skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Approximately 4" long x 2" across (bottom of foot)

BERROCO SUEDE (50 grs): 1 ball #3717 Wild Bill Hickock (MC) BERROCO PLUSH (50 grs): 1 ball #1901 Cream (CC)

needles and notions

1 set (4) double pointed needles (dpns), size 5 (3.75 mm) or size to obtain gauge Crochet hook, size 3.25 mm (D) 2 st markers Sewing needle and matching

thread gauge

22 sts and 30 rows = 4'' in St st with MC To save time, take time to check gauge

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NOTE: We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. BOOTIES (Make 2)

Instep: With 2 dpns, using MC, cast on 7 sts, Knit 1 row.

Inc Row: K1, M1, knit to last st, M1, k1 - 9 sts. Rep the last 2 rows once more - 11 sts. Knit 1 row. Mark beg and end of last row.

Eyelet Row: (K2tog, yo, k1) twice, yo, SSK, k1, yo, SSK – 11 sts (4 eyelets made). Work even in Garter St until piece measures 1½" above Eyelet Row. Bind off.

Cuff: With 1 dpns, using CC, cast on 28 sts. Work even in Garter St for 1½". Break off CC.

Foot: SI 14 sts of cuff, without working them; join MC and p14, pick up and knit 8 sts along right side edge of instep, 10 sts across bound-off edge of instep, 8 sts along left side edge of instep then purl remaining 14 sts of cuff – 54 sts. Divide sts onto 3 dpns. Place marker and join for working in the round.

Rnd 1: K27, pm, knit to end.


Rnds 2 and 3: Knit, slipping markers.

Dec Rnd: * K1, k2tog, knit to 3 sts before marker, SSK, k1, sm, rep from * once more – 50 sts. Rep the last 3 rnds (Rnds 2 and 3 and Dec Rnd) twice more – 42 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Divide sts onto 2 needles (sts on one side of markers on one needle and sts on the other side of markers on second needle). Graft sts together using Kitchener st.

FINISHING

Cuff Edging: With RS facing, using crochet hook and CC, work 1 row single crochet across top of instep between markers.

Tie: Using crochet hook and MC, make a chain 20" long. Sew center of tie to center back edge of bootie at base of cuff. Fold cuff down to outside over tie and slip stitch in place to first rnd of MC, using sewing needle and thread. Weave free ends of tie through eyelets of instep so they meet in center, then tie ends in a bow. Weave in all ends.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

k: kni

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

MC: main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

pm: place marker
rep: repeat
rnd(s): round(s)

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)
yo: yarn over

Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
