needles and notions

29" length circular needle, size 9 (5.50 mm) or size to obtain gauge One 1" button

gauge

18 sts and 30 rows = 4" in Pattern Stitch with C1 and C2 worked together

To save time, take time to check gauge

NOTF

C1 and C2 are worked together throughout.

PATTERN STITCH

(Odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 2: P2, * sl 1 wyib, p1, rep from * to last 3 sts, end sl 1 wyib, p2.

Row 3: K1, * sl 1 wyif, k1, rep from * across.

Row 4: P1, * k1, p1, rep from * across.

Row 5: K2, * sl 1 wyif, k1, rep from * to last 3 sts,

end sl 1 wyif, k2.

Row 6: P1, * sl 1 wyib, p1, rep from * across.

Rep these 6 rows for Pat St.



BACK

With circular needle, using 1 strand each of C1 and C2 held together, cast on 87 (95, 105, 113, 123, 131, 141, 149) sts. Do not join. Work even in Pattern Stitch for 21", end on WS. Mark beginning and end of last row for beginning of armholes. Work even until armholes measure 7 ($7\frac{1}{2}$, 8, $8\frac{1}{2}$, 9, 9, $9\frac{1}{2}$, $9\frac{1}{2}$)", end on WS.

Shape Shoulders: Bind off 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7) sts at beginning of the next 2 (10, 4, 12, 6, 14, 8, 16) rows, then 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 0) sts at beginning of the next 14 (6, 12, 4, 10, 2, 8, 0) rows. Bind off remaining 37 sts for back neck.

LEFT FRONT

With circular needle, using 1 strand each of C1 and C2 held together, cast on 51 (55, 59, 65, 69, 73, 79, 83) sts. Do not join. Work even in Pattern Stitch for 21", end on WS. Mark end of last row for beginning of armhole. Work even until armhole measures $6 (6\frac{1}{2}, 7, 7\frac{1}{2}, 8, 8, 8\frac{1}{2}, 8\frac{1}{2})$ ", end on RS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (WS): Bind off 16 (16, 15, 17, 16, 16, 17, 17) sts, work to end—35 (49, 44, 48,



53, 57, 62, 66) sts. Decrease 1 st at neck edge every RS row 10 times. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9, 9½, 9½)", end on WS.

Shape Shoulder: Continuing to decrease at neck edge, bind off 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7) sts at beginning of the next 1 (5, 2, 6, 3, 7, 4, 8) RS rows, then 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 0) sts at beginning of the next 7 (3, 6, 2, 5, 1, 4, 0) RS rows. Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

With circular needle, using 1 strand each of C1 and C2 held together, cast on 51 (55, 59, 65, 69, 73, 79, 83) sts. Do not join. Work even in Pattern Stitch for 13", end on WS.

Buttonhole Row (RS): Work 4 sts, yo, k2tog, work to end—1 buttonhole made. Continue to work even in Pattern Stitch until piece measures 21" from beginning, end on WS. Mark beginning of last row for beginning of armhole. Work even until armhole measures 6 (6½, 7, 7½, 8, 8, 8½, 8½)", end on WS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Bind off 16 (16, 15, 17, 16, 16, 17, 17) sts, work to end—35 (49, 44, 48, 53, 57, 62, 66) sts sts. Decrease 1 st at neck edge every RS row 10 times. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9, 9½, 9½)", end on RS.

Shape Shoulder: Continuing to decrease at neck edge, bind off 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7) sts at beginning of the next 1 (5, 2, 6, 3, 7, 4, 8) WS rows, then 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 0) sts at beginning of the next 7 (3, 6, 2, 5, 1, 4, 0) WS rows. Fasten off.

Sew shoulder seams.

SI FFVFS

With RS facing, using circular needle and 1 strand each of C1 and C2 held together, pick up and knit 63 (67, 71, 75, 81, 81, 85, 85) sts along armhole edge between markers. Do not join. Beginning with Row 2, work even in Pattern Stitch for 1", end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 18 (14, 12, 10, 8, 8, 8, 8)th row 5 (3, 5, 5, 9, 9, 6, 6) times, then every 0 (12, 10, 8, 6, 6, 6, 6)th row 0 (4, 3, 5, 3, 3, 7, 7) times—51 (51, 53, 53, 55, 55, 57, 57) sts. Work even until sleeve measures approximately 15" from beginning, end on WS with either Row 2 or 4. Bind off on either Row 3 or 5.




POCKETS (Make 2)


With circular needle, using 1 strand each of C1 and C2 held together, cast on 29 sts. Do not join. Work even in Pat St for 7", end on WS with either Row 2 or 4. Bind off on either Row 3 or 5.

FINISHING

Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew one pocket to RS of each front with cast-on edge of pocket 3" up from cast-on edge of front and side edge of pocket 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4)" in from side seam.

Collar: With RS facing, using circular needle and 1 strand each of C1 and C2 held together, begin at end of bound-off sts on Right Front, pick up and knit 91 sts along neck edge to end of bound-off sts on Left Front. Beginning with Row 2, work even in Pattern Stitch for 1½", end on WS. Bind off knitwise. Sew first ½" on side edge of collar to bound-off sts on each side. Sew button to Left Front edge to correspond to buttonhole. Weave in all ends and block as desired.





STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches

over

cn: cable needle **dec:** decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong

Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right

Side row

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) **k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together **k3tog:** knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p. M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s) p2tog: purl 2 stitches together p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s) **RS:** right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. *On* WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over
