skill level: Intermediate

One size

finished measurements

Approximately 29" wide x 16" long

Note: Each repeat of chart (64 sts)
measures approximately 12" wide.

To widen your curtain panel, cast
64 sts more for each 12" you wish
to add. Each repeat of Rows 39-56
measures 3". To lengthen your
curtain panel, work 1 more repeat
of Rows 39-56 for each 3" you wish
to add. Make sure to adjust yarn
amounts accordingly.

materials

2 Hanks **BERROCO INDIGO** (100 grs),
#6402 Cut-offs

29" Length circular knitting needle,
size 6 (4.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN
GAUGE

Straight knitting needles, size 6 (4.00
mm)

2 St markers

gauge

21 sts and 26 rows = 4" in charted
pat after blocking

NOTE

Curtain panel is worked from the top down. Cast-on edge will be top edge of curtain.

CURTAIN PANEL

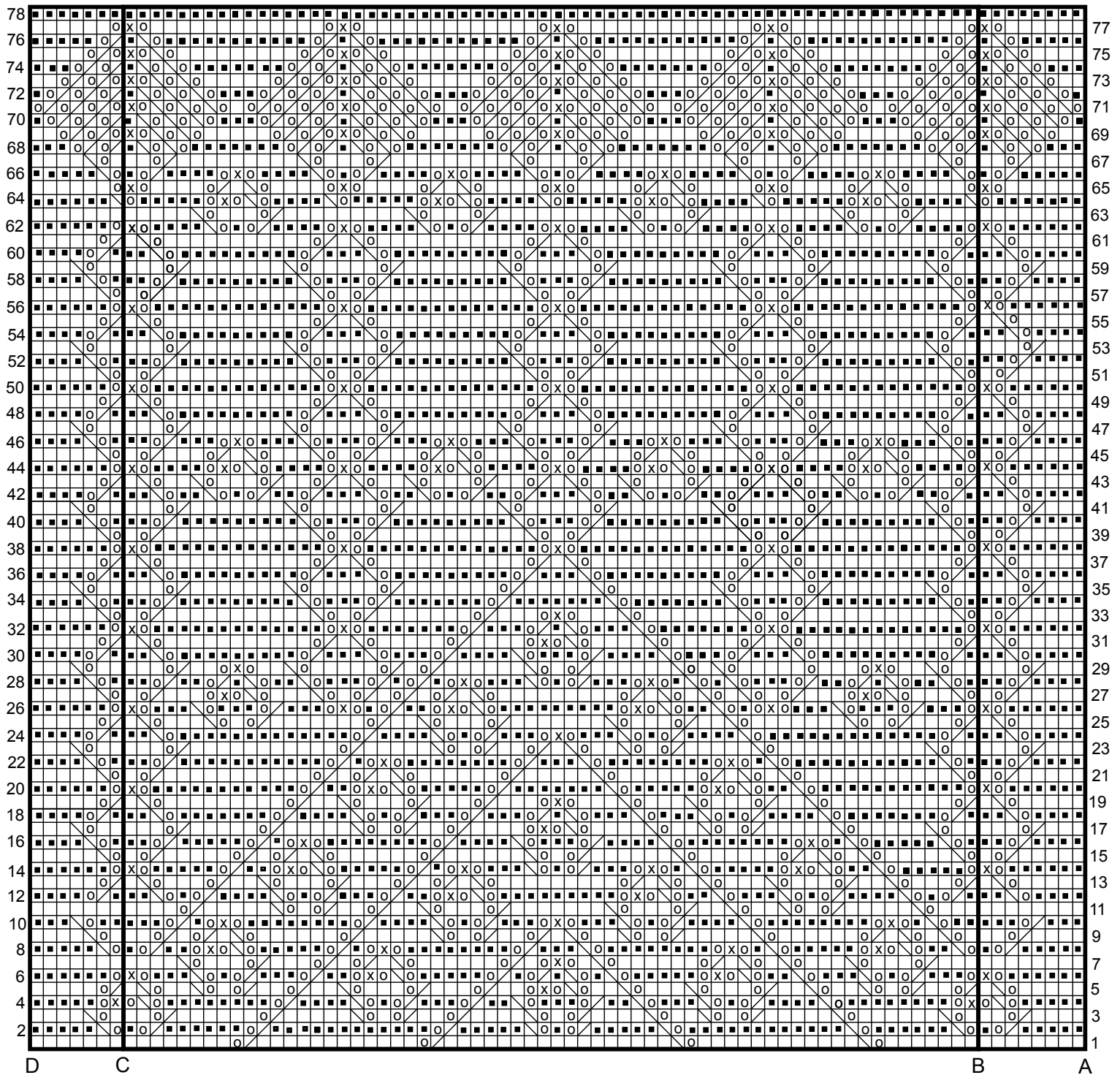
With circular needle, cast on 149 sts. DO NOT join. Knit 5 rows, end on WS.

Establish Chart: Row 1 (RS): K3, place marker, work Row 1 of Chart to last 3 sts, place marker, k3.
Row 2: K to first marker, work Row 2 of Chart to last marker, k to end. Work even in pat as established until chart has been completed and/or piece measures desired length, end on WS. Knit 4 rows. Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Curtain Tabs: With RS facing, using straight needles, beg at right edge (as it faces you) of cast-on edge, pick up and k5 sts. Knit 28 rows. Bind off. Fold bound-off edge to WS and sew to cast-on edge of curtain panel. In this manner, make 4 more curtain tabs, one at left edge, one in center and the others spaced evenly between. **Note:** If you are widening your curtain panel, add more curtain tabs, spacing evenly along cast-on edge. Wet block or steam curtain panel.

CHART NOTES

On RS, beg at A, work to C, rep between B and C, end at D.

On WS, beg at D, work to B, rep between C and B, end at A.

Work Rows 1-56, rep Rows 39-56 twice more, then work Rows 57-78.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
