materials

4(5-5-6-6-7-8) balls **BERROCO BRIZA** (40 grs), #9301 Del Norte 29" and 16" length circular knitting needles, size 7 (4.50 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
1 st marker

gauge

20 sts and 30 rows = 4" in St st
TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

NOTE: We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

NOTE

This garment is worked in one piece, starting at lower front edge and ending at lower back edge. Stitches are cast on, then bound off for sleeves.

FRONT

With longer circular needle, cast on 81(93-101-113-121-133-141) sts. DO NOT join. Beg on WS, work Rows 1 – 11 of chart, end on WS. Work even in St st until piece measures 16" from beg, end on WS. Mark beg and end of last row.

Beg Sleeves: Cast on 7 sts at beg of the next 20 rows – 221(233-241-253-261-273-281) sts. Work even until sleeves measure 3(3-3½-4-4½-5-5½)" above markers, end on RS. Work even, following chart, for 5", end on RS with Row 8 of chart.

Shape Neck: Next Row (WS): Work Row 9 of chart over 88(94-98-104-108-114-118) sts, bind off center 45 sts for front neck, work to end.

Following Row (RS): Work Row 10 of chart over 88(94-98-104-108-114-118) sts, cast on 45 sts, work to end – 221(233-241-253-261-273-281) sts.

Back: Continue to work even, following chart, until sleeves measure approximately 5" above neck, end on WS with Row 3 of chart. Work even in St st until sleeves measure 13(13-14-15-16-17-18)" above markers, end on WS.

End Sleeves: Bind off 7 sts at beg of the next 20 rows – 81(93-101-113-120-133-141) sts. Mark beg and end of last row. Work even in St st until piece measures 14¾" above markers, end on RS. Work Rows 1 – 11 of chart, end on WS. Bind off.

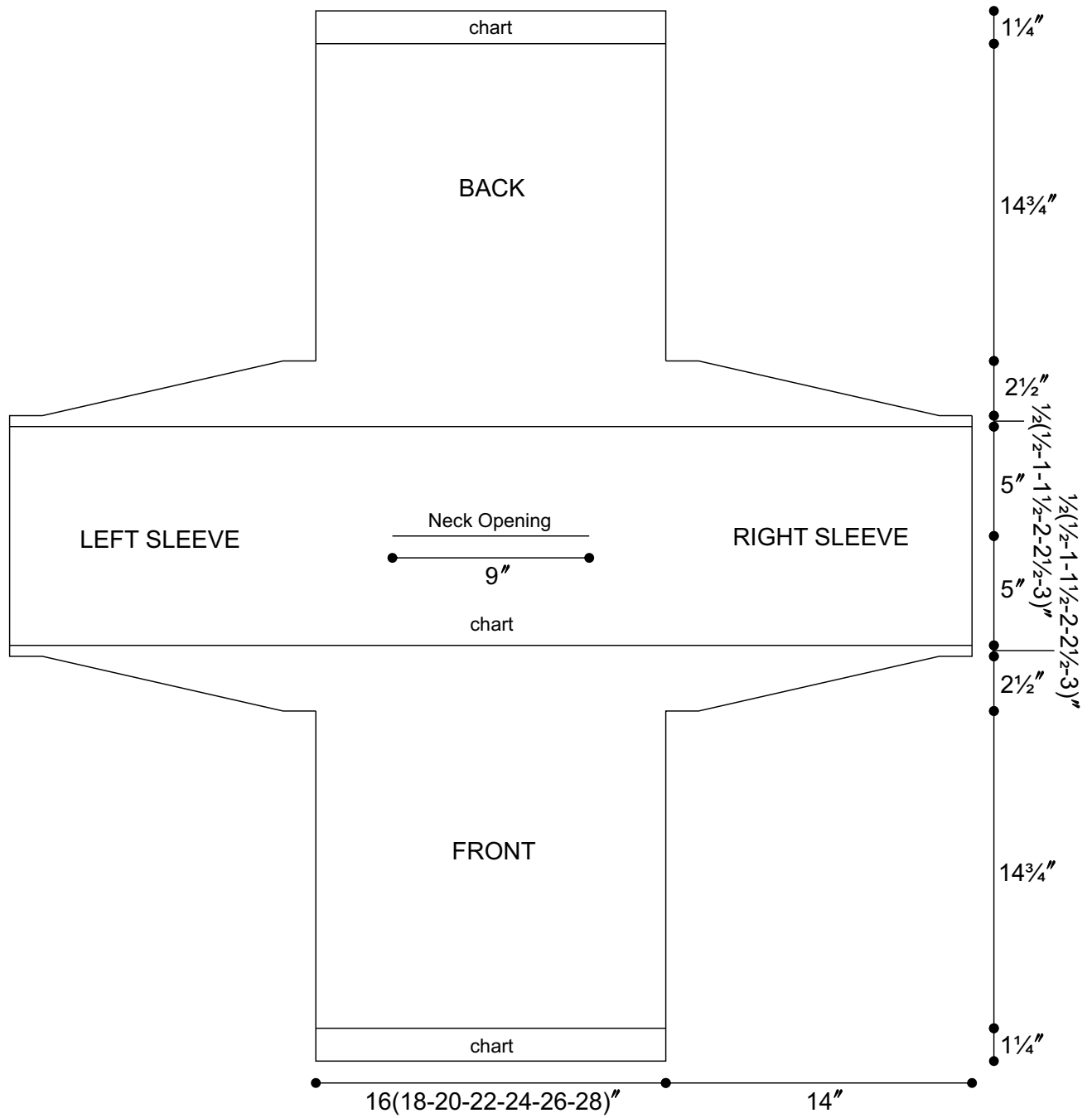
FINISHING

Neckband: With RS facing, using shorter circular needle, beg at shoulder, pick up and k90 sts around entire neck. Join for working in the round. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd. Bind off all sts knitwise. Sew side and sleeve seams.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needle

cont: continue

dec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: established

inc: increase

K: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand

MC: main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
