1 CROCHETED NECKLACE

Skill level: Intermediate

One size

finished measurements

Approximately 17" long (not including clasp)

materials

1 hank **BERROCO MYKONOS** (50 grs), #8560 Apollo

Crochet hook, size 3.75mm (F)

Clasp (sample used a magnetic clasp)

Sewing needle & thread

gauge

17½ hdc = 4"

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

STITCH GLOSSARY

3Hdctog

[Yo, pull up a loop in ch-1 sp, yo and pull through 2 loops] 3 times, yo and pull through all loops on hook – forms hdctog cluster

4Hdctog

[Yo, pull up a loop in ch-1 sp, yo and pull through 2 loops] 4 times, yo and pull through all loops on hook – forms hdctog cluster

NECKLACE

Ch 78.

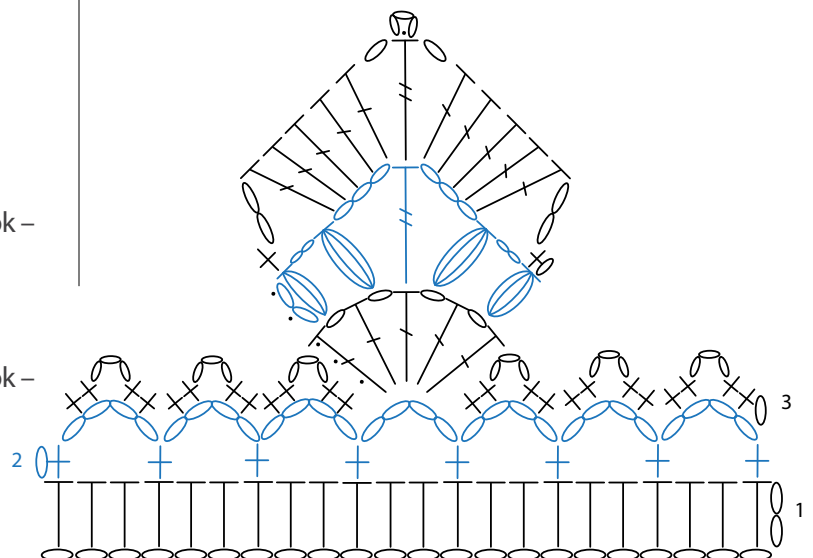
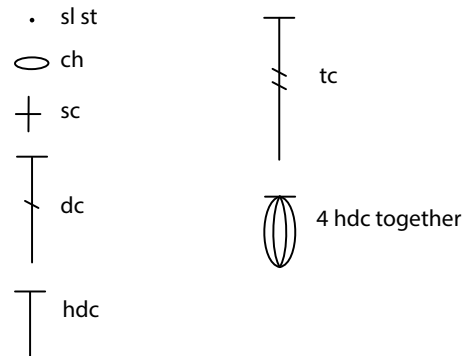
Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, * ch 4, sk 2 hdc, sc in next st, rep from * to end. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, * 2 sc in ch-4 sp, ch 3, 2 sc in same ch-4 sp, sk sc, rep from * 11 times more, [dc, ch 1] 4 times in next ch-4 sp, dc in same ch-4 sp, turn, ch 2, 3Hdctog in ch-1 sp, ch 2, sk next dc, 4Hdctog in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in next dc, ch 3, 4Hdctog in next ch-1 sp, ch 2, sk next dc, 4Hdctog in next ch-1 sp, turn, ch 1, sc in 4Hdctog, ch 2, sk ch-2 sp and next cluster, 4 dc in ch-3 sp, ch 2, tr in next tr, ch 3, sl st in tr, ch 2, 4 dc in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk next cluster and ch-2 sp, sc in next hdc cluster, sl st along side of medallion to next ch-4 sp, ** 2 sc in ch-4 sp, ch 3, 2 sc in same ch-4 sp, sk sc, rep from * 10 times more, 2 sc in ch-4 sp, ch 3, 2 sc in same ch-4 sp.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Using sewing needle and thread, sew on clasp.

