BACK

With smaller needles, cast on 98 (114, 126, 134, 146, 162, 170) sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K2, * p2, k2, rep from * across.

Row 2: P2, * k2, p2, rep from * across. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 2" from beginning, end on RS. Change to larger needles.

Inc Row (WS): P10 (18, 6, 10, 16, 6, 10), increasing 2 (0, 1, 2, 2, 1, 2) sts evenly across, pm, work Set-up Row of Chart 1 over next 78 (78, 114, 114, 114, 150, 150) sts, pm, purl to end, increasing 2 (0, 1, 2, 2, 1, 2) sts evenly across—106 (118, 134, 144, 156, 172, 182) sts.

Establish Chart: Row 1 (RS): Knit to first marker, sm, work Row 1 of Chart 1 to last marker, sm, knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to first marker, sm, work Row 2 of Chart 1 to last marker, sm, purl to end. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 15" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Raglan Armholes: Bind off 4 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—98 (108, 122, 132, 142, 158, 166) sts.

Dec Row 1 (RS): K1, k3tog tbl, work to last 4 sts, k3tog, k1—4 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row 1 (4, 9, 13, 16, 22, 25) times more, end on WS—90 (88, 82, 76, 74, 66, 62) sts.

Dec Row 2 (RS): K1, k2tog tbl, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row 21 (20, 17, 14, 13, 9, 7) times more, end on WS—46 sts. Bind off.


LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on 49 (53, 57, 61, 65, 73, 77) sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): * K2, p2, rep from * to last st, k1.







Row 2: P1, * k2, p2, rep from * across. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 2" from beginning, end on RS. Change to larger needles.

Inc Row (WS): Work Set-Up Row of Chart 2 over 39 sts, pm, purl to end, increasing 0 (0, 0, 0, 2, 0, 0) sts evenly across—51 (55, 59, 63, 69, 75, 79) sts.

Establish Chart: Row 1 (RS): Knit to marker, sm, work Row 1 of Chart 2 to end.

Row 2: Work Row 2 of Chart 2 to marker, sm, purl to end. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 15" from beginning, end on WS.

Note: Please read through this entire section before starting to knit. You will be shaping both edges at the same time and need to keep track of all decs.

Shape Raglan Armhole: Bind off 4 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8) sts, work to end—47 (50, 53, 57, 62, 68, 71) sts. Work 1 row even.

Dec Row 1 (RS): K1, k3tog tbl, work to end—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row 2 (3, 4, 7, 10, 14, 16) times more, end on WS—41 (42, 43, 41, 40, 38, 37) sts.

Dec Row 2 (RS): K1, k2tog tbl, work to end—1 st

dec'd. Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row 20 (21, 22, 20, 19, 17, 16) times more, end on WS—20 sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures 5 (5½, 6, 6½, 7, 7½, 8)", end on RS and shape neck as follows:

Shape Neck: Next Row (WS): Bind off 8 sts, work to end. Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 11 times, while continuing to decrease at armhole edge as before. When all neck and armhole decs have been completed, end on WS. Fasten off last st.

RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on 49 (53, 57, 61, 65, 73, 77) sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K1, * p2, k2, rep from * across.

Row 2: * P2, k2, rep from * to last st, p1. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 2" from beginning, end on RS. Change to larger needles.

Inc Row (WS): P10 (14, 18, 22, 26, 34, 38), increasing 0 (0, 0, 0, 2, 0, 0) sts evenly across, pm, work Set-Up Row of Chart 3 to end—51 (55, 59, 63, 69, 75, 79) sts.

Establish Chart: Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of Chart 3 to marker, sm, knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to marker, sm, work Row 2 of Chart 3 to end. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 15" from beginning, end on RS.

Shape Raglan Armhole: Next Row (WS): Bind off 4 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8) sts, work to end—47 (50, 53, 57, 62, 68, 71) sts.

