## materials

4(4-5-5-6-6) Hanks [BERROCO WEEKEND DK](#) (100 grs), #2964 Curry  
Crochet hook, size 5.00 mm (H/8)  
OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE  
Tapestry needle  
Spray bottle with water and straight pins for blocking.

## gauge

22 sts (2SR) = 4"; 8 rows (1.33 RR) = 4" in cables and chains stitch pattern.

## NOTES

Tunic is worked in one piece starting at one sleeve cuff and ending at the other sleeve cuff. Front and Back panels are added with chains that are joined to either side of the sleeve.

**SR:** Stitch Repeat - Stitches to repeat for stitch pattern

**RR:** Row Repeat - Number of rows to repeat for stitch pattern

**Prev:** Previous

**Dtr:** Double Treble Crochet

**Tr:** Treble Crochet

**Dc:** Double Crochet

**Ch-sp(s):** Chain Space(s)

**FPT:** Front Post Treble Crochet

**BPdc:** Back Post Double Crochet

**Sk:** Skip

**Tch:** Turning chain

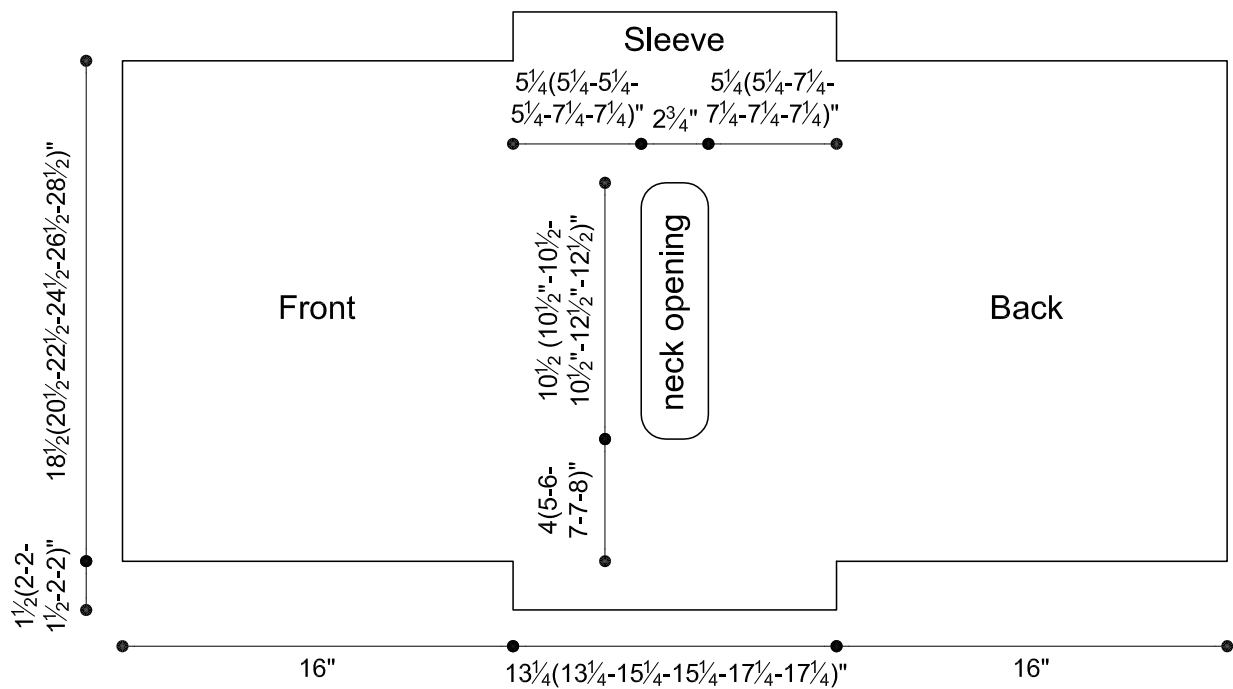
### **Dctrtog:**

Yarn over hook, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yarn over hook and draw up a loop, yarn over hook and draw yarn through 2 loops, skip 2 chains, yarn over hook twice, insert hook into next chain, yarn over hook and draw up a loop, [yarn over hook and draw yarn through 2 loops] twice, yarn over hook and draw yarn through remaining loops on hook.



