Straight needles, size 19 (15 mm) or size to obtain gauge Crochet hook, size 10.00 mm (N-15)

gauge

6 sts and 6 rows = 4" in Garter St using Macro To save time, take time to check gauge

SCARF

With straight needles, using Berroco Macro, cast on 15 sts. Work even in Garter St (knit every row) until piece measures 62" from beginning. Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Fringe: Cut six 17" long strands of Berroco Suede. Hold all strands together and fold in half. Insert crochet hook through first stitch of cast-on edge of scarf and pull through folded center of strands forming a loop. Pull free ends of strands through loop forming fringe. In this manner, make fringe in every stitch of cast-on and bound-off edges of scarf. Trim ends to even off if necessary. Weave in all ends and block as desired.
