**skill level:** Intermediate One size

## finished measurements

70" wide x 36" down center (Not including fringe – after blocking)

### materials

5 balls BERROCO BOBOLI LACE (100 grs), #4390 Sunrise 29" length circular knitting needle, size 6 (4.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE Crochet hook, size 4.00 mm (G)

#### gauge

22 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Garter St (after blocking) TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

## **SHAWL**

With circular needle, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Yo, knit to end of row – 4 sts.

**Row 2 (RS):** Yo, knit to end of row -5 sts.

Rep the last 2 rows until there are 360 sts on needle, end with a WS row.

**Bind-Off Row (Sewn bind-off method):** Cut yarn, leaving a very long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle. \*With yarn threaded on tapestry needle, bring needle and yarn through the first 2 sts on needle (working from right to left). Bring the tapestry needle back through the first st on needle (working from left to right), then drop the st off the needle. Rep from \* until all sts have been bound off.

## **FINISHING**

**Crocheted Edging:** Beg at bound-off edge of shawl. **Row 1:** Using crochet hook, join yarn with a sl st in first yo on right side edge; sc in same yo, \* ch 5, skip 1 yo, sc in next yo, rep from \* along both side edges of shawl, ending back at bound-off edge; ch 3, turn.

**Row 2:** Sc in first ch-5 sp, \* ch 6, sc in next ch-5 sp, rep from \* along both side edges of shawl, ending back at bound-off edge; ch 4, turn.

**Row 3:** Sc in first ch-6 sp, \* ch 7, sc in next ch-6 sp, rep from \* along both side edge of shawl, ending back at bound-off edge. Fasten off.

**Fringe:** Cut six 11-inch strands of yarn. Pull strands together and fold in half. Using crochet hook, draw center of strands through first ch-7 sp on edging forming a loop. Pull ends of strands through loop forming fringe. In this manner, make 1 fringe in each ch-7 sp along side edges of shawl. Trim fringe to even off if necessary.



## **ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS**

**beg:** beginning

ch: chain
rep: repeat
RS: right side
sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
st(s): stitch(es)

ws: wrong side
yo: yarn over

**Garter St:** Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
