FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Approximately 14" wide x 66" long
(not including fringe)

YARN

BERROCO PROVIDENCE (50 grs):
5 balls #1121 Lincoln Woods
NEEDLES and NOTIONS
Knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm)
or size to obtain gauge
Crochet hook, size 5.00 mm (H), for
fringe
2 stitch markers

GAUGE

26 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Pattern
Stitch (section between markers)
*To save time and ensure accurate
measurements, take time to check
gauge.*

SCARF

Cast on 93 sts.

Set Up Row (WS): P12, pm, p69, pm, p12.

Pattern Stitch: Row 1 (RS): [K2tog, leaving sts on needle, knit the first stitch again, slip sts off needle, skip 1, knit the next stitch tbl behind skipped stitch, knit skipped stitch] 3 times, sm, k2tog, * [k1, yo, k1] all in next stitch, sl 1, k2tog, pss0, rep from * 16 times more, [k1, yo, k1] all in next stitch, SSK, sm, [k2tog, leaving sts on needle, knit the first stitch again, slip sts off needle, skip 1, knit the next stitch tbl behind skipped stitch, knit skipped stitch] 3 times.

Row 2: Purl, slipping markers.

Rep the last 2 rows until piece measures approximately 66" from beginning, end on RS with Row 1. Bind off purlwise on WS.

FINISHING

Fringe: Cut four 11" long strands of yarn. Put strands together and fold in half. Insert crochet hook from WS to RS in first stitch on cast-on edge of scarf. Pull folded ends of strands through, forming a loop. Pull free ends of strands through loop, forming fringe. In this manner, make fringe in every other stitch along cast-on and bound-off ends of scarf. Trim ends to even off if necessary. Weave in all ends and block as desired.



STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needle

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase

k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

k3tog: knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

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