### **Trdtrtog:**

Yarn over hook twice, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yarn over hook and draw up a loop, [yarn over hook and draw yarn through 2 loops] twice, skip 2 chains, yarn over hook 3 times, insert hook into next chain, yarn over hook and draw up a loop, [yarn over hook and draw yarn through 2 loops] 3 times, yarn over hook and draw yarn through remaining loops on hook.

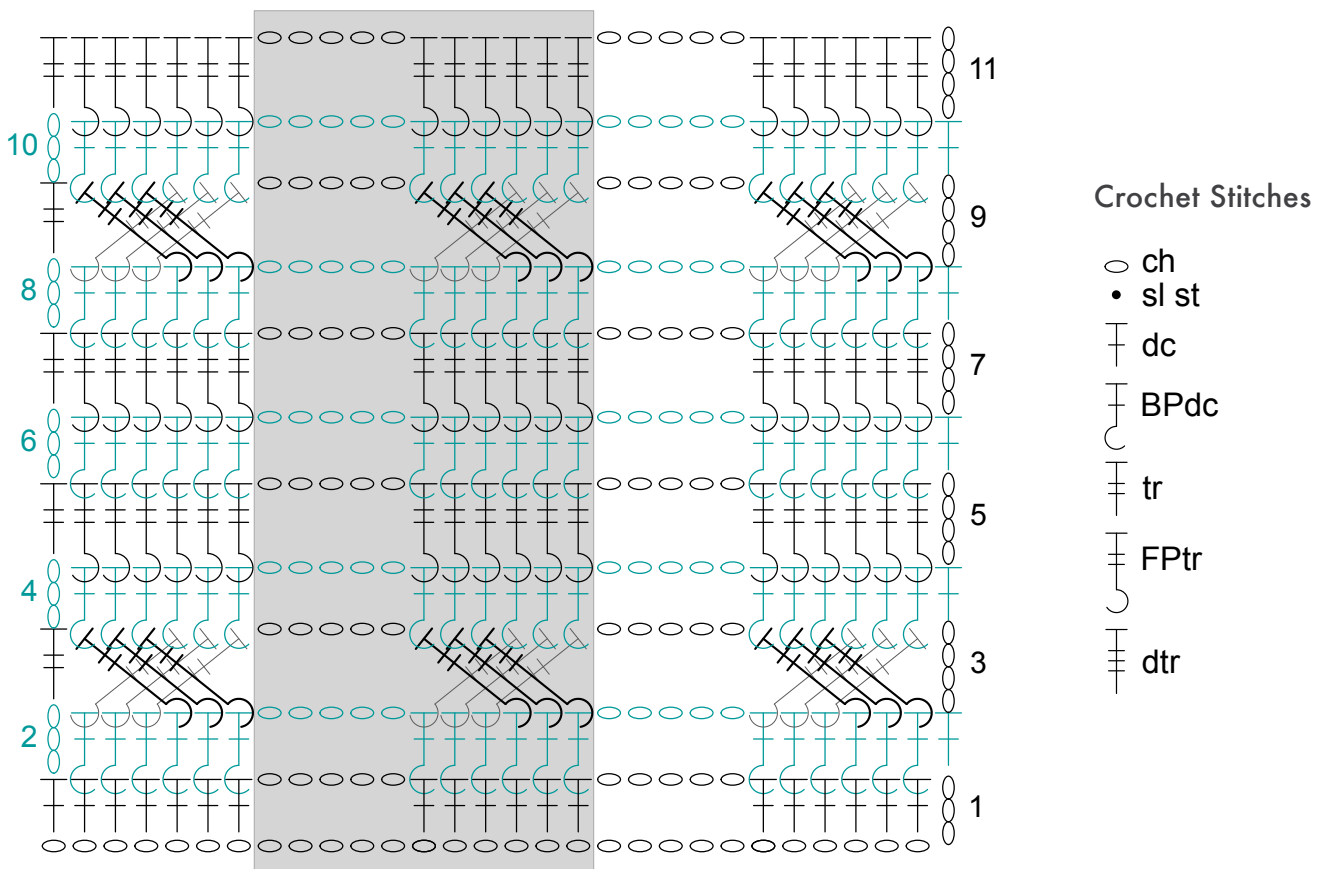


### CABLES AND CHAINS STITCH PATTERN

See stitch diagram AT DIRECTION for assistance.

