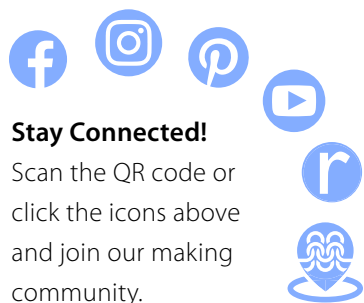

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#### SIZES

(1, 2, 3, 4, 5)

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Back / Front Width: (29½, 35, 39¼, 45, 49¾)" / (75, 89, 99.5, 114, 126.5) cm

Length: 21½" / 54.5 cm

Shown in size 2 (35" / 89 cm).

#### YARN

**BERROCO LUMI** (50 g): (9, 11, 12, 14, 18) balls #8156  
Snow (C1)

**BERROCO AERIAL** (25 g): (5, 5, 6, 7, 8) balls #3447  
Thunder (C2)

#### HOOK

Crochet hook, size I-9 / 5.5 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

#### NOTIONS

Removable stitch markers, tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

15 sts and 11 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern St with 1 strand of each yarn held together

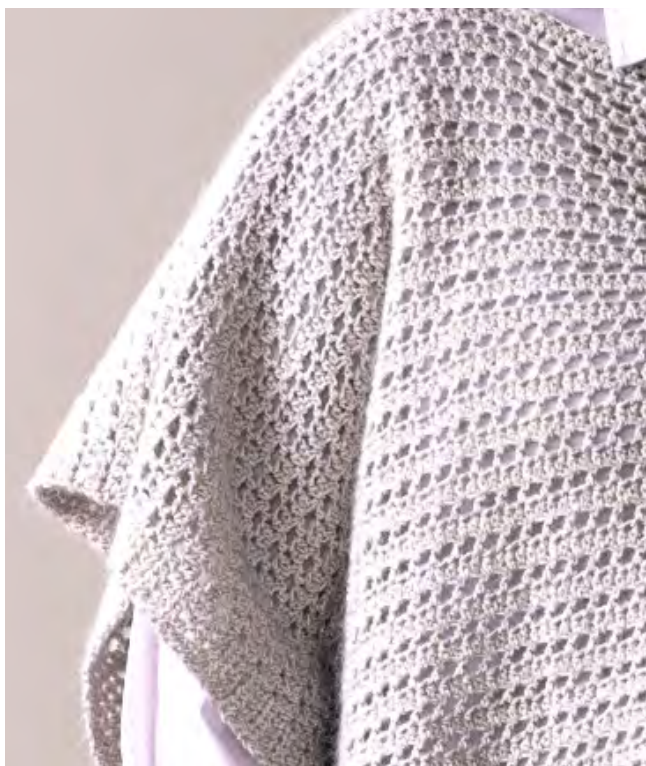
*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

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## CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Back and Front are worked flat separately, then sewn together at shoulders. Work with one strand of each yarn held together throughout, but seam shoulders using only C1.

## PATTERN STITCH

Odd number of sts

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 2 (counts as hdc throughout), hdc in each hdc (and ch-sp) across, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in each of the next 4 hdc, \* ch 1, skip next hdc, hdc in next hdc; rep from \* to the last 5 hdc, hdc in each of the last 5 hdc, turn.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for pattern stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### BACK

Ch (112, 132, 150, 170, 188).

**Row 1 (RS):** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (111, 131, 149, 169, 187) hdc.

**Rows 2–3:** Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

**Rows 4–55:** Work in Pattern St, working Rows 1 and 2 twenty-six times.

**Rows 56–59:** Ch 2, hdc in each hdc (and ch-sp) across, turn. Fasten off.



## FRONT

Work same as for Back.

## FINISHING

Measure off (41, 43, 43, 45, 45) sts at center of upper back, and place markers for back neck, with (35, 44, 53, 62, 71) sts at each side for shoulders. Sew shoulder seams. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**Note:** Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

**ch:** chain

**hdc:** half double crochet

**sp:** space

**sts:** stitch(es)
