materials

3 Hanks [BERROCO LINUS](#) (50 grs), #6826 Chickadee
Straight knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
2 Double pointed knitting needles (dpn), size 8 (5.00 mm)
2 St markers
1 St holder

gauge

19 sts = 4"; 23 rows = 4" in St st

STITCH GLOSSARY

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

NOTE

This shawl starts with a center point. When the point is completed, the Lace Pat is established with St st on each side and increases outward. When the Lace Pat has been completed, the center sts are bound off and the tails are worked out on each side.

LACE PATTERN (Worked over 12 sts)

Row 1 (RS): (K2, yo, SSK) 3 times.

Row 2: (P2, yo, p2 tog) 3 times.

Rep these 2 rows for Lace Pat.

SHAWL

Center Point: With straight needles, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K1, yo, k2, yo, k1 – 6 sts.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: (K2, yo) twice, k2 – 8 sts.

Row 5: (P2, k1) twice, p2.

Row 6: K2, p1, yo, k2, yo, p1, k2 – 10 sts.

Row 7: (P2, k2) twice, p2.

Row 8: K2, p2, yo, k2, yo, p2, k2 – 12 sts.

Row 9: (P2, k3) twice, p2.

Row 10: K2, p3, yo, k2, yo, p3, k2 – 14 sts.

Row 11: (P2, k4) twice, p2.

Row 12: K2, p4, yo, k2, yo, p4, k2 – 16 sts.

Row 13: (P2, k5) twice, p2.

Row 14: K2, p5, yo, k2, yo, p5, k2 – 18 sts.

Row 15: (P2, k6) twice, p2.



Establish Lace Pat: Row 16 (RS): K2, yo, k1, yo, place marker, work Row 1 of Lace Pat over 12 sts, place marker, yo, k1, yo, k2 – 22 sts.

Row 17: P to first marker, work Row 2 of Lace Pat to last marker, p to end.

Row 18 (RS): K2, yo, k to marker, yo, sl marker, work Lace Pat to last marker, sl marker, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2 – 26 sts.

Row 19: P to first marker, work Lace Pat to last marker, p to end. Rep Rows 18 and 19 thirty-one times more, end on WS – 150 sts.

Divide for Tails: Next Row (RS): K2, yo, k to first marker, drop marker, yo, k2, place sts you just worked on a holder for right tail; bind off 8 sts, k1, drop marker, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2 – 73 sts.

Left Tail: Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, p2 tog, p to last 4 sts, p2 tog, yo, k2.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K2, * yo, p2 tog, rep from * to last 5 sts, p3 tog, yo, k1 – 72 sts.

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: K2, yo, p2 tog, p to last 4 sts, p2 tog, yo, k2.

Row 7: Purl.

Row 8 (RS): K2, yo, SSSK, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end p1, k2 tog, yo, k2 – 71 sts.

Row 9: P4, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end k1, p4.

Row 10: K2, yo, SSSK, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 4 sts, end k2 tog yo, k2 – 70 sts.

Row 11: P4, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 4 sts, end p4. Rep Rows 8 – 11 until 8 sts remain, end on RS. Purl 1 row. Sl first 4 sts to one dpn and last 4 sts to second dpn. Fold sts with WS tog and weave

together using Kitchener St or with RS tog and work 3-needle bind-off.

Right Tail: Sl 73 sts from holder to straight needle prepared to work a WS row and join yarn.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K2, yo, p2 tog, p to last 4 sts, p2 tog, yo, k2.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K2, * yo, p2 tog, rep from * to last 5 sts, end p3 tog, yo, k2 – 72 sts.

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: K2, yo, p2 tog, p to last 4 sts, end p2 tog, yo, k2.

