**skill level:** Intermediate

One size

**finished measurements**

Approximately 11" wide x 72" long

**materials**

3 hanks **BERROCO VINTAGE** (100 grs), #51182 Indigo (MC) and 1 hank each #51190 Cerulean (CC1) and #51103 Clary (CC2)

Straight knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN

**gauge**

Spare knitting needle, size 8 (5.00 mm) for 3-needle bind off

Waste yarn to hold sts

**GAUGE**

19 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Pat St

## NOTE

This scarf is worked in 2 halves, then joined in center with 3-needle bind off. When changing colors, hold yarn to the left and pick up new color from underneath. This twists yarn so there are no holes.

### BORDER PATTERN (Odd number of sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** With CC1, k1, \* sl 1 WYIF, k1, rep from \* across.

**Row 2:** With CC1, purl.

**Row 3:** With MC, k1, \* sl 1 WYIB, k1, rep from \* across.

**Row 4:** With MC, purl.

**Row 5:** With CC2, k1, \* sl 1 WYIF, k1, rep from \* across.

**Row 6:** With CC2, purl.

**Rows 7 and 8:** With CC1, rep Rows 3 and 4.

**Rows 9 and 10:** With MC, rep Rows 1 and 2.

**Rows 11 and 12:** With CC2, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Rep these 12 rows twice more (36 rows total) for Border Pat.

### PATTERN STITCH (Worked over 53 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** K3, p5, \* k2, p5, rep from \* to last 3 sts, end k3.

Rep these 2 rows for Pat St.

## SCARF

**First Half:** With MC, cast on 53 sts. Knit 6 rows (3 Garter Ridges), end on WS.

**Establish Border Pat: Row 1 (RS):** With MC, k3, join CC1 and work Row 1 of Border Pat to last 3 sts, join another hank of MC and k3.

**Row 2:** With MC, k3, with CC1, work Row 2 of Border Pat to last 3 sts, with MC, k3. Work even in pat as established until 36 rows of Border Pat have been completed, end on WS. Fasten off CC1 and CC2 and work even in Pat St with MC alone until piece measures 36" from beg, end on WS. Break off yarn and sl sts to waste yarn.



**Second Half:** Work as for first half until piece measures 36" from beg, end on WS. DO NOT break off yarn.

## FINISHING

Sl 53 sts of first half to straight needle and hold 2 halves with RS facing each other and with needles pointed in the same direction.

**Bind Off:** \* Insert point of spare needle through first st on front needle and first st on back needle, then k these 2 sts tog. Repeat from \* once more, then bind off first st. Work in this manner until all sts on both needles have been bound off. Weave in all ends. Block as desired.

## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

### Knit

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**beg:** beginning  
**CC:** contrasting color  
**cdd (centered double decrease):** Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.  
**cn:** cable needle  
**cont:** continue  
**dec:** decrease  
**dpn:** double pointed needles  
**est:** established  
**inc:** increase  
**K:** knit  
**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s)  
**k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together  
**k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together  
**LH:** left hand  
**MC:** main color  
**M1:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1L:** Work as for M1.  
**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1pL:** Work as for M1p.  
**M1pR:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**p:** purl  
**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s)  
**pat(s):** pattern(s)  
**pm:** place marker  
**pssso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch  
**p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together  
**p2sso:** pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch  
**p3tog:** purl 3 stitches together  
**rem:** remaining  
**rep:** repeat  
**RH:** right hand  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**RS:** right side  
**sl:** slip  
**sm:** slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**TBL:** through back loop(s)

**tog:** together

**WS:** wrong side

**wyib:** with yarn in back

**wyif:** with yarn in front

**yo:** yarn over

**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row

**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

### Crochet

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**ch:** chain

**dc:** double crochet

**hdc:** half double crochet

**sc:** single crochet

**sl st:** slip stitch

**sp:** space

**tr:** treble