Chain a multiple of 11 plus 10.

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 5 ch, \*ch 5, sk 5 ch, dc in next 6 ch; rep from \* across, dc

in last ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), BPdc in next 6 dc, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, BPdc in next 6 dc, rep from \* across, dc in top of tch, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 4 (counts as tr throughout), sk 3 dc, FPtr around next 3 dc, FPtr around prev 3 dc (in front of prev FPtr), \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, sk 3 dc, FPtr around next 3 dc, FPtr around prev 3 dc; rep from \* across, tr in top of tch, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, BPdc in next 6 tr, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, BPdc in next 6 tr; rep from \* across, dc in top of tch, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 4, FPtr in next 6 dc, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, FPtr in next 6 dc; rep from \* across, tr in top of tch, turn.

**Rows 6-7:** Rep Rows 4-5.

**Row 8:** Rep Row 4.

Rep Rows 3-8 to desired length.

## RIGHT SLEEVE

Ch 76 (76-87-87-98-98)

**Row 1 – WS(RS-RS-WS-RS-RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 5 ch, \*ch 5, sk 5 ch, dc in next 6 ch; rep from \* across, dc in last ch, turn – 44(44-50-50-56-56) dc + 6(6-7-7-8-8) ch-sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), BPdc in next 6 dc, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, BPdc in next 6 dc, rep from \* across, dc in top of tch, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 4, FPtr in next 6 dc, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, FPtr in next 6 dc; rep from \* across, tr in top of tch, turn.

**For Sizes S, M, XL, 2X ONLY: Row 4:** Ch 3, BPdc in next 6 tr, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, BPdc in next 6 tr; rep from \* across, dc in top of tch, turn.

**For ALL Sizes:** Ch 90, remove hook from ch.

## FRONT AND BACK RIGHT SHOULDER

Join new ball of yarn to opposite side of sleeve with sl st to top of tch, ch 88, fasten off, place loop (of opposite side) back on hook.

**Row 1 – WS(RS-RS-WS-RS-RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 5 ch, \*ch 5, sk 5 ch, dc in next 6 ch\*\*; rep from \* across to the last 4 ch, ch 5, sk last 4 ch, sk first st, cont in Row 4(5-5-4-5-5) of stitch pattern across to last st, ch 5, sk last st, sk 4 ch, dc in next 6 ch, rep from \* across to last ch ending at \*\*, dc in last ch, turn – 140(140-146-146-152-152) dc + 22(22-23-23-24-24) ch-sps.

**For Sizes XS and L ONLY: Row 2:** Cont in Row 5 of stitch pattern across.

**For ALL Sizes: Row 3(2-2-3-2-2):** Cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern .

**For Size XS ONLY: Rows 4-8:** Cont in Rows 3-7 of stitch pattern.

**For Size S ONLY:** Rows 3-10: Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern once, Cont in Rows 3-4 of stitch pattern.

**For Size M ONLY: Rows 3-12:** Cont in Rows 5-6 of stitch pattern once, Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern once, Cont in Rows 3-4 of stitch pattern.

**For Size L ONLY: Rows 4-14:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern once, Cont in Rows 3-7 of stitch pattern.

**For Size XL ONLY: Rows 3-14:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice.

**For Size 2X ONLY: Rows 3-16:** Cont in Rows 5-6 of stitch pattern once, Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice.

## XSMALL/ LARGE NECK OPENING

**Row 1a (WS):** Ch 3, BPdc in next 6 tr, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, BPdc in next 6 tr; rep from \* 10 times total, dc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, dtr in next tr, turn. – 68 dc + 10 ch-5 sps.

**Row 2a:** Ch 4, sk ch-2 sp, tr in next dc, cont in Row 3 of stitch pattern across, turn.

**Rows 3a-7a:** Cont in Rows 4-8 of stitch pattern.

**Rows 8a-19a:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice.

**Row 20a:** Ch 7, tr in first dc, cont in Row 3 of stitch pattern, remove hook from work.

Join new ball of yarn with sl st 5 tr from last st on Row 1a.