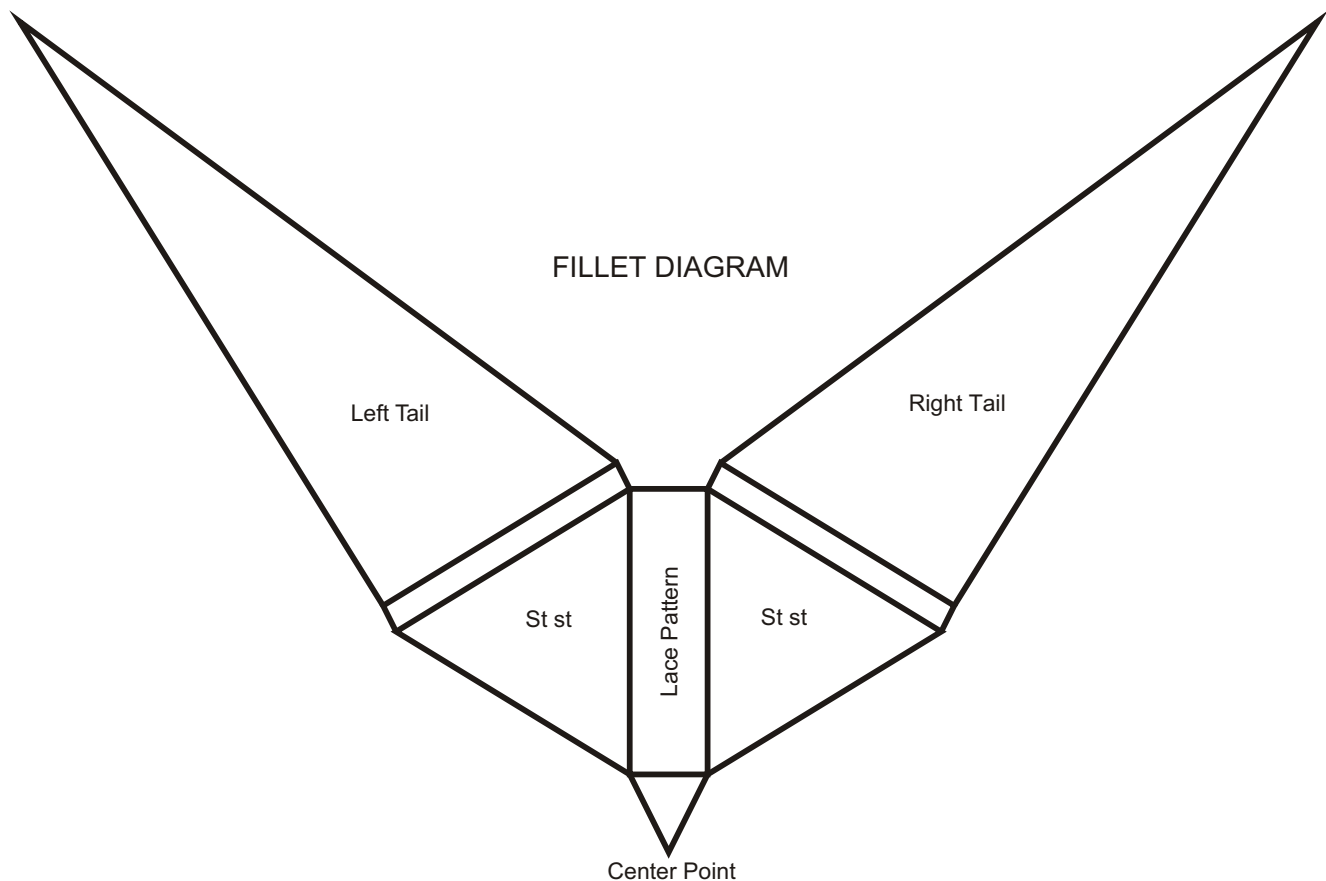
Row 7: Purl.

Row 8: K2, yo, SSK, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end k3 tog, yo, k2 – 71 sts.

Row 9: P5, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end k1, p4.

Row 10: K2, yo, SSK, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 6 sts, end p1, k3 tog, yo, k2 – 70 sts.

Row 11: P3, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, end k1, p4. Rep Rows 8 – 11 until 8 sts remain, end on RS. Purl 1 row. Complete same as left tail.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
KSP: Knit 1, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift 2nd stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on RH needle (1 stitch decreased).
K2SP: Knit 2 together, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift second stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on right hand needle (2 stitches decreased).
LH: left hand
lp(s): loop(s)
LT2 (Left Twist): Skip 1 stitch, knit second stitch through back loop, then knit both stitches together through back loop
MC: main color
M1k: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch (1 stitch increased).
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
RT2 (Right Twist): Knit 2 stitches together, leaving them on the left hand needle, then knit the first stitch again slipping both stitches to the right hand needle.
SKP: slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over
sl: slip
SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)
tog: together
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row
STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. Reverse **St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.
GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

bphdc (back post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on even # or wrong side rows).
bptr (back post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from back to front around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.
ch: chain
dc: double crochet
fphdc (front post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on odd # or right side rows)
fptr (front post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.
hdc: half double crochet
hdctbl: Half double crochet worked in the back loop
hdctfl: Half double crochet worked in the front loop
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
