

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Approximately 32" wide x 34" long

YARN

2 Balls each BERROCO SOX (100 grs), #1413 Confetti (A), #1410 Lollipop (B) and #1412 Jellybeans (C)

HOOKS and NOTIONS Crochet hook, size 3.50 mm (E-4) or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

1 Hexagon = 4" across or 4½ from corner to corner To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

HEXAGON

(Make 23 with A, 23 with B and 22 with C)

With crochet hook, ch 4. Join with a sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 5, (work 3 dc's in ring, ch 2) 5 times, work 2 dc's in ring, join with a sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 2: SI st into next space, ch 5, dc in same space, * dc in each of next 3 dc's, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in same ch-2 space, rep from * 4 times more, dc in each of last 3 dc's, join with a sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 3: SI st into next space, ch 5, dc in same space, * (dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc) twice, dc in next dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 space, rep from * 4 times more, (dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc) twice, dc in last dc, join with a sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 4: SI st into next space, ch 5, dc in same space, * dc in each dc and ch-1 space to next ch-2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 space, rep from * 4 times more, dc in each dc and ch-1 space to end, join with a sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 5: SI st into next space, ch 5, dc in same space, * (dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc) 4 times, dc in next dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 space, rep from * 4 times more, (dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc) twice, dc in last dc, join with a sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 4. Fasten off.

HALF HEXAGON

(Make 4 with A and 4 with B)

With crochet hook, ch 4. Join with a sl st to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch 2), 3 dc's in ring, * ch 2, 3 dc's in ring, rep from * once more, ch 2, dc in ring. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch 2), dc in ch-2 space, dc in each of the next 3 dc's, * (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, dc in each of the next 3 dc's, rep from * once more, dc in ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and ch 2), dc in ch-2 space, dc in next dc, (ch 1, skip 1 dc, dc in next dc) twice, * (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, dc in next dc, (ch 1, skip 1 dc, dc in next dc) twice, rep from * once more, dc in ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5. Turn.





Row 4: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch 2), dc in ch-2 space, * dc in each dc and ch-1 space to ch-2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, rep from * once more, dc in each dc and ch-1 space to end, dc in ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5. Turn.


Row 5: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch 2), dc in ch-2 space, * dc in next dc, (skip 1 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1) 3 times, skip 1 dc, dc in next dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, rep from * once more, dc in next dc, (skip 1 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1) 3 times, skip 1 dc, dc in next dc, dc in ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-5. Turn.

Row 6: Rep Row 4. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew hexagons and half hexagons together, working through back loops of all sts and following diagram.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

cont: continue

ch: chain

dec: decrease

dc: double crochet

dtr: double treble crochet

est: established

hdc: half double crochet

inc: increase MC: main color pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker rep: repeat rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

sc: single crochet sl st: slip stitch

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the

loop.

sp: space st(s): stitch(es) tog: together tr: treble

WS: wrong side yo: yarn over
