16" Length circular knitting needles, sizes 3 (3.25 mm) and 5 (3.75 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
1 Set (4) double pointed knitting needles (dpn), size 5 (3.75 mm)
1 St marker
Tapestry needle

gauge

22 sts and 38 rnds = 4" in k1, p1 ribbing with smaller needle
23 sts and 32 rnds = 4" in Pat St with larger needle

STITCH GLOSSARY

CDD – Centered Double Dec

Sl 2 sts tog as if to k2 tog, k1, pass 2 sl sts tog over k1 (2 sts dec'd)

PATTERN STITCH (Multiple of 14 sts)

Rnds 1 and 3: Knit.

Rnds 2 and 4: Purl.

Rnds 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15 and 17: Knit.

Rnds 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16 and 18: * K11, p3, rep from * around.

Rep these 18 rnds for Pat St.

HAT

With smaller circular needle, cast on 90 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Work even in k1, p1 ribbing for 1". Change to larger needle.

Inc Rnd: (K2, M1) 40 times, (k1, M1) 10 times – 140 sts. Work even in Pat St until 3 repeats (54 rnds) have been completed, end on Rnd 18.

Note: As you decrease for top, when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns and divide sts onto 3 needles.

Shape Top: Dec Rnd 1: K4, * CDD, k11, rep from * to last 10 sts, CDD, k to end – 120 sts. Work 3 rnds even in pat as established (Rnds 2 – 4 of pat).

Dec Rnd 2: K3, * CDD, k9, rep from * to last 9 sts, CDD, k to end – 100 sts. Work 3 rnds even (Rnds 6-8 of pat, working even rnds as * k7, p3, rep from * around).

Dec Rnd 3: K2, * CDD, k7, rep from * to last 8 sts, CDD, k to end – 80 sts. Work 3 rnds even (Rnds 10-



12 of pat, working even rnds as * k5, p3, rep from * around).

Dec Rnd 4: K1, * CDD, k5, rep from * to last 7 sts, CDD, k to end – 60 sts. Work 3 rnds even (Rnds 14-16 of pat, working even rnds as * k3, p3, rep from * around).

Dec Rnd 5: * CDD, k3 rep from * around – 40 sts.

Next Rnd: * K1, p3, rep from * around.

Dec Rnd 6: * P2tog, rep from * around – 20 sts. Knit 1 rnd.

Dec Rnd 7: Rep Dec Rnd 6 – 10 sts. Break off yarn, leaving a 12" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off.

CDD (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
