Directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses. To Fit Head Size: 18(19-20 and 21-22)"

finished measurements

Approximately 16(17½-19½)" around x 8(10-10½)" high

materials

1 Hank each **BLACKSTONE TWEED** (100 grs), colorways shown left to right:

Colorway 1: #2607 Wintry Mix (MC), #2676 Striped Bass (CC1) and #2602 Steamers (CC2)

Colorway 2: #2675 Beach House (MC), #2658 Pitch (CC1) and #2601 Clover Honey (CC2)

Colorway 3: #2664 Old Brick (MC), #2656 Narragansett (CC1) and #2685 Log Cabin (CC2)

16" Length circular knitting needles, sizes 6 (4.00 mm) and 7 (4.50 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

1 Set (4) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 7 (4.50 mm)

6 St markers (1 a different color for beg of rnd)

Tapestry needle

Optional: Pompon maker

gauge

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in St st on larger needles

HAT

With smaller circular needle, using MC, cast on 72(78-84) sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd with different colored marker and carry marker up. Work even in k1, p1 ribbing for 4". Change to larger needles and CC1. Work 1 rnd in ribbing as established. Change to CC2 and work even in ribbing as established until piece measures 7½(8½-9)" from beg.

Next Rnd: * Work 12(13-14) sts in ribbing, place marker, rep from * to last 12(13-14) sts, work to end – 6 markers on needle.

Note: As you decrease, when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns, dividing sts onto 3 needles.

Shape Top:

For Sizes S and L ONLY: Dec Rnd 1: * K1, k2tog, work to 2 sts before next marker, SSK, sl marker, rep from * around – 12 sts dec'd. Work 1 rnd even (k the k sts and p the p sts as they face you).

Dec Rnd 2: * K1, SSP, work to 2 sts before next marker, p2tog, sl marker, rep from * around – 12 sts dec'd. Work 1 rnd even. Rep the last 4 rnds 1(X-2) times, then rep Dec Rnd 1 1(X-0) time(s) more – 12 sts remain.

For Size M ONLY: Dec Rnd 1: * K1, k2tog, work to 2 sts before next marker, p2tog, sl marker, p1, SSP, work to 2 sts before next marker, SSP, sl marker, rep from * around – 12 sts dec'd. Work 1 rnd even (k the k sts and p the p sts as they face you).

Dec Rnd 2: * K1, SSP, work to 2 sts before next marker, SSK, sl marker, p1, k2tog, work to 2 sts before next marker, p2tog, sl marker, rep from * around – 12 sts dec'd. Work 1 rnd even. Rep the



last 4 rnds twice more – 6 sts remain.

For ALL Sizes: Work 1 rnd even. Break off yarn leaving an 8" long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure, then fasten off.

FINISHING

Make pompon of desired size using any color and sew to top of hat.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1k: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1k.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
