finished measurements

Approximately 18(20-22)" around
x 8½" high (unstretched)

Yarn

BERROCO ULTRA WOOL (100 grs):
1 ball each #33116 Chickpea (MC),
#3327 Kabocha (CC1), and #3301
Cream (CC2)

needles and notions

16" length circular needles, sizes 4
(3.5 mm) and 6 (4.00 mm) or size
to obtain gauge

1 set (4) double-pointed needles
(dpns), size 6 (4.00 mm)
1 st marker
Tapestry needle
Pompom maker

gauge

26 sts and 26 rnds = 4" in
charted pat

*To save time, take time to check
gauge*

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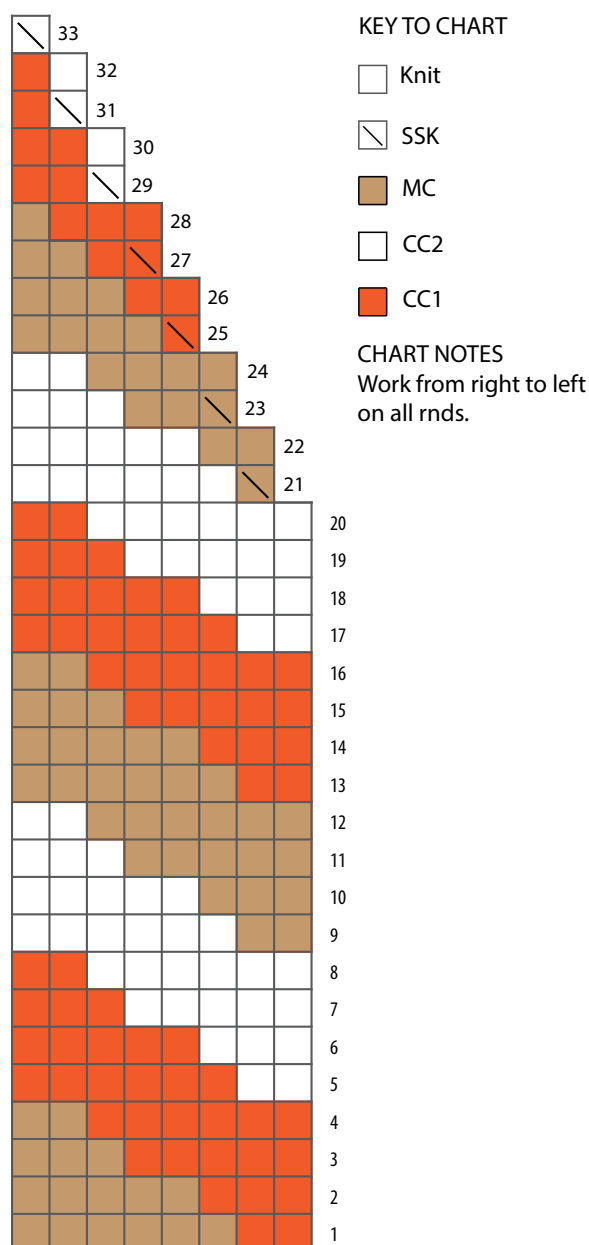
NOTE: We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

NOTES

When changing colors, hold yarn to the left and pick up new color from underneath. This twists yarn so there are no holes.

Do not carry yarn across more than 4 sts without twisting colors together to prevent long loops.



HAT

With smaller circular needle, using MC, and tubular cast-on method, cast on 104(120-136) sts. Place marker and join for working in the round.

Set-Up Ribbing: Rnd 1: * K1, p1, rep from * around. Work even in ribbing as established until ribbing measures 3" from beginning. Change to larger circular needle. Knit 2 rounds in MC.

Join CC1 and work even, following Chart until Rnd 20 has been completed, joining CC2 on Rnd 5.

Note: As you decrease for crown, when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns, dividing sts onto 3 needles.

Shape Crown: Work Rnds 21–33 of Chart, decreasing on every other rnd as indicated on chart—13(15-17) sts.

Next Rnd: With CC, * SSK, rep from * to last st, end k1—7(8-9) sts. Break yarn, leaving an 8" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure, then fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired. Make pom-pom using desired colors of yarn (we used all 3 colors). Shape pom-pom, then attach to crown of hat.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

CC: contrasting color

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

k: knit

MC: main color

p: purl

rnd(s): round(s)

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)
