finished measurements

Bust (closed) - 32(36-40-44-48-52)" Length - 17(17-18-18½ -19½ -20)" Note: This garment was designed with approximately 2" of ease. Due to the dolman sleeves, however, the fit is very forgiving and each size will fit multiple sizes.

materials

3(4-4-5-6-6) Hanks BERROCO VINTAGE CHUNKY (100 grs), #6179 Chocolate (A) 4(5-6-6-7-8) Balls BERROCO MARMOT (50 grs), #3743 Amber 29" Length circular knitting needles, sizes 7 (4.50 mm) and 8 (5.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE Straight knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm) 5 St markers Two 1½" buttons

gauge

16 sts = 4"; 28 rows = 4" in Pat St on larger needle 21 sts = 4"; 23 rows = 4" in k2, p2 ribbing on smaller needle TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

note: BOTH st and row gauge are very important to assure that your garment will have the same measurements as on schematic.

PATTERN STITCH

Row 1 (WS): With B, knit. Row 2: Purl. Row 3: Knit. Change to A. Row 4: Knit. Row 5: Purl. Change to B. Row 6: Knit. Row 7: Knit. Row 8: Purl. Row 9: Knit. Rep Rows 4 - 9 for Pat St.

note: This garment is worked sideways in one piece, from left sleeve cuff to right sleeve cuff. Ribbed front/bottom band is picked up and worked during finishing.

LEFT CUFF

With straight needles, using B, cast on 48(48-52-56-60-64) sts using long-tail method. Work even in Pat St for approximately 3", end on WS with Row 9 of Pat. **Shape Sleeve: Inc Row (RS):** K1, M1, k to last st, M1, k1 - 50(50-54-58-62-66) sts. Rep this inc every 4th row twice more, then every RS row 29 times more, working incs into Pat St and ending on WS -112(112-116-120-124-128) sts. Piece should measure approximately 12¹/₂" from beg.

Body: Switching to larger circular needle, cast on 12(12-14-14-16-16) sts at beg of the next 2 rows - 136(136-144-148-156-160) sts. Mark center of row for shoulder line.

note: Decs at each end of needle will be worked at different intervals. Please take care to keep track of each edge independently.

Shape Left Front Edge: Dec 1 st at end of the next RS row, then at same edge EVERY row 21(15-11-5-1-0) times more, every RS row 12(18-24-30-36-35) times, then every 4th row 0(0-0-0-2) times. As you are working decs at left front edge, when piece measures $1\frac{1}{2}(2\frac{1}{2} - 3\frac{1}{2} - 4\frac{1}{2} - 5\frac{1}{2} - 6\frac{1}{2})''$ above last group of caston sts at start of body, end on WS.

Shape Left Front Neck: Next Row (RS): Work 75(75-79-81-85-87) sts and leave these sts on circular needle for back; join another strand of yarn being used and, with straight needle, continuing to dec at left front edge, dec 1 st at beg of the next 14(14-12-10-8-6) RS rows, then at same edge EVERY row 8(8-12-16-20-24) times. When all decs have been completed, end on WS. Bind off remaining 5 sts. **Back:** With WS facing, join yarn being used to first st on circular needle - 75(75-79-81-85-87) sts. Dec 1 st at beg of the next WS row, then at same edge



EVERY row 6 times more - 68(68-72-74-78-80) sts. Work even in pat as established until back measures 9(10-11-12-13-14)" above sts cast on for body, end on WS. **Make a note of the row you just ended with.** The next row of Pat St is the one you will start the right front with. Continue to work even until piece measures 13(14-15-16-17-18)" above sts cast on for body, end on WS. Inc 1 st at end of the next RS row, then at same edge EVERY row 6 times more - 75(75-79-81-85-87) sts. DO NOT break off yarn. Leave sts on needle and set aside for right side.

Right Front: With circular needles, using color needed for first row (see note you made from back), cast on 5 sts.

