**skill level:** Intermediate Shown in size 37"

**finished measurements** Bust – 32(37-40-45-48-53-56)" Length – 23½(24-24½-25-25½-26-26½)"

#### materials

4(5-5-6-6-7-8) balls BERROCO BRIZA (40 grs), #9301 Del Norte 29" and 16" length circular knitting needles, size 7 (4.50 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE 1 st marker

#### gauge

20 sts and 30 rows = 4" in St st TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

# NOTE

This garment is worked in one piece, starting at lower front edge and ending at lower back edge. Stitchess are cast on, then bound off for sleeves.

## FRONT

With longer circular needle, cast on 81(93-101-113-121-133-141) sts. DO NOT join. Beg on WS, work Rows 1 – 11 of chart, end on WS. Work even in St st until piece measures 16" from beg, end on WS. Mark beg and end of last row.

**Beg Sleeves:** Cast on 7 sts at beg of the next 20 rows – 221(233-241-253-261-273-281) sts. Work even until sleeves measure  $3(3-3\frac{1}{2}-4-4\frac{1}{2}-5-5\frac{1}{2})$ " above markers, end on RS. Work even, following chart, for 5", end on RS with Row 8 of chart.

**Shape Neck: Next Row (WS):** Work Row 9 of chart over 88(94-98-104-108-114-118) sts, bind off center 45 sts for front neck, work to end.

**Following Row (RS):** Work Row 10 of chart over 88(94-98-104-108-114-118) sts, cast on 45 sts, work to end – 221(233-241-253-261-273-281) sts.

**Back:** Continue to work even, following chart, until sleeves measure approximately 5" above neck, end on WS with Row 3 of chart. Work even in St st until sleeves measure 13(13-14-15-16-17-18)" above markers, end on WS.

**End Sleeves:** Bind off 7 sts at beg of the next 20 rows – 81(93-101-113-120-133-141) sts. Mark beg and end of last row. Work even in St st until piece measures 14<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" above markers, end on RS. Work Rows 1 – 11 of chart, end on WS. Bind off.


## FINISHING

**Neckband:** With RS facing, using shorter circular needle, beg at shoulder, pick up and k90 sts around entire neck. Join for working in the round. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd. Bind off all sts knitwise. Sew side and sleeve seams.





On RS, beg at A, work to C, rep between B and C. On WS, beg at C, work to B, rep between C and B, end at A.



## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

#### Knit

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over. **cn:** cable needle cont: continue dec: decrease **dpn:** double pointed needles est: established inc: increase K: knit **k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s) k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together LH: left hand MC: main color M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1

stitch increased). M1L: Work as for M1.

**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

**M1pR:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**p:** purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

- st(s): stitch(es)
- TBL: through back loop(s)
- tog: together
- WS: wrong side
- wyib: with yarn in back
- wyif: with yarn in front
- yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

ch: chain
dc: double crochet
hdc: half double crochet
sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
