gauge

12 sts = 4"; 20 rows = 4" in St st TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

BACK

First Leg

With straight needles, using MC, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Inc 1, k2, inc 1 – 6 sts.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: K1, (Inc 1) 4 times, k1 – 10 sts.

Row 5: K8, WTS, p5, WTS, k7 – 10 sts.

Row 7: K2, SSK, k2, k2 tog, k2 – 8 sts.

Rows 9, 11, 13 and 15: Knit - 8 sts.

Row 17: K1, SSK, k2, k2 tog, k1 – 6 sts. Break off

yarn and sl 6 sts to st holder.

Second Leg

Work same as for 1st Leg, end on Row 17, leaving sts on needle.

Joining Row (WS): Purl 6 sts, cast on 1 st, purl 6 sts from holder – 13 sts.

BODY

Row 1: K4, Inc 1, k3, Inc 1, k4 – 15 sts.

Row 2 and all WS rows (unless otherwise

specified): Purl.

Row 3: K2, Inc 1, (k4, Inc 1) twice, k2 – 18 sts.

Row 5: K16, WTS, p13, WTS, k12, WTS, p11, WTS,

k10, WTS, p9, WTS, k13 – 18 sts.

Row 7: K5, SSK, k4, k2 tog, k5 – 16 sts.

Row 9: (K1, SSK) twice, k4, k2 tog, k1, k2 tog, k1 –

12 sts.

Row 11: K2, SSK, k4, k2 tog, k2 – 10 sts.

Row 13: Knit.

Row 14 (WS): Purl 10, then cast on 9 sts (first arm)

– 19 sts.

Row 15: K9 (1st arm), k10, then cast on 9 sts

(second arm) - 28 sts.

Rows 17, 19 and 21: Knit - 28 sts.

Row 23: Knit.

Row 25: Bind off 9 sts, k to end – 19 sts.

Row 26 (WS): Bind off 9 sts purlwise, p to end –

10 sts.

HEAD

Row 1 (RS): SSK, k6, k2 tog – 8 sts.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: Inc 1, k1, Inc 1, k2, Inc 1, k1, Inc 1 – 12 sts.

Row 5: Inc 1, k3, Inc 1, k2, Inc 1, k3, WTS, p11, WTS,

k10, WTS, p9, WTS, k10, Inc 1 – 16 sts.

Row 7: Inc 1, k3, Inc 1, k6, Inc 1, k3, Inc 1 – 20 sts.

Row 9: K4, Inc 1, k10, Inc 1, k4 – 22 sts.

Row 11: Knit.

Row 13: K5, SSK, k8, k2 tog, k5 – 20 sts.

Row 15: K2, SSK, (k5, k2 tog) twice, k2 – 17 sts.

Row 17: SSK, k13, WTS, p12, WTS, k10, WTS, p8,

WTS, k6, WTS, p4, WTS, k8, k2 tog – 15 sts.

Row 19: K5, sl sts to holder, bind off 5 sts, k to end – 5 sts.

First Ear: Purl 5.

Row 1 (RS): (Inc 1, k1) twice, Inc 1 – 8 sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit – 8 sts.

Row 4: P2 tog, p4, p2 tog – 6 sts.

Row 5: K2 tog, k2, k2 tog – 4 sts.

Row 6: Bind off as follows: K2 tog twice. Bind off last 2 sts.

Second Ear: With WS facing, join MC and purl 5 sts from holder.

Work same as for 1st ear.

FRONT

First Leg: With straight needles, using MC, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Inc 1, k2, Inc 1 – 6 sts.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: K1, (Inc 1) 4 times, k1 – 10 sts.

Row 5: K8, WTS, p5, WTS, k4, WTS, p3, WTS, k6 – 10 sts.

Row 7: K3, SSK, k2 tog, k3 – 8 sts. **Rows 9, 11 and 13:** Knit – 8 sts.

Row 15: Knit.

Row 17: K1, SSK, k2, k2 tog, k1 – 6 sts. Break off yarn and sl 6 sts to st holder.

