11 GINGERBREAD SHRUG

Designed by Amy Christoffers Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Approximately 31/2" wide (not including sleeves) and 3" tall

materials

1 hank *BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA* (100 grs), #6292 Tiger's Eye Mix

1 set (4) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 6 (4.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE 1 button (optional)

gauge

20 sts and 24 rows = 4" in [k1, p1] rib TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

BODY

Note: work Body using just 2 dpns, working back and forth in rows.

Cast on 11 sts.

Set up rib (RS): *K1, p1, rep from * to last stitch, k1. Work in 1x1 rib as set for 40 rows more ending with a WS row.

Pick up row: With RS facing, work 11 sts in rib, turn piece 90 degrees, skip the first 12 rows, pick up and knit 17 sts along the edge to last 12 rows, skip the last 12 rows, turn piece 90 degress and pick up and knit 11 stitches along the cast-on edge—39 sts. Knit 1 (WS) row.

Set up rib (RS): *K1, p1, rep from * to last stitch, k1. Work in 1x1 rib as set for 3 rows more, ending with a WS row. Bind off in rib.

SLEEVES (make 2)

With dpns, pick up and knit 12 sts evenly around an armhole (created on the pick up row). Divide the sts evenly over 3 dpns and join for working in the round. Work in reverse stockinette stitch for 8 rounds. Bind off purlwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Sew on button and block as desired.



2 HOLLY SWEATER

Designed by Alison Green Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Approximately 23/4" wide (not including sleeves) and 31/2" tall

materials

1 hank *BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA LIGHT* (50 grs), #4201 Winter White (MC), and small amounts of #42181 Ruby Mix (CC1) & #42184 Emerald Mix (CC2) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 5 (3.75 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE and size 4 (3.5 mm) stitch marker

gauge

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" in St st using larger needles TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

BODY

With smaller dpns and CC1, cast on 32 sts. Divide sts evenly on 3 dpns, pm and join for working in the rnd. Purl one rnd. Change to larger needle. Leave CC1 attached, join MC and knit one rnd with MC. Join CC2 and work Rnds 1-5 from chart, repeating chart 8 times in each rnd. Break off CC1 and CC2, and work in St st using MC until piece measures approximately 2½".

Next Rnd: * Bind off 1 st, knit 15 (including st remaining from bind off), rep from * once more. Turn. Work remainder of Body back and forth in rows. Work 7 rows in St st.

Bind off 4, knit to last 4 sts, bind off 4. Place remaining 7 sts on hold for back neck.

Rejoin MC to WS of front. Work 7 rows St st.

Next row: K3, k2tog, turn. Purl 4. Bind off 4.

Place 5 sts on hold for front neck, rejoin MC to rem 5

sts on RS, SSK, knit to end. Purl next row, then bind off.

Sew right shoulder.

Neckline: With CC2 and smaller needle, starting at front left shoulder, pick up and knit 3 sts on side of neck, knit across 5 front neck sts, pick up and knit 3 on side of neck, knit 7 back neck sts. Bind off knitwise on WS.

Sew left shoulder and side of neck (using ends).

SLEEVES (make 2)


Using MC and larger dpns, pick up and knit 14 sts around armhole. Divide sts evenly on 3 dpns, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work in St st for approximately 1½". Join CC1.

Next Rnd: * K1 using MC, k1 using CC1, rep from * to end. Do not break CC1. Knit 1 rnd using MC. Join CC2. Next Rnd: * K1 using CC2, k1 using MC, rep from * to end. Break CC2. Knit 1 rnd using MC. Bind off purlwise using CC1.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

6 CANE SWEATER

Designed by Ashley Palumbo Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Approximately $2\frac{3}{4}$ " wide (not including sleeves) and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " tall

materials

1 hank *BERROCO COSMA* (50 grs), #2420 Hibiscus double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 5 (3.75 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

gauge

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" in St st TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

FRONT AND BACK (make 2)

Note: work Body using just 2 dpns, working back and forth in rows.

Cast on 17 sts. Work even following Body Chart. Bind off on WS in the following pattern: 4 purlwise, 9 knitwise, 4 purlwise.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Note: work Sleeves using just 2 dpns, working back and forth in rows.

Cast on 15 sts. Work even following Sleeve Chart. Bind off.

FINISHING

Seam first and last 4 sts of Front and Back for shoulder seams.

Rolled Collar: Pick up and knit 20 sts around neckline, dividing sts evenly onto 3 dpns. Pm and join for working in ther rnd. Knit 2 rnds.

Next Rnd: * M1, k5, rep from * around. 25 sts. Knit 2 rnds. Bind off. Weave in ends.



4 CONFETTI SWEATER

Designed by Emily Nora O'Neil Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Approximately 3" wide (not including sleeves) and 3½" tall


materials

1 hank *BERROCO COSMA* (50 grs), #2401 Magnolia (MC), and small amounts of #2460 Lotus (CC1), #2430 Poppy (CC2) and 2423 Narcissus (CC3) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 4 (3.5 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE and size 2 (2.75 mm) waste yarn

gauge

27 sts and 34 rows = 4" in St st using larger needles TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

BODY CHART



STITCH GLOSSARY

Make bobble: with CC indicated, [k1, k1tbl] into next st, turn. P2, turn. K2, then pass first st over second st. Cut CC, knotting the ends together on WS.

BODY

With smaller needles and MC, cast on 36 sts, dividing evenly over 3 dpns. Pm and joing for working in the rnd. Work in [k1, p1] ribbing for 4 rnds. Change to larger needles. Work Rnds 1-16 from Body Chart, repeating 18 chart sts twice per rnd.

BACK

Turn and p18 (Row 17 of Body Chart) onto 1 dpn, leaving remaining 18 sts on spare dpn for Front. Work Rows 18-20 from Body Chart, working back and forth in rows. Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Place rem 8 sts on waste yarn for neck.

FRONT

Rejoin yarn to Front sts on WS. Complete same as for Back.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Seam shoulders. Using larger needles, pick up and knit 14 sts around, dividing evenly on 3 dpns. Work even from Sleeve Chart, repeating 7 charted sts twice per rnd. When chart is complete, change to smaller neeldes and work in [k1, p1] rib for 3 rnds. Bind off in rib.

FINISHING

Collar: With smaller needles, pick up and knit 16 sts around neckline, dividing sts evenly onto 3 dpns. Pm and join for working in the rnd. Work in [k1, p1] rib for 3 rnds. Bind off in pattern.

Weave in ends.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together,

knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needlecont: continuedec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: establishedinc: increaseK: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) **k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together **k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand **MC:** main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

ch: chain

dc: double crochet **hdc:** half double crochet

sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