**Row 1b (WS):** Ch 7, dc in ch-5 sp, cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern across – 68 (74) dc + 10 (11) ch-5 sps.

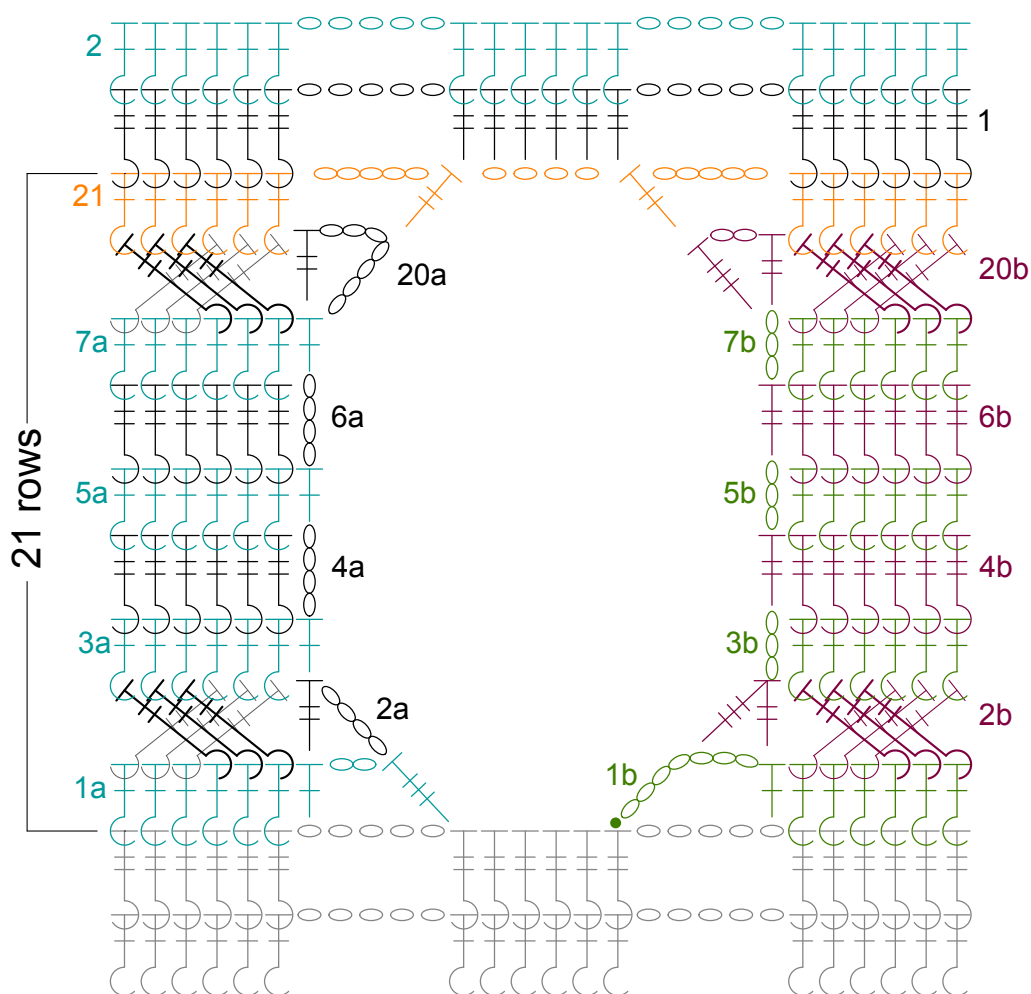
**Row 2b:** Cont in Row 3 of stitch pattern across to ch-7 sp, trdrtog over next dc and 3rd ch, turn.

**Rows 3b-7b:** Cont in Rows 4-8 of stitch pattern.

**Rows 8b-19b:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice.

**Row 20b:** Cont in Row 3 of stitch pattern to tch, (tr, ch 2, dtr) in top of tch, fasten off.

Place free loop from end of Row 20a back on hook, turn.

