

Lower Edge - 64(68½-73-75½)" Length - 31" (not including fringe and collar)

yarn

BERROCO VINTAGE CHUNKY (100 grs): 11(13-14-15) hanks #6152 Mistletoe

needles and notions

36" and 16" length circular needles, size 10 (6.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge 6 st markers Waste yarn to hold sts Crochet hook, size 6.00 mm (J)

gauge

14 sts and 21 rows = 4'' in St st To save time, take time to check gauge

NOTE

This cape is made all in one piece from the lower edge up.

CAPE

With longer circular needle, cast on 224(240-256-264) sts. Do not join.

Edging: Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2 (RS): K1, * yo, SSK, rep from * to last st, end

k1.

Row 3: Knit.

Establish Front Bands: Row 1 (RS): K1, p1, k1, pm, knit to last 3 sts, pm, k1, p1, k1.

Row 2: K1, p1, k1, sm, purl to last marker, sm, k1, p1, k1. Work even in pat as established until piece measures 12" from beg, end on WS.

Divide for Armholes: Next Row (RS): Using shorter circular needle, k1, p1, k1, sm, k32. Leave remaining sts on longer circular needle.

Right Front: Work even in pat as established on 35 sts until piece measures 8" above dividing row, end on RS. SI sts and marker to waste yarn for right front.

Sides and Back: Next Row (RS): Join yarn to first st on longer circular needle. K154(170-186-194), sl remaining 35 sts to waste yarn for left front. Beg with a purl row, work even in St st until piece measures 8" above dividing row, end on RS. Sl sts to waste yarn for sides and back.

Left Front: Next Row (RS): SI 35 sts from waste yarn to shorter circular needle. Join yarn to first st. Knit to marker, sm, k1, p1, k1. Work even in pat as established until piece measures 8" above dividing row, end on RS.

Joining Row (WS): Using longer circular needle, k1, p1, k1, sm, p32 sts of left front, purl 154(170-186-194) sts of sides and back from waste yarn then work 35 sts of right front from waste yarn – 224(240-256-264) sts. Work 2 rows even in pat as established.



Establish Raglan Decs: Next Row (RS): Working in pat as established work 35 sts, pm, k42(50-58-62), pm, k70, pm, k42(50-58-62), pm, work 35 sts. Work 1 WS row even.

Dec Row (RS): Work to 3 sts before first marker, SSK, k1, sm, k1, k2tog, * work to 3 sts before next marker, SSK, k1, sm, k1, k2tog, rep from * twice more, work to end – 8 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 4 rows 10(8-6-4) times more, then every RS row 7(11-15-19) sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when 21 sts remain at each front edge before first and after last marker, end on WS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Work 7 sts, sl these sts to holder, work to end, continuing to work raglan decs as before.

Following Row (WS): Work 7 sts, sl these sts to holder, work to end. Continuing to work raglan decs as before, bind off 2 sts at beg of the next 4 rows, then dec 1 st at beg and end of the next 4 RS rows. When all raglan and neck decs have been completed, end on WS – 58 sts. Break off yarn.

FINISHING

Collar: With RS facing, using shorter circular needle, join yarn at right front edge, knit 7 sts from

holder, pick up and knit 8 sts along right front neck edge, knit 58 sts from longer circular needle, pick up and knit 8 sts along left front neck edge, then knit 7 sts from second holder – 80 sts.

Set-Up Rib: Row 1 (WS): P3, * k2, p2, rep from * to last st, end p1.

Row 2 (RS): K3, * p2, k2, rep from * to last st, end k1. Rep these 2 rows until collar measures 4", end on WS. Bind off in ribbing.

Right Scarf: With RS facing, using shorter circular needle, pick up and knit 17 sts along side edge of collar on right front.

Row 1 (WS): K1, * p1, k1, rep from * across. Rep this row until scarf measures 32" long, end on WS. Bind off.

Left Scarf: With RS facing, using shorter circular needle, pick up and knit 17 sts along side edge of collar on left front. Complete as for right scarf. **Armhole Edging:** With RS facing, using shorter circular needle, beg at lower edge of armhole, pick up and knit 56 sts around entire armhole. Place marker and join for working in the round. Work even in k2, p2 ribbing for 2 rnds. Bind off in ribbing. Repeat on second armhole.

Fringe: Cut four 8" long strands of yarn. Put strands together and fold in half. Insert crochet hook from WS to RS through first yo of cape edging. Pull center of strands through yo forming a loop, then pull ends of strands through this loop forming fringe. In this manner, make fringe in each yo of edging. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

CDD (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needlecont: continuedec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

est: established inc: increase k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) **k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together **k3tog:** knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase – Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

MC: main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase – Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together

st(s): stitch(es)

tbl: through back loop(s)

tog: together

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. *On RS rows:* With yarn held in front, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle, then bring the yarn to the back again. Turn your work. *On WS Rows:* With yarn held in back, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
