#### finished measurements

Approximately 10" around belly (at widest point) x 7" high

#### materials

1 Ball each BERROCO KODIAK (50 grs), #7002 Frost (A) and #7034 Puffin (B)

1 Hank BERROCO CIRRUS (25 grs), #2541 Sand Dollar (C)

1 Set (5) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 10 (6.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

1 St marker

Tapestry needle

Sewing needle and white thread Small amount of fiber fill stuffing

#### gauge

12 sts and 21 rnds = 4" in St st with A and Cheld tog TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK **GAUGE**

**NOTE:** We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

#### **NOTE**

Body and head are shaped using short rows. When working these rows, you will work part way across, then turn and purl back, leaving some sts unworked.

#### STITCH GLOSSARY

**CDD:** Sl 2 sts tog as if to k2tog, k next st, pass 2 sl sts together over k1 – 2 sts dec'd.

**Wrap and Turn:** When knitting, bring yarn to the front, sl next st to RH needle, turn, bring yarn to the front, sl same st to RH needle, bring yarn across slipped st and purl as directed - slipped st is now a wrapped st.

When purling, sl next st to RH needle, bring yarn across slipped st and to the back, turn, sl same st to RH needle, bring yarn across slipped st to the back, then knit as directed – slipped st is now a wrapped st. When knitting, each time you come to a wrapped st, lift wrap back over st and onto LH needle, then knit wrap tog with its accompanying st.

#### **BODY**

**Base:** With 2 dpns, using long-tail cast-on and 1 strand each of A and C held tog, cast on 12 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row, end on WS.

**Next Rnd (RS):** K7 with first needle; using second needle, k5, then pick up and k2 sts along side edge of base; with third needle, pick up and k7 sts along cast-on edge of base; with fourth needle, pick up and k5 sts along cast-on edge of base, then 2 sts along side edge of base – 28 sts (7 sts on each of 4 needles). Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Knit 10 rnds.



**Shape Belly: Short Rows:** K10, wrap and turn; p8, wrap and turn; k6, wrap and turn; p4, wrap and turn. Knit the next row, each time you come to a wrapped st, lift wrap back over st onto LH needle and knit it tog with its accompanying st – 28 sts. Knit 4 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 1:** \* SSK, k8, k2tog, k2, rep from \* once more – 24 sts. Knit 4 rnds.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \* SSK, k6, (k2tog) twice, rep from \* once more – 18 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Change to B.

#### **HEAD**

**Inc Rnd:** \* M1, k8, M1, k2, rep from \* once more – 22 sts. Knit 2 rnds.

**Short Rows:** K7, wrap and turn; p4, wrap and turn; k12, wrap and turn, p4, wrap and turn, k to end – 22 sts. Knit 1 rnd.

**Dec Rnd 3:** \* K4, CDD, k4, rep from \* once more – 18 sts.

**Short Rows:** K6, wrap and turn; p3, wrap and turn; k12, wrap and turn, p3, wrap and turn, k to end – 18 sts.

**Dec Rnd 4:** \* K2, CDD, k3, CDD, rep from \* once more – 10 sts. Break off yarn, leaving an 8" long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through sts on needles. Stuff body and head with fiber fill. Pull sts up tightly and secure. Fasten off.

### WINGS (Make 2)

With 2 dpns, using 1 strand each of A and C held tog, cast on 4 sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row. **Dec Row 1 (RS):** K1, SSK, k2 – 4 sts. Purl 1 row, knit

1 row, purl 1 row.

**Dec Row 2 (RS):** K1, CDD, k1 – 3 sts. Purl 1 row.

Dec Row 3 (RS): CDD - 1 st. Fasten off.

#### **FACE**

With 2 dpns, using A and long-tail method, cast on 5 sts

Row 1 and all WS rows: Purl.

**Row 2:** K in front and back of first st, k to end – 6 sts.

Row 4: Bind off 1 st, k to end – 5 sts.

Row 6: Cast on 1 st, k to end – 6 sts.

**Row 8:** SSK, k to end – 5 sts.

Row 9: Purl. Bind off.

## EYES (Make 2)

Cut two 3" long strands of B. Tie 3 knots in the center of one strand, right next to each other. Using tapestry needle, draw free ends of strand from RS to WS of face, centering knots (eye) over widest point of face, then tie ends together. Repeat with second strand over the other widest point of face.

#### **BFAK**

With 2 dpns, using B, cast on 3 sts. Knit 3 rows. **Dec Row:** CDD – 1 st. Fasten off leaving tail for sewing.

#### **FINISHING**

Using sewing needle and thread, sew face to center front of head. Sew beak to face centered between the 2 eyes. Sew cast-on edge of one wing to each side of body 1 rnd before start of head.

**Feet (Make 2):** With 2 dpns, using B, pick up and k3 sts along front of body at point where sts are picked up along base. Knit 3 rows.

**Dec Row (RS):** CDD – 1 st. Fasten off. Repeat for second foot (inner edges of feet should be approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  apart at center front.

#### ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

#### Knit

**beg:** beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together,

knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

**LH:** left hand **MC:** main color

**M1:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**M1pL:** Work as for M1p.

**M1pR:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**p:** purl

**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

**psso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip

sm: slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand

needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

**TBL:** through back loop(s)

**tog:** together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. **GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
