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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: Approximately 22" / 55 cm

Center back length: 3" / 7.5 cm

Center front length: 16" / 40 cm

YARN

BERROCO STRATTO (50 g): 2 balls #12708 Heather

Note: Sample used nearly all of 2 balls, consider buying a third ball to avoid running out of yarn.

HOOK

Crochet hook, size M-13 / 9 mm hook or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

8 hdc and 7 rows = 4" / 10 cm

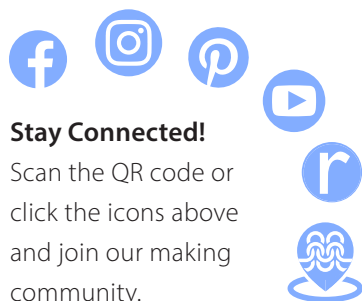
Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Cowl is worked sideways, beginning at the center back, increasing to the point at the front of the cowl, then decreasing to the center back on the other side. Short edges are joined with a slip-stitch seam at the center back after collar edging is complete.

INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 8.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch to end, turn. *6 hdc.*

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as an hdc here and throughout), hdc in each hdc to end, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn.

Increase Section:

Note: Take care to chain loosely at the beginning of all odd numbered rows to allow enough give along bottom edge of cowl.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to last 2, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in last hdc, turn. *1 hdc inc'd.*

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in first hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each hdc to end. *1 hdc inc'd.*

Row 6: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to last 2, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in last hdc, turn. *1 hdc inc'd.*

Row 7: Ch 2, 2 hdc in first hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each hdc to end. *2 hdc inc'd.*

Rows 8–19: Rep Rows 4–7 three times more. *26 hdc.*

Rows 20–21: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn.

Decrease Section:

Row 22: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to last 3, hdc2tog, hdc in last hdc, turn. *1 hdc dec'd.*

Row 23: Ch 2, hdc in first hdc, hdc2tog, hdc in each hdc to end, turn. *1 hdc dec'd.*

Row 24: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to last 3, hdc2tog, hdc in last hdc, turn. *1 hdc dec'd.*

Row 25: Ch 2, hdc2tog, hdc2tog, hdc in each hdc to end, turn. *2 hdc dec'd.*

Rows 26–37: Rep Rows 22–25 three times more. *6 hdc.*

Row 38: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn.

Row 39: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn.

Row 40: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end, turn.

Slip stitch to top edge of cowl and rotate piece 90 degrees to the right. Do not fasten off.

Collar:

Row 1: Ch 2 (does not count as an hdc), hdc in each row, turn. *40 hdc.*

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 4, dc in first hdc, * skip 2 hdc, [dc, ch 1, dc] in next hdc; rep from * to last 3 hdc, skip 2 hdc, dc in last dc.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each dc and ch-1 sp.

Do not fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold cowl in half and join short ends together with a slip-stitch seam.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Note: Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

dec: decrease

hdc: half double crochet

hdc2tog: half double crochet 2 stitches together—Yo, insert hook into indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through all 5 loops.

inc: increase

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sl st: slip stitch

WS: wrong side
