needles (dpn), size 6 (4.0 mm) OR
SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
4 St markers
Tapestry needle
Waste yarn

gauge
22 sts and 32 rnds = 4" in reverse
stockinette st with larger needle

LEFT MITTEN

With smaller dpns, cast on 38 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 3 dpns, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work even in garter st (knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd) for 5". Change to larger needle.

Establish chart: Work Rnd 1 of Chart 1, pm, purl to end of rnd.

Work 2 more rnds as established.

Thumb gusset: Inc Rnd 1: Work Rnd 4 of Chart 1, sm, purl to last st, pm, M1p, p1, M1p – 2 sts inc'd.

Next Rnd: Work next rnd of Chart 1, sm, purl to next marker, sm, purl to end. Work 1 more rnd even in pat as established.

Inc Rnd 2: Work next rnd of Chart 1, sm, purl to next marker, sm, M1p, purl to end, M1p – 2 sts inc'd.

Rep Inc Rnd 2 every 3rd row 4 more times (13 sts in thumb gusset).

Divide for Thumb: Next Rnd: Work next rnd of Chart 1, sm, purl to next marker, drop marker, sl the next 13 sts to waste yarn for thumb – 37 sts. Work even until a total of 3 repeats of Chart 1 have been completed. Replace Chart 1 with Chart 2 and work Rnds 1-12 of Chart 2 once.

Dec Rnd: * P1, p2tog, purl to 3 sts before marker, p2tog, p1, sm, rep from * once more. Rep Dec Rnd every other rnd until 9 sts remain (5 on back of hand and 4 on palm). Break off yarn, leaving a 12" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off.

Thumb: Sl 13 sts from waste yarn to larger dpn's. Join yarn and p13, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work even in reverse St st (purl every rnd) until thumb measures 2" or until only tip of thumb is showing when trying the mitten on.

Dec Rnd 1: * P1, p2tog, rep from * to last st, p1 – 9 sts.

Dec Rnd 1: P1, (p2tog) to end – 5 sts. Break off yarn leaving an 8" long end. Thread end into tapestry



needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off. Weave in all ends, using tail at base of thumb to close up hole.

RIGHT MITTEN

With smaller dpns, cast on 38 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 3 dpns, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work even in garter st (knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd) for 5". Change to larger needle.

Establish chart: Work Rnd 1 of Chart 1, pm, purl to end of rnd.

Work 2 more rnds as established.

Thumb gusset: Inc Rnd 1: Work Rnd 4 of Chart 1, sm, M1p, p1, M1p, pm, purl to last st – 2 sts inc'd.

Next Rnd: Work next rnd of Chart 1, sm, purl to next marker, sm, purl to end. Work 1 more rnd even in pat as established.

Inc Rnd 2: Work next rnd of Chart 1, sm, M1p, purl to next marker, M1p, sm, purl to end – 2 sts inc'd.

Rep Inc Rnd 2 every 3rd row 4 more times (13 sts in thumb gusset).

Divide for Thumb: Next Rnd: Work next rnd of Chart 1, drop marker, sl the next 13 sts to waste yarn for thumb, sm, purl to next marker – 37 sts. Complete as for Left Mitten.

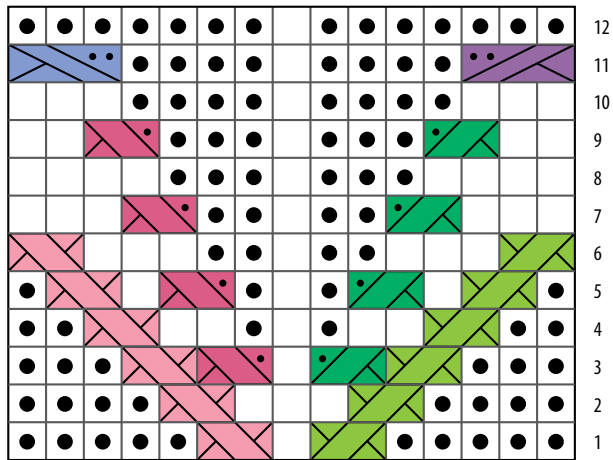
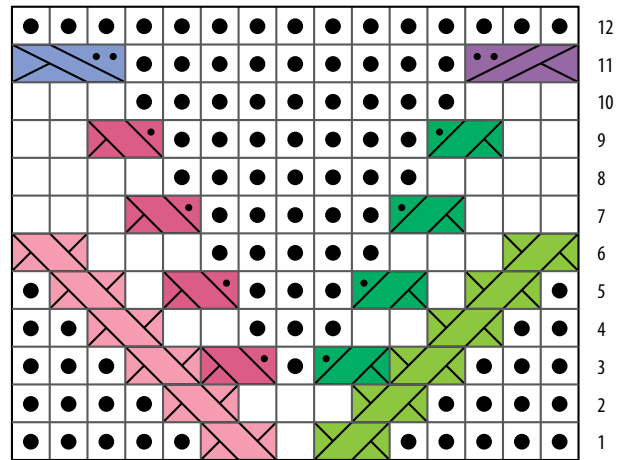




KEY TO CHARTS

 knit


 purl


 sl 1 to cn and hold to FRONT, k1, k1 from cn

 sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k1, k1 from cn

 sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k1, p1 from cn

 sl 1 to cn and hold to FRONT, p1, k1 from cn

 sl 1 to cn and hold to FRONT, p2, k1 from cn

 sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k1, p2 from cn

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needle

cont: continue

dec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: established

inc: increase

K: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand

MC: main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