2 MUG RUG

Skill level: Intermediate

One size

finished measurements

Approximately 5" x 5"

materials

1 ball each **BERROCO CORSICA** (50 grs), #3615 Conch (A), #3642 Rose Petal (B), #3619 Fig (C), #3616 Pear (D) and 1 hank **BERROCO COSMA** #2471 Willow (E)
Crochet hook, size D (3.25 mm)

gauge

Five-Petal Flower = approximately 1 3/4" across
TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

STITCH GLOSSARY

4Trtog

*Yo twice, insert hook into st, yo and pull up a loop, [yo, draw through 2 loops] twice, rep from * 3 more times (5 loops on hook), yo, draw through all loops on hook.

3Dctog

*Yo, insert hook in stitch, yo and pull up loop, yo, draw through 2 loops, rep from * 2 more times (4 loops on hook), yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

Note

Leave long tails to tack the flowers together. Or you can join the flowers with a sl st as you go.

FIVE-PETAL FLOWER (make 2 each in B and E, and 1 in C)

Ch 7, sl st in first ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 14 sc into ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: * Ch 4, 4Trtog, inserting hook twice in next sc and twice in following sc, ch 4, sc in next sc, rep from * 4 times more, end with a sl st in beg ch instead of sc.

Fasten off.

SMALL CIRCLE (make 3)

With D, work Rnd 1 of Five-Petal Flower. Fasten off.

FOUR-PETAL FLOWER (make 2)

With D, ch 4, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 7 sc into ring, sl st in beg ch, fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join A in sl st, * ch 3, 3Dctog all in back loop of next sc, ch 3, sc into center ring, skip next sc, rep from * 3 times more, sl st in beg ch. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Using the tails, tack flowers and circles together using photo as a guide. Steam finished piece.



3 GIFT CARD HOLDER

Skill level: Easy

One size

finished measurements

Approximately 4 1/4" wide and 2 1/2" tall (after sewing)

materials

1 hank **BERROCO MIXER** (50 grs), #8144 Jive
straight needles, size 7 (4.50 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

gauge

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in garter st

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

GIFT CARD HOLDER

Cast on 20 stitches. Knit 18 rows. Purl 1 row. Knit 18 rows. Bind off all stitches, leaving a long tail. Sew bind-off edge to cast-on edge, then sew one end of piece closed. Turn piece inside out to hide seam.



4 BRACELET

Skill level: Intermediate

Shown in size M

sizes

Directions are for women's size Small. Changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses

finished measurements

Approximately ½" wide and 15(16½-18)" long

materials

1 hank **BERROCO INDIGO** (100 grs), #6407 Faded
3 double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 2 (2.75 mm) OR
SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
waste yarn
darning needle
1 button, size ⅝"

gauge

6 sts = ½" and 30 rows = 4" in pattern st

BRACELET

Using the provisional cast on method of your choice, cast on 3 sts. * K3, do not turn, slip 3 sts back to the left hand needle. Rep from * for 9 rounds more.

Next rnd: Place the sts from the provisional cast on onto the 3rd needle. With this needle held in front, and the working needle held in back work as follows: * K1 stitch from the cast on sts on needle #3, k1 from the working needle, rep from * to the end of the row— 6 sts on the needles. You will now be working back and forth in rows.

Row 1 (RS): K3, (yo) twice, k3.

Row 2: P3, p1, k1, p3.

Row 3: K2, SSK, k2tog, k2.

Rows 4 & 6: Purl.

Row 5: Slip 3 sts onto the 3rd needle, hold in front, k3, k3 from needle #3.

Rep rows 1–6, 16 (18, 20) times more or to desired length.

Next row: K2tog, k2, SSK. Purl 1 row.

Next row: K2tog, SSK.

Bind off purl wise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Sew a button to the bound off end.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
