Approximately 60" across (top edge) x 14" long (at center) before blocking

Materials

2 balls BERROCO FOLIO (50 grs), #4540 Pebble Straight knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge 2 double-pointed needles (dpn), size 8 (5.00 mm) 2 st markers 1 st holder

gauge

19 sts and 25 rows = 4" in St st To save time, take time to check gauge

NOTE

This shawl starts with a center point. When the point is completed, the Lace Pat is established with St st on each side and increases outward. When the Lace Pat has been completed, the center sts are bound off and the tails are worked out on each side.

LACE PATTERN (Worked over 12 sts)

Row 1 (RS): [K2, yo, SSK] 3 times. **Row 2:** [P2, yo, p2tog] 3 times. Rep these 2 rows for Lace Pat.

SHAWL

Center Point: With straight needles, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K1, yo, k2, yo, k1 – 6 sts.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: [K2, yo] twice, k2 – 8 sts.

Row 5: [P2, k1] twice, p2.

Row 6: K2, p1, yo, k2, yo, p1, k2 – 10 sts.

Row 7: [P2, k2] twice, p2.

Row 8: K2, p2, yo, k2, yo, p2, k2 – 12 sts.

Row 9: [P2, k3] twice, p2.

Row 10: K2, p3, yo, k2, yo, p3, k2 – 14 sts.

Row 11: [P2, k4] twice, p2.

Row 12: K2, p4, yo, k2, yo, p4, k2 – 16 sts.

Row 13: [P2, k5] twice, p2.

Row 14: K2, p5, yo, k2, yo, p5, k2 – 18 sts.

Row 15: [P2, k6] twice, p2.

Establish Lace Pat: Row 16 (RS): K2, yo, k1, yo, place marker, work Row 1 of Lace Pat over 12 sts, place marker, yo, k1, yo, k2 – 22 sts.

Row 17: Purl to first marker, work Row 2 of Lace Pat to last marker, purl to end.

Row 18 (RS): K2, yo, knit to marker, yo, sl marker, work Lace Pat to last marker, sl marker, yo, knit to last 3 sts, yo, k2 – 26 sts.

Row 19: Purl to first marker, work Lace Pat to last marker, purl to end. Rep Rows 18 and 19 thirty-one times more, end on WS – 150 sts.



Divide for Tails: Next Row (RS): K2, yo, knit to first marker, drop marker, yo, k2, place sts you just worked on a holder for right tail; bind off 8 sts, k1, drop marker, yo, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2 – 73 sts.

Left Tail: Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, p2tog, yo, k2.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K2, * yo, p2tog, rep from * to last 5 sts, p3tog, yo, k1 – 72 sts.

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: K2, yo, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, p2tog, yo, k2.

Row 7: Purl.

Row 8 (RS): K2, yo, SSSK, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end p1, k2tog, yo, k2 – 71 sts.

Row 9: P4, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end k1, p4.

Row 10: K2, yo, SSSK, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 4 sts, end k2tog yo, k2 – 70 sts.

Row 11: P4, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 4 sts, end p4. Rep Rows 8 – 11 until 8 sts remain, end on RS. Purl 1 row. SI first 4 sts to one dpn and last 4 sts to second dpn. Fold sts with WS tog and weave together using Kitchener St or work 3-needle bind-off.

Right Tail: SI 73 sts from holder to straight needle prepared to work a WS row and join yarn.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, p2tog, yo, k2.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K2, * yo, p2tog, rep from * to last 5 sts, end p3tog, yo, k2 – 72 sts.

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: K2, yo, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, end p2tog,

yo, k2.

Row 7: Purl.

Row 8: K2, yo, SSK, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts,

end k3tog, yo, k2 - 71 sts.


Row 9: P5, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end k1, p4.

Row 10: K2, yo, SSK, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 6 sts, end p1, k3tog, yo, k2 – 70 sts.

Row 11: P3, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end k1, p4. Rep Rows 8 – 11 until 8 sts remain, end on RS. Purl 1 row. Complete same as left tail.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

CDD (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needlecont: continuedec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

est: established inc: increase k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)k2tog: knit 2 stitches togetherk3tog: knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase – Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

MC: main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase – Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together

st(s): stitch(es)

tbl: through back loop(s)

tog: together

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. *On RS rows:* With yarn held in front, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle, then bring the yarn to the back again. Turn your work. *On WS Rows:* With yarn held in back, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
