**skill level:** Easy  
One size

**finished measurements**  
Approximately 46" wide x 25" long  
(Not including fringe)

**yarn**  
**BERROCO SUEDE** (50 grs), 6 balls  
#3714 Hopalong Cassidy

**Needles and Notions**  
29" circular needle, size 10 (6.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge  
Crochet hook, size 5.00 mm (H)

**gauge**  
15 sts and 16 rows = 4" in Garter St  
To save time, take time to check gauge

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**NOTE:** We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. ## SHAWL

With circular needle, cast on 2 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, knit in front and back of next st – 3 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit to last st, knit in front and back of last st – 4 sts.

Rep Row 2 until there are 175 sts on needle. Bind off all sts knitwise.

## FINISHING

**Fringe:** Cut two 14" long strands of yarn. Put strands together and fold in half. With crochet hook, draw center of strands through cast-on st at point of shawl forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. In this manner, make fringe in between Garter ridges along each slanted edge of shawl. Trim fringe to even off if necessary.

**Note:** For speedier cutting, wrap yarn multiple times around a piece of cardboard that is half the length of the strands (7"). Cut lower edge to free strands.



## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**k:** knit

**rep:** repeat

**RS:** right side

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**Garter St:** Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