Second Leg: Work same as for 1st Leg, end on Row

17, leaving sts on needle.

Joining Row (WS): Purl 6, cast on 1 st, purl 6 sts

from holder – 13 sts.

BODY

Row 1 (RS): K5, Inc 1, k1, Inc 1, k5 – 15 sts. Row 2 and all WS rows (unless otherwise

specified): Purl.

Row 3: Inc 1, k5, Inc 1, k1, Inc 1, k5, Inc 1 – 19 sts.

Row 5: K15, WTS, p10, WTS, k8, WTS, p6, WTS, k4,

WTS, p2,

WTS, k10 – 19 sts.

Row 7: K5, SSK, k5, k2 tog, k5 – 17 sts.

Row 9: K4, SSK, k5, k2 tog, k4 – 15 sts.

Row 11: K2, SSK, k7, k2 tog, k2 – 13 sts. Row 13: Knit.

Row 14 (WS): P13, then cast on 9 sts (1st arm) – 22 sts.

Row 15: K9 (first arm), k13, then cast on 9 sts (second arm) – 31 sts.

Row 17: K12, SSK, k3, k2 tog, k12 - 29 sts.

Row 19: Knit - 29 sts.

Row 21: K11, SSK, k3, k2 tog, k11 - 27 sts.

Row 23: Knit.

Row 25: Bind off 9 sts, k to end – 18 sts.

Row 26 (WS): Bind off 9 sts purlwise, p to end – 9 sts.

HFAD

Row 1 (RS): SSK, k5, k2 tog – 7 sts.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: (K1, Inc 1) 3 times, k1 – 10 sts.

Row 5: (Inc 1) twice, k1, (Inc 1) 4 times, k1, (Inc 1) twice – 18 sts.

Row 7: K2, Inc 1, k3, Inc 1, k4, Inc 1, k2, WTS, p11, WTS, k9, WTS, p7, WTS, k5, WTS, p3, WTS, k8, Inc 1, k2 – 22 sts.

Row 9: Knit.

Row 11: K1, Inc 1, k5, (SSK) twice, (k2 tog) twice, k5, Inc 1, k1 – 20 sts.

Row 13: K9, k2 tog, k9 – 19 sts.

Row 15: K2, SSK, k11, k2 tog, k2 – 17 sts.

Row 17: SSK, k13, WTS, p12, WTS, k10, WTS, p8, WTS, k6, WTS, p4, WTS, k8, k2 tog – 15 sts.

Row 19: K5, sl these sts onto holder, bind off 5 sts, k to end – 5 sts.

Ears: Work same as for back ears.

FINISHING

Sew back and front of bear together, leaving ears and bound-off sts at top of head open for stuffing. Stuff legs and arms first, making them quite firm. Stuff body next, being sure to stuff lightly so that bear is huggable. Stuff muzzle next, then head. This makes the muzzle stand out. Sew bound-off sts and ears tog. Embroider the face with embroidery floss as in photo.

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cn: cable needle

dpn: double pointed needles

KSP: Knit 1, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift 2nd stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on RH needle (1 stitch decreased).

K2SP: Knit 2 together, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift second stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on right hand needle (2 stitches decreased).

LH: left hand **lp(s):** loop(s)

LT2 (Left Twist): Skip 1 stitch, knit second stitch through back loop, then knit both stitches together through back loop

MC: main color

M1k: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch (1 stitch increased).

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2sso:** pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

RT2 (Right Twist): Knit 2 stitches together, leaving them on the left hand needle, then knit the first stitch again slipping both stitches to the right hand needle.

SKP: slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over

sl: slip

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2

together.
st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. Reverse St **st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

bphdc (back post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on even # or wrong side rows).

bptr (back post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from back to front around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

fphdc (front post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on odd # or right side rows)

fptr (front post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

hdc: half double crochet

hdctbl: Half double crochet worked in the back loop **hdctfl:** Half double crochet worked in the front loop

sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
