Approximately 22" wide x 72" long

materials

4 hanks BERROCO MODERN COTTON (100 grs), #1601 Sandy Point (A) and 3 hanks #1611 Rocky Point

Straight knitting needles, size 7 (4.50 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Tapestry needle

gauge

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" in St st TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

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NOTE: We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

NOTE

Borders are worked first in Lace Pat. Sts are then picked up along the side edge of 1 border and worked in St st with Garter St edging to end. Live sts are then grafted onto the side edge of the second border.

LACE PATTERN

Note: Due to the nature of this pat, the number of sts will vary from row to row. The number following each row is the number of sts you will have after completing that row.

Rows 1 and 3 (RS): K3, [yo, p2tog] twice, yo, k1TBL, k2tog, p1, SSK, k1TBL, yo, k3 – 17 sts.

Rows 2 and 4 (WS): K3, p3, k1, p3, k2, [yo, p2tog] twice, k1 – 17 sts.

Row 5: K3, [yo, p2tog] twice, yo, k1TBL, yo, k2tog, p1, SSK, yo, k4 – 18 sts.

Row 6: K4, p2, k1, p4, k2, [yo, p2tog] twice, k1 – 18 sts. **Row 7:** K3, [yo, p2tog] twice, yo, k1TBL, k1, k1TBL, yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k5 – 19 sts.

Row 8: K5, p7, k2, [yo, p2tog] twice, k1 – 19 sts.

Row 9: K3, [yo, p2tog] twice, yo, k1TBL, k3, k1TBL, yo, k7 – 21 sts.

Row 10: Bind off 4 sts, k2, p7, k2, [yo, p2tog] twice, k1 – 17 sts.

Rep these 10 rows for Lace Pat.

PATTERN STITCH (Multiple of 12 sts + 17)


Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): K4, p9, * k3, p9, rep from* to last 4 sts, end k4.

Rep these 2 rows for Pat St.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Working in Pat St, work 33 rows B, (2 rows A, 4 rows B) twice, 2 rows A, 34 rows B, 34 rows A, (2 rows B, 4 rows A) twice, 2 rows B, 34 rows A, (2 rows B, 2 rows A) 24 times, 2 rows B, 34 rows A, (2 rows B, 4 rows A) twice, 2 rows B, 34 rows A, 34 rows B, (2 rows A, 4 rows B) twice, 2 rows A, 34 rows B.



BORDERS (Make 2)

With A, cast on 17 sts. Work even in Lace Pat until 13 repeats (130 rows) have been completed, end with Row 10. Bind off.

SHAWL

With RS facing, using B, pick up and knit 101 sts along long straight edge of first Border. Beg with Row 2, work even in Pat St, following Stripe Sequence until Stripe Sequence has been completed, end with a WS row. Break off yarn, leaving a 48" long end. Leave sts on needle.

FINISHING

Thread end into tapestry needle. Insert needle through first st on LH needle from back to front, pulling yarn through. Insert needle under first st on straight edge of second border, pulling yarn through. Insert needle through first st on LH needle from front to back, pulling yarn through and slipping st off LH needle. In this manner, continue joining live sts on LH needle to straight edge of border until all sts have been joined. Weave in all ends. Block as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needlecont: continuedec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: establishedinc: increaseK: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) **k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together **k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand **MC:** main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2toq:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. With yarn held in back, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle, then bring the yarn to the back again. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. **GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on

straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