Shape Left Front Neck: Working in Pat St with next row of pat, Inc 1 st at beg of the next RS row, then at same edge EVERY row 7(7-11-15-19-23) times more, then every RS row 14(14-12-10-8-6) times. While you are working incs for left front neck, also inc 1 st at end of the first RS row, at same edge every 4th row 0(0-0-0-0-1) time more, every RS row 11(17-23-29-35-36) times, then EVERY row 22(16-12-6-2-0) times for right front edge. When all left front neck incs have been completed, end on WS.

Joining Row (RS): With RS facing, using circular needle and yarn still attached to last st worked, work across sts on straight needle, increasing at end as before. Continue to work in pat as established, increasing at right front edge as before. When all incs have been completed, end on WS - 136(136-144-148-156-160) sts.

Right Sleeve: Bind off 12(12-14-14-16-16) sts at beg of the next 2 rows - 112(112-116-120-124-128) sts. Dec 1 st each side every RS row 29 times, then every 4th row 3 times - 48(48-52-56-60-64) sts. Continue to work even until sleeve measures 12¹/₂" above sts bound off for right sleeve, end on WS. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew side and sleeve seams.


Front and Bottom Band: With RS facing, using smaller circular needle and A, beg at center of back neck, pick up and k30 sts across back neck edge, 32(32-36-36-40-40) sts along left front neck edge, place marker, pick up and k6 sts along 5 sts bound off on left front, place marker, pick up and k58(58-60-60-62-62) sts along lower left front edge, 86(94-106-118-126-138) sts across lower back edge, 58(58-60-60-62) sts along lower right front edge, place marker, pick up and k6 sts along 5 sts cast on for right front, place marker, pick up and k6 sts along 5 sts cast on for right front, place marker, pick up and k32(32-36-36-40-40) sts along right front neck edge, then 28 sts across remaining back neck edge - 336(344-368-380-400-412) sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up.

Rnd 1: * K2, p2, rep from * around.

Inc Rnd: Work to first marker, sl marker, p2, M1, k2, M1, p2, sl marker, work to next marker, sl marker, p2, M1, k2, M1, p2, sl marker, work to end - 340(348-372-384-404-416) sts.

Next Rnd: Work even, working incs into ribbing as sts become available. Rep the last 2 rnds once more - 344(352-376-388-408-420) sts.

Rnd 6: Buttonhole Rnd: Work to first marker, sl marker, p2, M1, k2, p2, k2, M1, p2, sl marker, work to next marker, sl marker, p2, M1, k2, yo, p2 tog, k2, M1, p2, sl marker, work to end - 348(356-380-392-412-424) sts. Continue to inc 4 sts in this manner every RS row, making one more buttonhole in center 2 sts of right front on Rnd 14. When band measures 3", bind off in ribbing. Sew on buttons.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
KSP: Knit 1, then slip stitch base

KSP: Knit 1, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift 2nd stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on RH needle (1 stitch decreased).

K2SP: Knit 2 together, then slip stitch back to left hand needle, lift second stitch on left hand needle back over returned stitch and replace returned stitch on right hand needle (2 stitches decreased).

LH: left hand

lp(s): loop(s)

LT2 (Left Twist): Skip 1 stitch, knit second stitch through back loop, then knit both stitches together through back loop

MC: main color

M1k: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch (1 stitch increased).

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

rem: remaining

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

RT2 (Right Twist): Knit 2 stitches together, leaving them on the left hand needle, then knit the first stitch again slipping both stitches to the right hand needle. **SKP:** slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over

sl: slip

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s) tog: together WS: wrong side wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front yo: yarn over end on WS: and baying just completed a b

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle. Reverse St

st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

bphdc (back post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on even # or wrong side rows).

bptr (back post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from back to front around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

fphdc (front post half double crochet): Yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front around post of half double crochet one row below, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook (this is worked on odd # or right side rows)

fptr (front post triple): Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back around post of stitch on previous row and pull up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

hdc: half double crochet

hdctbl: Half double crochet worked in the back loop hdctfl: Half double crochet worked in the front loop sl st: slip stitch sp: space

tr: treble

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
