COWL

With smaller needle, cast on 156 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Purl 3 rnds. Change to larger needle and knit 1 rnd.

Pattern Stitch: Rnd 1: * K1, yo, SSK, k7, k2tog, yo, rep from * around.

Rnd 2 and all even numbered rnds: Knit.

Rnd 3: * K2, yo, SSK, k5, k2tog, yo, k1, rep from * around.

Rnd 5: * K1, (yo, SSK) twice, k3, (k2tog, yo) twice, rep from * around.

Rnd 7: * K2, (yo, SSK) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, rep from * around.

Rnd 9: * k1, (yo, SSK) twice, yo, CDD, (yo, k2tog) twice, yo, rep from * around.

Rnd 11: * K2, (yo, SSK) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, rep from * around.

Rnd 13: * K3, yo, SSK, yo, CDD, yo, k2tog, yo, k2, rep from * around.

Rnd 15: * K4, yo, SSK, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, rep from * around.

Rnd 17: * K5, yo, CDD, yo, k4, rep from * around.

Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 2.

Rep Rnds 1 – 18 four times more. Change to smaller needle and purl 3 rnds. Bind off loosely using larger needle.

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
