
6(7-8-8-9-10-11) Balls BERROCO FOLIO (50 grs), #4516 Tea Rose Straight knitting needles, size 5 (3.75 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

gauge

24 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Pat St TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

PATTERN STITCH (Multiple of 3 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: * P2, k1, rep from * across. **Row 4:** * P1, k2, rep from * across.

Rep these 4 rows for Pat St.

BACK

Cast on 108(120-132-144-156-168-180) sts. Work even in Pat St for $15\frac{1}{2}$, end on WS. Mark beg and end of last row for beg of armholes. Work even until armholes measure $6(6\frac{1}{2}-7-7\frac{1}{2}-8-8\frac{1}{2}-9)$, end on WS. Bind off. Mark center 48 sts for back neck.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on 54(60-66-72-78-84-90) sts. Work even in Pat St for $15\frac{1}{2}$, end on WS. Mark end of last row for beg of armhole. Work even until armhole measures $6(6\frac{1}{2}-7-7\frac{1}{2}-8-8\frac{1}{2}-9)$, end on WS. Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front until piece measures 15½", end on WS. Mark beg of last row for beg of armhole. Complete as for left front.

SLEEVES

Cast on 54(54-54-54-60-60-60) sts. Work even in Pat St for 1", end on WS.


Inc Row (RS): K1, M1L, work to last st, M1R, k1 – 2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc Row every $1\frac{3}{4}(1\frac{1}{4}-1-\frac{3}{4}-\frac{3}{4}-\frac{3}{4}-\frac{1}{2})$ " 8(11-14-17-17-20-23) times more, working incs into Pat St – 72(78-84-90-96-102-108) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 17" from beg, end on WS. Bind off.



FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neckband: With RS facing, beg at right front edge, pick up and k24 sts across right front neck edge, 48 sts across back neck edge, then 24 sts across left front neck edge – 96 sts. Knit 3 rows. Bind off knitwise.

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
