materials

2 hanks BERROCO ARTISAN (50 grs), #6035 Norwegian Sea 16" length circular knitting needles, sizes 5 (3.5 mm) and 6 (4.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE 1 set (4) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 6 (4.00 mm) 4 st markers (1 a different color for beg of rnd) Tapestry needle

gauge

20 sts and 28 rnds = 4" in St st on larger needle TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

HAT

With smaller circular needle, cast on 96 sts. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist sts.

Set up rib: *K1, p1, repeat from * to end. Work in 1x1 rib as set until piece measures 3" from the cast-on. Change to larger circular needle and purl 1 round. Knit 1 round. Purl 1 round.

Border pattern:

Rnd 1: P1, k5, rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: *P2, k3, p1, rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * K1, p2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: *K2, p3, k1, rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: * K1, p2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 6: * P2, k3, p1, rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: *P1, k5, rep from * to end.

Knit 1 round. Purl 1 round. Knit 1 round. Purl 1 round.

Next Rnd: * K24, pm, rep from * around – 4 markers on needle.

Main Pattern:

Rnd 1: * [K1, p1] twice, [k3, p1] twice, k1, p1, [k4, p1] twice, sm (slip marker), rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, [k3, p2] twice, sm, rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * K1, [p1, k3] 3 times, p1, [k2, p3] twice, sm, repeat from * to end.

Rnd 4: *K1, p1, k2, p1, k5, p1, k2, p1, [k1, p4] twice, sm, repeat from * to end.

Repeat rounds 1-4 until piece measures 9" from the cast-on, end on Rnd 4 of Main Pattern.

Shape Crown:

Note: As you decrease, when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns.

Dec Rnd 1: *[K1, p1] twice, k2, p3tog, k2, p1, k1, p1, [k3, p2tog] twice, sm (slip marker), rep from * to end—80 sts rem.

Next Rnd: *[K1, p1, k3, p1] twice, [k2, p2] twice, sm, rep from * to end.



Next Rnd: *K1, [p1, k2] twice, k1, p1, k2, p1, [k1, p3] twice, from * to end.

Dec Rnd 2: *[K1, p1] twice, k1, p3tog, [k1, p1] twice, k2, p2tog, k2, p2tog, sm, rep from * to end—64 sts rem.

Next Rnd: *K1, p1, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1, [k1, p2] twice, rep from * to end.

Dec Rnd 3: *[K1, p1] twice, k3tog, [p1, k1] twice, p2tog, k1, p2tog, sm, rep from * to end—48 sts remain.

Next Rnd: *P1, k1, rep from * to end.

Dec Rnd 4: *K3tog, p3tog, rep from * to end—16 sts remain.

Next Rnd: *P1, k1, rep from * to end.

Dec Rnd 5: *K2tog, p2tog, rep from * to end—8 sts remain.

Next Rnd: *P1, k1, rep from * to end.

Break off yarn, leaving an 8" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together,

knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needle cont: continue dec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: establishedinc: increaseK: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) **k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together **k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand **MC:** main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

ch: chain

dc: double crochet **hdc:** half double crochet

sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