**Row 21:** Cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern to ch-7 sp, ch 5, sk next tr, tr in 4th ch, ch 4, tr in dtr (at end of Row 20b), ch 5, sk next tr, cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern to end.

### SMALL/ MEDIUM NECK OPENING

**Row 1a (RS):** Ch 4, FPtr in next 6 dc, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, FPtr in next 6 dc; rep from \* 10 (11) times total, tr in ch-5 sp, ch 2, dtr in next dc, turn. (67 (73) tr + 10 (11) ch-5 sps)

**Row 2a:** Ch 3, dc in tr, cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern across, turn.

**Rows 3a-4a:** Cont in Rows 7-8 of stitch pattern

**Rows 5a-16a:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice

**Rows 17a-19a:** Cont in Rows 3-5 of stitch pattern

**Row 20a:** Ch 5, dc in first tr, cont in Row 6 of stitch pattern, remove hook from work.

Join new ball of yarn with sl st 5 dc from last st on Row 1a.

**Row 1b (RS):** Ch 7, tr in ch-5 sp, cont in Row 5 of stitch pattern across – 67 tr + 10 ch-5 sps.

**Row 2b:** Cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern across to ch-8 sp, dctrtogether over next tr and 4th ch of ch-7 sp, turn.

**Rows 3b-4b:** Cont in Rows 7-8 of stitch pattern

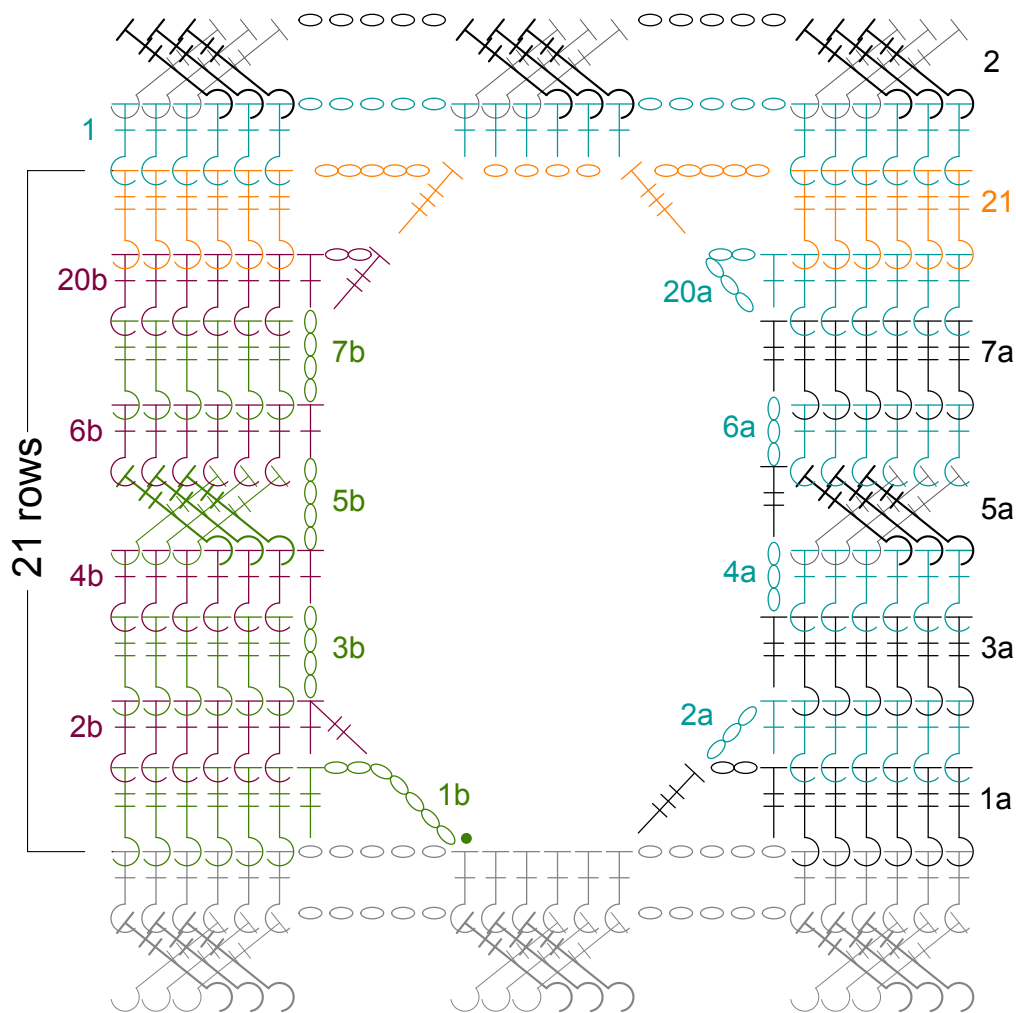
**Rows 5b-16b:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice

