Note: This garment was designed with approximately 4 – 6" of ease. Please take this into consideration when selecting your size.

Yarn

6(7-8-8-10-11) balls **BERROCO NOBLE** (100 grs), #2032 Wormwood

needles and notions

29" circular knitting needles, sizes 13 (9.00 mm) and 15 (10.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge

1 set (4) each double pointed knitting needles (dpns), sizes 13 (9.00 mm) and 15 (10.00 mm)

4 st markers

Five 1" buttons

Tapestry needle

Waste yarn to hold sts

gauge

10 sts and 14 rows = 4" in St st on larger needles

NOTE

Body of this garment is worked in one piece to underarms. Sleeves are worked in the round, then body and sleeves are joined at underarm to work yoke in one piece.

BODY

With smaller needle, cast on 95(105-115-125-135-145) sts. Do not join.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (WS): P1, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 2 sts, end p2.

Row 2 (RS): K1, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Work even in pat as established for 5 more rows, end with a WS row. Change to larger needle and St st and work even until piece measures 17" from beg, end with a WS row. Do not break off yarn, set aside.

SLEEVES (Make 2)

With smaller dpns, cast on 26(28-30-30-32-32) sts.

Divide sts onto 3 needles, place marker and join for working in the round.

Set Up Rib: Rnd 1: * K1, p1, rep from * around. Rep this rnd 10 times more. Change to larger dpns and St st and work even for 5 rnds.

Inc Rnd: K1, M1L, knit to end, M1R – 2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc Rnd every 50(25-12-10-8-6) rnds 1(2-4-5-6-8) times more – 30(34-40-42-46-50) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 18" from beg, end 2(2-2-3-3-3) sts before end of rnd. Sl the next 5(5-5-7-7-7) sts onto waste yarn for underarm and remaining 25(29-35-35-39-43) sts onto waste yarn for yoke.

YOKE

Joining Rnd (RS): Knit first 21(24-26-28-30-33) sts on circular needle for right front; sl the next 5(5-5-7-7-7) sts to waste yarn for underarm, pm, k25(29-35-35-39-43) sts of right sleeve, pm; k43(47-53-55-61-65) sts on circular needle for back, pm; sl the next 5(5-5-7-7-7) sts to waste yarn for underarm, k25(29-35-35-39-43) sts of left sleeve, pm; k21(24-26-28-30-33) sts on circular



needle for left front – 135(153-175-181-199-217) sts. Work 3(3-1-1-1-1) row(s) in St st, end with a WS row.

Set Up Decs: Dec Row 1 (RS): K2, k2tog (neck dec), * knit to 3 sts before next marker, SSK, k1, sm, k2tog, knit to 2 sts before next marker, SSK, sm, k1, k2tog, rep from * once more, knit to 4 sts before end, SSK, (neck dec), k2 – 10 sts dec'd. Purl 1 row. Rep the last 2 rows 7(8-7-9-9-10) times more, end with a WS row – 55(63-95-81-99-107) sts.

Dec Row 2 (RS): * Knit to 3 sts before marker, SSK, k1, sm, k2tog, knit to 2 sts before next marker, SSK, sm, k1, k2tog, rep from * once more, knit to end – 8 sts dec'd.

Purl 1 row. Rep the last 2 rows 2(3-7-5-7-8) times more, end with a RS row – 31(31-31-33-35-35) sts. Bind off purlwise on WS.

FINISHING

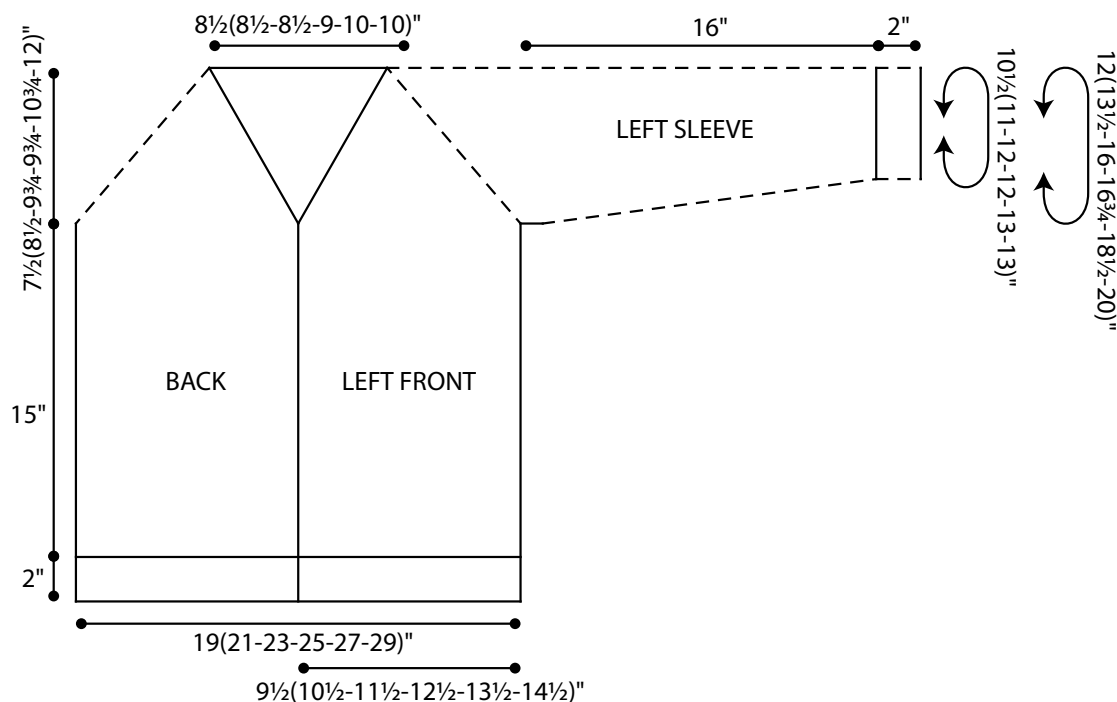
Graft live underarm sts together using Kitchener St.

Neckband: With RS facing, using smaller circular needle, beg at lower right front edge, pick up and knit 56(59-63-63-66-68) sts along right front and neck edge (or approximately 2 sts for every 3 rows), 29(29-29-31-35-35) sts across bound-off sts of neck, then 56(59-63-63-66-68) sts along left neck and front edge (or approximately 2 sts for every 3 rows) – 141(147-155-157-167-171) sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (WS): P1, * k1, p1, rep from * across.

Row 2 (RS): K1, * p1, k1, rep from * across. Rep Row 1 once more.

Buttonhole Row (RS): Working in ribbing as established, work 4 sts, * SSK, yo, work 6 sts, rep from * 4 times more, work to end. Work even in ribbing as established for 2 more rows, end with a RS row. Bind off in ribbing. Weave in all ends and block as desired. Sew on buttons.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
CDD (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)
est: established
inc: increase
k: knit
k TBL: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p TBL: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip

sm: slip marker
SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.
SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.
st(s): stitch(es)
TBL: through back loop(s)
tog: together
w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. With yarn held in back, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle, then bring the yarn to the back again. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row
Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.
Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.
Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
