



## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired. If desired, make a small pompom and attach to top of hat.

## PULLOVER

**Sleeves (make 2):** With MC, cast on 12 sts. Place marker for BOR and join for working in the round.

Work 2 rnds in k1, p1 ribbing.

Knit 10 rnds.

**Inc Rnd:** K1, M1L, knit to last st, M1R, k1. 14 sts.

Knit 7 rnds.

Slip sts to waste yarn and set aside.

**Body:** With MC, cast on 36 sts. Place marker for BOR and join for working in the round.

Work 2 rnds in k1, p1 ribbing.

Knit 12 rnds.

**Join Body and Sleeves: Next Rnd:** Knit 18 sts for back, pm, slip sleeve sts to left needle and knit these sts, pm, knit 18 sts for front, pm, slip sleeve sts to left needle and knit these sts. 64 sts.

**Dec Rnd:** \* SSK, knit to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, sm; rep from \* around. 56 sts.

### For Version 1:

#### Yoke:

With CC1, knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd. 48 sts.

With CC2, knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd. 40 sts.

With CC1, knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd. 32 sts.

With MC, [knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd] twice. 16 sts.

Work 2 rnds in k1, p1 ribbing. Bind off.

### For Version 2:

#### Yoke:

With CC1, knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd. 48 sts.

With MC, knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd. 40 sts.

With CC1, knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd. 32 sts.

With MC, [knit 1 rnd, work Dec Rnd] twice. 16 sts.

Work 2 rnds in k1, p1 ribbing. Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

If desired, use loop of yarn to attach hat and pullover to key clasp.

## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**BOR:** beginning of round

**CC:** contrasting color

**dec:** decrease

**inc:** increase

**k:** knit

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together

**MC:** main color

**M1L:** Make 1 Left— Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left-hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**M1R:** Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left-hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**p:** purl

**pm:** place marker

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**sm:** slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left-hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**St st:** Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.