**Rows 17b-19b:** Cont in Rows 3-5 of stitch pattern

**Row 20b:** Cont in Row 6 of stitch pattern to tch, ch 3, tr in top of tch, fasten off.

Place free loop at end of Row 20a back on hook, turn.

**Row 21:** Cont in Row 7 of stitch pattern to ch-5 sp, ch 5, sk next dc, dtr in 3rd ch of ch-5 sp, ch 4, dtr in tr, ch 5, sk next dc, cont in Row 7 of stitch pattern to end.

## XLARGE/ 2X NECK OPENING

**Row 1a (RS):** Ch 4, sk 3 dc, FPtr around next 3 dc, FPtr around prev 3 dc, \*ch 5, sk ch-5 sp, sk 3 dc, FPtr around next 3 dc, FPtr around prev 3 dc; rep from \* 11 times total, tr in ch-5 sp, ch 2, dtr in next dc, turn. (73 tr + 11 ch-5 sps)

**Row 2a:** Ch 3, dc in tr, cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern across, turn.

**Rows 3a-6a:** Cont in Rows 5-8 of stitch pattern.

**Rows 7a-18a:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice.

**Rows 19a-23a:** Cont in Rows 3-7 of stitch pattern.

**Row 24a:** Ch 5, dc in tr, cont in Row 8 of stitch pattern, remove hook from work.

Join new ball of yarn with sl st 5 dc from last st on Row 1a.

**Row 1b (RS):** Ch 7, tr in ch-5 sp, cont in Row 3 of stitch pattern across - 73 tr + 11 ch-5 sps.

**Row 2b:** Cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern across to ch-8 sp, dctr tog over next tr and 4th ch of ch-7 sp, turn.

