(100 grs): 4 balls #5737 Aster

needles and notions

Straight needles, size 10 (6.00 mm) *or size to obtain gauge* 4 Stitch markers

gauge

25 sts and 21 rows = 4'' in Pattern Stitches.

To save time, take time to check gauge

NOTE

Due to the nature of these pattern stitches, the number of sts will vary from row to row. The number of sts given at the end a row indicates the number of sts you will have after completing that row.

PATTERN A

Begins and ends with 9 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, p5, k2.

Row 2: P2, k1, p3tog, k1, p2—7 sts.

Row 3: K2, p3, k2.

Row 4: P2, k1, [k1, p1, k1] all in next st, k1, p2—9 sts.

Rep these 4 rows for Pattern A.





PATTERN B

Begins and ends with 5 sts.

Rows 1 and 3 (RS): P2, k1, p2—5 sts.

Rows 2 and 4: K2, p1, k2.

Row 5: P2, M1pR, k1, M1pL, p2—7 sts.

Row 6: K2, p3, k2.

Row 7: P2, k1, M1pR, k1, M1pL, k1, p2—9 sts.

Row 8: K2, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k2.

Row 9: P2, k1, p1, M1pR, k1, M1pL, p1, k1, p2

—11 sts.

Row 10: K2, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k2.

Row 11: P2, k1, p1, k1, M1pR, k1, M1pL, k1, p1, k1, p2—13 sts.

Row 12: K2, [p1, k1] 4 times, p1, k2.

Row 13: P2, [k1, p1] twice, M1pR, k1, M1pL, [p1, k1]

twice, p2—15 sts.

Rows 14, 16, and 18: K2, [p1, k1] twice, p3, [k1, p1] twice, k2.

Rows 15 and 17: P2, [k1, p1] twice, k3, [p1, k1] twice, p2.

Row 19: P2, [k1, p1] twice, CDD, [p1, k1] twice, p2—13 sts.

Row 20: K2, [p1, k1] 4 times, p1, k2.

Row 21: P2, k1, p1, k1, CDD, k1, p1, k1, p2—11 sts.

Row 22: K2, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k2.

Row 23: P2, k1, p1, CDD, p1, k1, p2—9 sts.

Row 24: K2, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k2.



Row 25: P2, k1, CDD, k1, p2—7 sts.

Row 26: K2, p3, k2.

Row 27: P2, CDD, p2—5 sts.

Row 28: K2, p1, k2.

Rep these 28 rows for Pattern B.

PATTERN C

Begin with Row 15 of Pattern B, work through Row 28, then rep Rows 1–28 for Pattern C.

SCARF

Cast on 47 sts. Purl 1 row.

Establish Patterns: Next Row (RS): Work Pattern A over 9 sts, pm, work Pattern B over 5 sts, pm, work Pattern A over 9 sts, pm, work Pattern C over 15 sts, pm, work Pattern A over 9 sts. Work even in patterns as established until scarf measures 75" from beginning, end on WS. Bind off.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

CDD (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

k: knit

M1pL: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pm: place marker RS: right side st(s): stitch(es) WS: wrong side