Dec Row 1 (RS): Work to last 4 sts, k3tog tbl, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row 2 (3, 4, 7, 10, 14, 16) times more, end on WS—41 (42, 43, 41, 40, 38, 37) sts.

Dec Row 2 (RS): Work to last 3 sts, k2tog tbl, k1—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row 20 (21, 22, 20, 19, 17, 16) times more, end on WS—20 sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures 5 (5½, 6, 6½, 7, 7½, 8)", end on WS and shape neck as follows: **Shape Neck: Next Row (RS):** Bind off 8 sts, work to end. Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 11 times, while continuing to decrease at armhole edge as before. When all neck and armhole decs have been completed, end on WS. Fasten off last st.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 46 (46, 46, 46, 50, 50, 50) sts. Work in ribbing as for back for 3", end on

WS. Change to larger needles and work even in St st until sleeve measures 4" from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1R, k to last st, M1L, k1—2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc Row every 16 (12, 8, 6, 6, 6, 4)th row 5 (7, 9, 12, 12, 14, 17) times more—58 (62, 66, 72, 76, 80, 86) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 18" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Raglan Cap: Bind off 4 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—50 (52, 54, 60, 62, 66, 70) sts.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog tbl, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row 15 (15, 15, 20, 20, 22, 25) times more, then every 4th row 4 (5, 6, 4, 5, 5, 4) times, end on WS. Bind off remaining 10 sts.

FINISHING

Sew raglan sleeve caps to raglan armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Left Frontband: With RS facing, using smaller needles, begin at neck edge, pick up and knit 97 (101, 101, 105, 105, 109, 109) sts along left front edge to lower edge of ribbing.

Row 1 (WS): * P2, k2, rep from * to last st, p1. **Row 2 (RS):** K1, * p2, k2, rep from * across. Rep these 2 rows until band measures 1", end on WS. Bind off in ribbing.

Right Frontband: With RS facing, using smaller needles, begin at lower edge, pick up and knit

97 (101, 101, 105, 105, 109, 109) sts along right front edge to neck edge.

Row 1 (WS): P1, * k2, p2, rep from * across.

Row 2 (RS): * K2, p2, rep from * to last st, k1. Rep these 2 rows until band measures ½", end on WS.


Buttonhole Row (RS): Work 4 (4, 4, 4, 4, 6, 6) sts, yo, k2tog, * work 14 (15, 15, 16, 16, 16, 16) sts, yo, k2tog, rep from * 4 times more, work to end—6 buttonholes made (the last will be in the neckband). Continue to work in ribbing as established until band measures 1", end on WS. Bind off in ribbing.

Neckband: With RS facing, using circular needle, begin at outer edge of right frontband, pick up and knit 5 sts across edge of frontband, 7 sts across bound-off sts, 8 sts along right front neck edge, 8 sts across top of right sleeve, 46 sts across back neck edge, 8 sts across top of left sleeve, 8 sts along left front neck edge, 7 sts across bound-off sts, then 5 sts across edge of left frontband—102 sts.

Row 1 (WS): P2, * k2, p2, rep from * across. **Row 2 (RS):** K2, * p2, k2, rep from * across. Rep Row 1 once more, end on WS.

Buttonhole Row (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, work in ribbing to end. Work even in ribbing as established until band measures 1", end on WS. Bind off in ribbing.

Weave in all ends and block as desired. Sew on buttons.





CHART 1
Work Set-up Row on WS.
Rep Rows 1 - 36.
On RS, beg at A, work to C, rep between B and C, end at D.
On WS, beg at D, work to B, rep between C and B, end at A.
CHARTS 2 and 3

CHARTS 2 and 3 Work Set-Up Row on WS. Rep Rows 1 - 36. Work from right to left on RS rows and from left to right on WS rows.







STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches

cn: cable needle dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong

Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right

Side row

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) **k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together **k3tog:** knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p. M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s) **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row. knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s) **RS:** right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over