**Rows 3b-6b:** Cont in Rows 5-8 of stitch pattern.

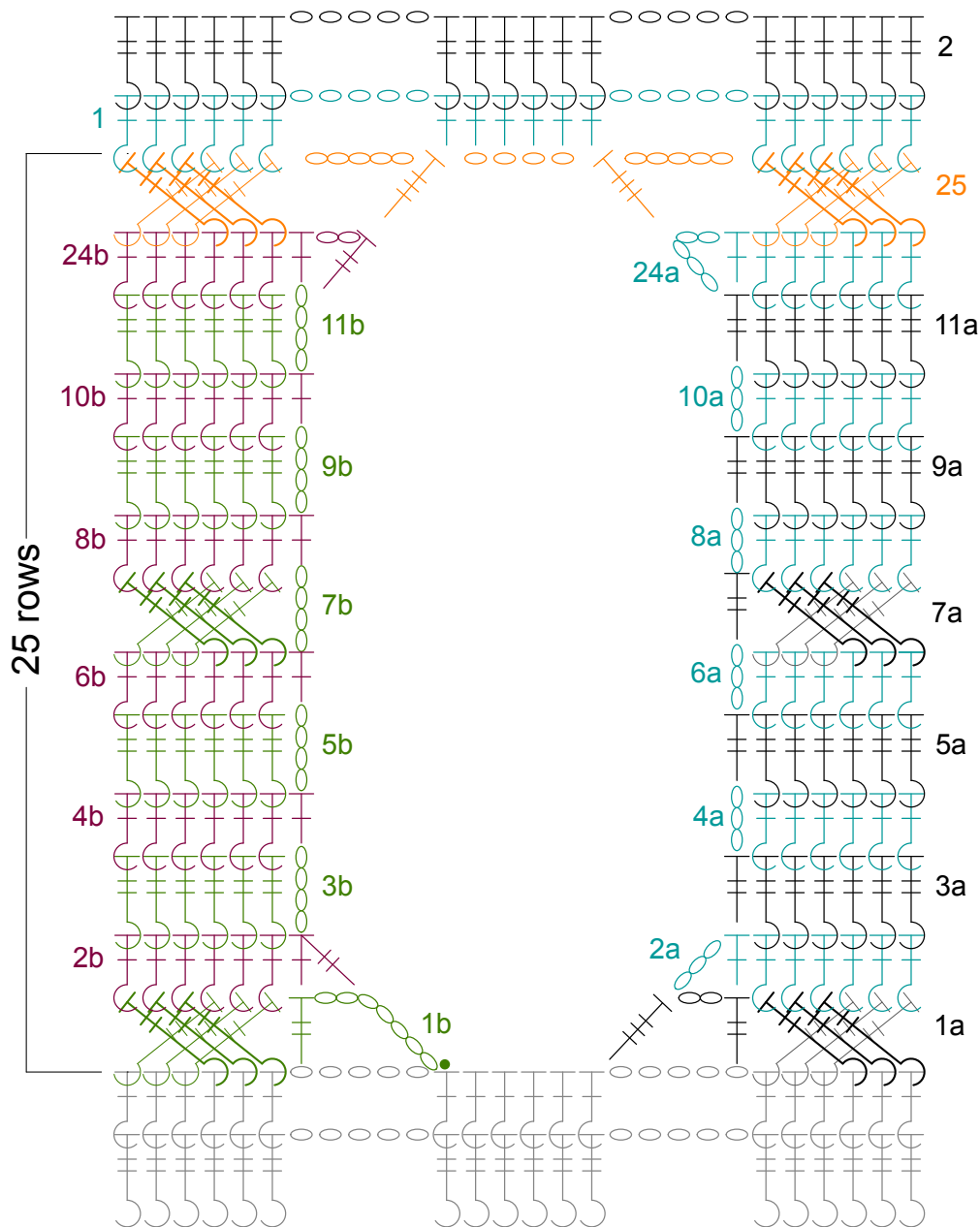
**Rows 7b-18b:** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern twice.

**Rows 19b-23b:** Cont in Rows 3-7 of stitch pattern.

**Row 24b:** Cont in Row 8 of stitch pattern to tch, (dc, ch 2, tr) in top of tch, fasten off.

Place free loop at end of Row 24a back on hook, turn.

**Row 25:** Cont in Row 3 of stitch pattern to ch-5 sp, ch 5, sk next dc, dtr in 3rd ch of ch-5 sp, ch 4, dtr in tr, ch 5, sk next dc, cont in Row 3 of stitch pattern to end.

## OPPOSITE FRONT AND BACK PANEL LEFT SHOULDER

**For Sizes XS and L ONLY: Row 1 (RS):** Cont in Row 5 of stitch pattern across to tr, tr in tr, tr in next 4 ch, tr in tr, cont in Row 5 of stitch pattern across – 140(146) tr + 22 (23) ch-sps.

**Rows 2-8 (2-14):** Cont in Rows 6-8 of stitch pattern, Cont in Rows 3-8 0(1) time, Cont in Row 3-6 of stitch pattern, fasten off.

**For Sizes S and M ONLY: Row 1 (WS):** Cont in Row 8 of stitch pattern across to dtr, dc in dtr, dc in next 4 ch, dc in dtr, cont in Row 8 of stitch pattern

across – 140(146) dc + 22, 23 ch-sps.

**Rows 2-10 (2-12):** Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern, Cont in Rows 3-5 of stitch pattern, (M only) Cont in Rows 6-7 of stitch pattern, fasten off.

**For Sizes XL and 2X ONLY: Row 1 (WS):** Cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern across to dtr, dc in dtr, dc in next 4 ch, dc in dtr, cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern across – 152(152) dc + 24, 24 ch-sps.

**Rows 2-14 (2-16):** Cont in Rows 5-8, Cont in Rows 3-8 of stitch pattern, Cont in Rows 3-5, (2X only) Cont in Rows 6-7, fasten off.

