STITCH GLOSSARY

All too

Work as a cluster, working only half of each st, yo then draw thru all loops on hook

TR

Triple (treble) crochet

CH-5 PICOT

Ch 5, sl st in 1st ch forming picot

CH-3 PICOT

Ch 3, sl st in 1st ch forming picot

SCARF

Following directions below, work Motif A once. * Work DC Pat for 2½", work Motif B, work Fillet Pat for 2½", work Motif C. Rep from * twice more. Work DC Pat for 2½". Work Motif B.

MOTIF A

With crochet hook, make a slip loop.

Rnd 1: SI st into loop, ch 6, (sc in loop, ch 5) 3 times, join with a sI st in first ch of beg ch-6.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 7 sc's in first ch-5 space, (sc in next sc, ch-5 picot, 7 sc's in next ch-5 space) 3 times, join with a sl st in beg ch-1, ch 2, dc in same ch as last sl st made.

Rnd 3: * Ch 4, skip 1 sc, 1 TR in each of the next 5 sc's, skip 1 sc, ch 4, sl st in next picot, rep from * twice more, ch 4, skip 1 sc, 1 TR in each of the next 5 sc's, skip 1 sc, ch 1, dc in last picot.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, work (1 dc under last dc of previous rnd, 1 TR in picot of previous rnd, 2 dc in next ch-4 space) all tog, ch 5, * work (1 TR in first of 5 TR, 1 dc in each of the next 2 TR) all tog, ch 5, work (1 dc in same TR as last insertion, 1 dc in next TR, 1 TR in next TR) all tog, ch 5, work (2 dc in next ch-4 space, 1 TR in picot of previous rnd, 2 dc in next ch-4

space) all tog, ch 5, rep from * twice more, work (1 TR in first of 5 TR, 1 dc in each of next 2 TR) all tog, ch 5, work (1 dc in same TR as last insertion, 1 dc in next TR, 1 TR in next TR) all tog, ch 5, join with a sl st in top of first group at beg of rnd.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, 6 sc's in first ch-5 space, * work (4 sc's, ch-3 picot, 3 sc's) all in ch-5 space at corner, 6 sc's in next ch-5 space, work (1 sc, ch-3 picot) in top of next group, 6 sc's in next ch-5 space, rep from * twice more, work (4 sc's, ch-3 picot, 3 sc's) all in ch-5 space at corner, 6 sc's in next ch-5 space, work (1 sl st, ch-3 picot) all in beg ch-1. Fasten off.

DC PATTERN

With RS facing, using crochet hook, join yarn with a sl st in corner picot of Motif A.

Row 1: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and ch-1), dc in same picot, ch 3, skip 3 sc's, work (dc, ch 1, dc) all in next sc, * ch 3, skip 4 sc's, work (dc, ch 1, dc) all in next picot, rep from * once more, ch 3, skip 3 sc's, work (dc, ch 1, dc) all in last picot. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and ch-1), dc in next ch-1 space, ch 3, * work (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space, rep from * 3 times more. Turn.

Rep Row 2 for DC Pat.



MOTIF B

Work same as Motif A until Rnd 4 has been completed.

Rnd 5 (Joining Rnd): Ch 1, 6 sc's in first ch-5 space, work (4 sc's, ch 1, sl st between 2 dc's in corner of DC section, ch 1, 3 sc's) all in ch-5 space at corner, sl st between next 2 dc's of DC section, * 6 sc's in next ch-5 space, work (1 sc, ch 1, sl st between next 2 dc's of DC section, ch 1) in top of next group, rep from * once more, work (4 sc's, ch 1, sl st between 2 dc's in corner of DC section, ch 1, 3 sc's) all in ch-5 space at corner, complete same as Rnd 5 of Motif A.

FILLET PATTERN

With RS facing, using crochet hook, join yarn with a sl st in corner picot of Motif B.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as 1 hdc and ch-1), work (skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, ch 1) 4 times, hdc in next picot, ch 1, (skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, ch 1) 4 times, hdc in last picot. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and ch-1), skip ch-1 space, * dc in next dc, ch 1, skip ch-1 space, rep from * across, end dc in 2nd ch of beg ch-3. Turn. Rep Row 2 for Fillet Pat.

MOTIF C

Work same as Motif A until Rnd 4 has been completed.

Rnd 5 (Joining Rnd): Ch 1, 6 dc's in first ch-5 space, work (4 sc's, ch 1, sl st in dc at corner of Fillet Pat section, ch 1, 2 sc's, sl st in next dc of Fillet Pat section, sc) all in ch-5 space at corner, * work (2 sc, sl st in next dc of Fillet Pat section)3 times all in next ch-5 space, work (sc, ch 1, sl st in next dc of Fillet Pat section, ch 1) in top of next group, rep from * once more, work (2 sc's, sl st in next dc of Fillet Pat section, 2 sc's, ch 1, sl st in last dc at corner of Fillet Pat section, ch 1, 3 sc's) all in ch-5 space at corner, complete same as Rnd 5 of Motif A.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: establishedinc: increaseK: knit

KSP: Knit 1, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift 2nd stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on RH needle (1 stitch decreased).

K2SP: Knit 2 together, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift second stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on right hand needle (2 stitches decreased).

LH: left hand **lp(s):** loop(s)

LT2 (Left Twist): Skip 1 stitch, knit second stitch through back loop, then knit both stitches together through back loop

MC: main color

M1k: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch (1 stitch increased).

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2sso:** pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

RT2 (Right Twist): Knit 2 stitches together, leaving them on the left hand needle, then knit the first stitch again slipping both stitches to the right hand needle.

SKP: slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over

sl: slip

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2

together.
st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. Reverse St **st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

bphdc (back post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on even # or wrong side rows).

bptr (back post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from back to front around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

fphdc (front post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on odd # or right side rows)

fptr (front post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

hdc: half double crochet

hdctbl: Half double crochet worked in the back loop **hdctfl:** Half double crochet worked in the front loop

sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
