16" Length circular knitting needles, sizes 4 (3.50 mm) and 6 (4.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

1 Set (4) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 6 (4.00 mm)

6 Hanging st markers (5 in one color and 1 a different color)

Tapestry needle

gauge

22 sts and 28 rnds = 4" in St st on size 6 (4.00 mm) needles

STITCH GLOSSARY

Wrap & Turn

Bring yarn to front of work, slip next st to RH needle, bring yarn to back of work, sl same st back to LH needle. Turn work.

CDD (Centered Double Decrease)

Work to 1 st before marked st. Sl 2 sts together knitwise, k1, pass 2 sl sts together over k1 – 2 sts decreased.

HAT

With smaller circular needle, using CC, cast on 108 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd with different colored marker and carry marker up. Work even in k2, p2 ribbing for 1". Join MC and change to larger circular needle.

Make Braid: Rnd 1: * K1 with MC, k1 with CC, rep from * around.

Rnd 2: Wrap & turn. Note: Pull out several yards from each ball of yarn. As you work this rnd, the yarns will be twisting around each other. You will untwist the yarns on the following rnd. * K1 with CC, bring MC under CC and k1 with MC, bring CC under MC, rep from * around.

Rnd 3: * K1 with CC, bring MC over CC and k1 with MC, bring CC over MC, rep from * around. Wrap & turn.

Inc Rnd: With MC, * k1, M1, k2, M1, rep from * around – 180 sts. With MC, knit 3 rnds. Work 13 rnds of Chart 1, then work 38 rnds of Chart 2, decreasing as indicated on chart – 12 sts. As you decrease, when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns, dividing sts onto 3 needles.



Final Rnd: With CC, (SSK) 6 times – 6 sts. Break off yarns. Thread end of CC into tapestry needle. Draw through all sts on needles, pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off.

Chart 1: Work the 6-st repeat 30 times around each rnd.

Chart 2: Work the 30-st repeat 6 times around each rnd. Place a hanging marker on the first st of each pattern rep, and move marker up every few rnds.

For dec rnds (beginning with rnd 7), work to 1 st before the end of rnd, working the first CDD using the last st of the previous rnd and the first 2 sts of the dec rnd.

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ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