## LEFT SLEEVE

Join yarn to 8th ch-5 sp with sl st.

**For Sizes XS and L ONLY: Row 1 (RS):** Ch 4, cont in Row 5 of stitch pattern for 6 (7) ch-5 sps, FPtr in next 6 dc, tr in next ch-5 sp, turn. (44, 50 tr)

**Rows 2-3:** Cont in Rows 6-7 of stitch pattern, fasten off.

**For Sizes S, M, XL and 2X ONLY: Row 1 (WS):** Ch 3, cont in Row 4 of stitch pattern for X(6-7-X-8-8) ch-5 sps, BPdc in next 6 tr, dc in next ch-5 sp, turn. X(44-50-X-56-56) dc.

**Rows 2-4:** Cont in Rows 5-7 of stitch pattern, fasten off.

## FINISHING

### BLOCKING AND SEAMING

Pin body to schematic size. Spray with water and allow to dry.

Fold garment vertically through neck opening, aligning sleeve corners and bottom corner of front and back panels. Tunic is seamed on the right side by dc up side seam separated by chains. Join yarn with sl st to RS of Front Panel bottom edge of side

seam, ch 2, sl st to Back Panel's bottom edge of side seam. \*[Slip free loop off of hook, insert hook into next st on Back Panel, place free loop on hook and pull through, dc in next st on Front Panel (this joins front and back seamlessly)] rep across to ch-sp, ch 5; rep from \* across side seam to under arm; Rep dc join across underarm seam by slipping free loop around post of edge stitches, fasten off. Rep on opposite side seam.

### COLLAR AND CUFF EDGING

Join yarn to RS edge with sl st.

**Rnd 1 (WS):** Ch 1, sc evenly around edge, sl st to first sc, turn.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sl st in ea sc around, fasten off.

### BOTTOM EDGING

Join yarn to WS back edge with sl st.

**Rnd 1 (WS):** Ch 1, sc evenly around edge, sl st to first sc, turn.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, dc in ea sc around, sl st to top of tch, turn.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in ea dc around, sl st to first sc, turn.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sl st in ea sc around, fasten off.



## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

### Knit

**beg:** beginning  
**CC:** contrasting color  
**cn:** cable needle  
**cont:** continue  
**dec:** decrease  
**dpn:** double pointed needles  
**est:** established  
**inc:** increase  
**K:** knit  
**KSP:** Knit 1, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift 2nd stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on RH needle (1 stitch decreased).  
**K2SP:** Knit 2 together, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift second stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on right hand needle (2 stitches decreased).  
**LH:** left hand  
**lp(s):** loop(s)  
**LT2 (Left Twist):** Skip 1 stitch, knit second stitch through back loop, then knit both stitches together through back loop  
**MC:** main color  
**M1k:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch (1 stitch increased).  
**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch (1 stitch increased).  
**p:** purl  
**pat(s):** pattern(s)  
**pm:** place marker  
**pssso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch  
**p2sso:** pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch  
**rem:** remaining  
**rep:** repeat  
**RH:** right hand  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**RS:** right side  
**RT2 (Right Twist):** Knit 2 stitches together, leaving them on the left hand needle, then knit the first stitch again slipping both stitches to the right hand needle.  
**SKP:** slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over  
**sl:** slip  
**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.  
**st(s):** stitch(es)

**TBL:** through back loop(s)  
**tog:** together  
**WS:** wrong side  
**wyib:** with yarn in back  
**wyif:** with yarn in front  
**yo:** yarn over  
**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.  
**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row  
**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. Reverse **St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.  
**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

### Crochet

**bphdc (back post half double crochet):** Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on even # or wrong side rows).  
**bptr (back post triple):** Yarn over twice, insert hook from back to front around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.  
**ch:** chain  
**dc:** double crochet  
**fphdc (front post half double crochet):** Yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on odd # or right side rows)  
**fptr (front post triple):** Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.  
**hdc:** half double crochet  
**hdctbl:** Half double crochet worked in the back loop  
**hdctfl:** Half double crochet worked in the front loop  
**sl st:** slip stitch  
**sp:** space  
**tr:** treble
