gauge


30 sts and 40 rnds = $4^{"}$ in St st (k EVERY rnd) and Lace Pat TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

NOTE

These socks are worked on 2 circular needles. When changing from one needle to the other, make sure that you pick up the opposite end of the needle holding the sts you will be working. If you pick up the end of the other needle, you will wind up with all the sts on one needle and will have to divide them onto 2 needles again. It is sometimes helpful to use 2 different colored needles or to mark both ends of one needle with nail polish or a permanent marker.

LACE PATTERN 1 (Multiple of 12 sts)

Rnd 1: Knit. **Rnd 2:** * K1, yo, SSK, k1, k2tog, yo, rep from * around.

Rnd 3: Knit. **Rnd 4:** * K1, yo, k1, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k1, yo, rep from * around.

Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 7: Knit.

Rnd 8: * K1, k2tog, (yo, k1) twice, sl 1, k2tog, psso, (k1, yo) twice, SSK, rep from * around. Rep these 8 rnds for Lace Pat 1

LACE PATTERN 2 (Multiple of 12 sts + 6) **Rnds 1 – 7:** Rep Rnds 1 – 7 of Lace Pat 1. **Rnd 8:** K2tog, (k1, yo) twice, SSK, * K1, k2tog, (yo, k1) twice, sl 1, k2tog, psso, (k1, yo) twice, SSK, rep from * once more. Rep these 8 rnds for Lace Pat 2.

SOCK (Make 2)

Cast on 60 sts, using provisional cast-on. Divide sts onto 2 circular needles and join, being careful not



to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Knit 7 rnds.

Eyelet Rnd: * Yo, k2tog, rep from * around. Knit 8 rnds. SI sts from provisional cast-on to third circular needle. Fold piece in half at Eyelet Rnd with WS together so that third circular needle is behind the 2 circular needles in use.

Joining Rnd: Insert point of RH needle through first st on circular needle in use and first st on third circular needle and knit them tog. Continue in this manner until all sts on third circular needle have been used. Drop third needle and continue working with the 2 original circular needles. Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 6 rnds, then work even in Lace Pat 1 until 8 repeats of Lace Pat (64 rnds) have been worked, end on Rnd 8.

Shape Heel Flap: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, k29, turn. Leave remaining 30 sts on second circular needle unworked. Drop marker.

Note: For heel flap, you will be working back and forth in St st on only the first 30 sts.

Row 2 (WS): SI 1, p29. Rep the last 2 rows 12 times more, end on WS.

Turn Heel: Short Rows: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, k16, k2tog, k1, turn – 29 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1, p5, p2 tog, p1, turn – 28 sts. **Row 3:** Sl 1, k6, k2tog, k1, turn – 27 sts. **Row 4:** Sl 1, p7, p2 tog, p1, turn – 26 sts. **Row 5:** Sl 1, k8, k2tog, k1, turn – 25 sts. **Row 6:** Sl 1, p9, p2 tog, p1, turn – 24 sts. Row 7: Sl 1, k10, k2tog, k1, turn – 23 sts. **Row 8:** Sl 1, p11, p2 tog, p1, turn – 22 sts. Row 9: Sl 1, k12, k2tog, k1, turn – 21 sts. **Row 10:** Sl 1, p13, p2 tog, p1, turn – 20 sts. **Row 11:** Sl 1, k14, k2tog, k1, turn – 19 sts. **Row 12:** Sl 1, p15, p2 tog, p1, turn – 18 sts. Gusset: Next Row (RS): K across 18 sts of heel flap, pick up and k15 sts along left edge of heel flap, with second needle, work across 30 unworked sts in Lace Pat 2. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Then with first needle, pick up and k15 sts along right edge of heel flap - 78 sts (48 sts on back needle in St st and 30 sts on front needle in Lace Pat 2). Note: From here you will again be working in the round on 2 needles. Knit to end of first (back) needle, then work in Lace Pat 2 across second (front) needle to beg of rnd.

Dec Rnd: With back needle, k1, SSK, k to last 3 sts on needle, k2tog, k1; with front needle, work across in Lace Pat 2 – 2 sts dec'd on back needle. Work 1 rnd even. Rep these 2 rnds 8 times more – 60 sts (30 sts on each needle). Keeping 30 sts on back needle in St st and 30 sts on front needle in Lace Pat 2, work even until sock measures 1¹/₂" less than desired length (the 2 circular needles will allow you to try on the sock to check the length). Discontinue Lace Pat 2 at this point and work all sts in St st. **Shape Toe: Dec Rnd:** With back needle, k1, SSK, k to 3 sts before end of needle, k2tog, k1; with front needle, k1, SSK, k to 3 sts before end of needle, k2tog, k1 – 2 sts dec'd on each needle. Knit 1 rnd. Rep these 2 rnds 8 times more - 12 sts on each needle. Break off yarn leaving an 18" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle. Hold needles parallel with each other and weave toe sts tog

Knit

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

- TBL: through back loop(s)
- tog: together
- WS: wrong side
- wyib: with yarn in back
- wyif: with yarn in front

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
