**skill level:** Intermediate  
One size

**finished measurements**  
Approximately 22" wide x 70" long

**materials**  
2 hanks **BERROCO CAPTIVA** (50 grs),  
#5540 Mascarpone (A)  
6 balls **BERROCO ANDEAN MIST** (25  
grs), #6303 Huayna Picchu (B) and  
4 balls #6320 Lascar (C)  
Straight knitting needles, sizes 8  
(5.00 mm) and 10½ (6.50 mm) OR  
SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE  
Tapestry needle

**gauge**  
22 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Lace Pat  
with A on size 8 needles  
14 sts and 22 rows = 4" in St st with  
2 strands of B held tog on size 10½  
needles  
TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO  
CHECK GAUGE

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**NOTE:** We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

## NOTE

Borders are worked first in Lace Pat. Sts are then picked up along the side edge of 1 border and worked in St st with Garter St edging to end. Live sts are then grafted onto the side edge of the second border.

## LACE PATTERN

**Note:** Due to the nature of this pattern, the number of sts will vary from row to row. The number given after a row is the number of sts you will have after working that row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2tog, k1, yo, k2tog, k5, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k9, yo, k2tog, k1 – 24 sts.

**Row 2:** Sl 1, k2, yo, k2tog, k1, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) twice, k2, yo, k2tog, k3, k2tog, yo, k3 – 23 sts.

**Row 3:** Yo, k4, yo, k2tog, k1, k2tog, yo, k11, yo, k2tog, k1 – 24 sts.

**Row 4:** Sl 1, k2, yo, k2tog, k3, (yo, k2tog) twice, k3, yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k6 – 24 sts.

**Row 5:** Yo, k1, k2tog, (yo) twice, k18, yo, k2tog, k1 – 26 sts.

**Row 6:** Sl 1, k2, yo, k2tog, k4, (yo, k2tog) twice, k8, (k1, p1) into double yo, k3 – 26 sts.

**Row 7:** K1, k2tog, (yo) twice, k2tog, (yo) twice, k2tog, k16, yo, k2tog, k1 – 27 sts.

**Row 8:** Sl 1, k2, yo, k2tog, k5, (yo, k2tog) twice, k6, (k1, p1) into double yo, k1, (k1, p1) into double yo, k2 – 27 sts.

**Row 9:** K2tog, k1, k2tog, (yo) twice, k2tog, k3, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, k11, yo, k2tog, k1 – 27 sts.

**Row 10:** Sl 1, k2, yo, k2tog, k3, k2tog, yo, k2tog, (yo, k3) twice, yo, k2tog, k2, (k1, p1) into double yo, k2tog, k1 – 27 sts.

**Row 11:** K2tog, k3, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, k10, yo, k2tog, k1 – 26 sts.

**Row 12:** Sl 1, k2, yo, k2tog, k2, (k2tog, yo) twice, k3, yo, k7, yo, k2tog, k1, k2tog – 26 sts.

Rep these 12 rows for Lace Pat.



## BORDER (Make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 26 sts. Work even in Lace Pat until a total of 13 repeats (156 rows) have been completed. Bind off.

## SHAWL

With RS facing, using larger needles and 2 strands of B held tog, pick up and k78 sts along straight side edge of first border.

**Row 1 (WS):** K3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

**Row 2:** Knit. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 10" above picked up sts, end on WS. Break off 1 strand of B and join one strand of C. Rep Rows 1 and 2 with 1 strand each of B and C held tog for 12", end on WS. Break off B and join a second strand of C. Rep Rows 1 and 2 with 2 strands of C held tog for 16", end on WS. Break off 1 strand of C and join one strand of B. Rep Rows 1 and 2 with 1 strand each of B and C held tog for 12", end on WS. Break off C and join a second strand of B. Rep Rows 1 and 2 with 2 strands of B held tog for 10", end on WS. Break off yarn, leaving a 48" long end.

## FINISHING

Thread end into tapestry needle. Insert needle through first st on LH needle from back to front, pulling yarn through. Insert needle under first st on straight edge of second border, pulling yarn through. Insert needle through first st on LH needle from front to back, pulling yarn through and slipping st off LH needle. In this manner, continue joining live sts on LH needle to straight edge of border until all sts have been joined. Weave in all ends. Block as desired.

## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

### Knit

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**beg:** beginning

**CC:** contrasting color

**cdd (centered double decrease):** Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

**cn:** cable needle

**cont:** continue

**dec:** decrease

**dpn:** double pointed needles

**est:** established

**inc:** increase

**K:** knit

**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s)

**k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together

**k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together

**LH:** left hand

**MC:** main color

**M1:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**M1L:** Work as for M1.

**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**M1pL:** Work as for M1p.

**M1pR:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**p:** purl

**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s)

**pat(s):** pattern(s)

**pm:** place marker

**pssso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch

**p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

**p2sso:** pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

**p3tog:** purl 3 stitches together

**rem:** remaining

**rep:** repeat

**RH:** right hand

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**RS:** right side

**sl:** slip

**sm:** slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**TBL:** through back loop(s)

**tog:** together

**WS:** wrong side

**wyib:** with yarn in back

**wyif:** with yarn in front

**yo:** yarn over

**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row

**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

### Crochet

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**ch:** chain

**dc:** double crochet

**hdc:** half double crochet

**sc:** single crochet

**sl st:** slip stitch

**sp:** space

**tr:** treble
