
5(6-6-7-7-8-9) hanks BERROCO LINUS (50 grs), #6842 Skimmer Straight knitting needles, size 9 (5.50 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE 16" length circular knitting needle, size 7 (4.50 mm) 2 st markers

gauge

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in St st on size 9 (5.50 mm) needles 19 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Pat St on size 9 (5.50 mm) needles TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

PATTERN STITCH (Multiple of 5 sts + 4)

Row 1 (RS): K2, * k2 tog, yo, k1, yo, SSK, rep from *

to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep these 2 rows for Pat St.

BACK

With straight needles, cast on 84(92-102-112-120-130-138) sts. Work even in St st for 1", end on WS. **Establish Pat St: Row 1 (RS):** K25(29-34-39-43-48-52), pm, work Row 1 of Pat St over 34 sts, pm, k to end.

Row 2: P to first marker, work Row 2 of Pat St to last marker, p to end. Work even in pat as established until piece measures 14" from beg, end on WS.

Shape Raglan Armholes: Bind off 4(5-5-6-6-7-8) sts at beg of the next 2 rows – 76(82-92-100-108-116-122) sts.

For Sizes S, M, L, 1X, 2X and 3X ONLY: Dec Row 1 (RS): K1, k3tog, work to last 4 sts, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k1 – 4 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row X(2-5-8-10-13-14) times more, end on WS – X(70-68-64-64-60-62) sts.

For ALL Sizes: Dec Row 2 (RS): K1, k2 tog, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1 – 2 sts dec'd. Rep this dec every RS row 20(17-16-14-14-12-13) times more, end on WS – 34 sts. Bind off for back neck.

FRONT

Work as for back until armholes measure approximately 5(5-5½-6-6½-7-7½)", end on WS. Mark center 22 sts on last row.





Next Row (RS): K1, k2 tog, work to first neck marker, join another hank of yarn and bind off center 22 sts, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1. Working both sides at once, continue to dec at armhole edges as

before. AT THE SAME

TIME, dec 1 st at each

Shape Neck:

neck edge EVERY row 5 times. When all neck and armhole decs have been completed, fasten off last st each side.

SLEEVES

With straight needles, cast on 45(45-45-45-49-49-49) sts. Work even in St st for 2", end on WS.

Establish Pat St: Row 1 (RS): K13(13-13-13-15-15-15), pm, work Row 1 of Pat St over 19 sts, pm, k to end.

Row 2: P to first marker, work Row 2 of Pat St to last marker, p to end.

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1L, work to last st, M1R, k1 – 2 sts inc'd. Working in pat as established, rep Inc Row every $2\frac{1}{4}(1\frac{1}{2}-1-\frac{3}{4}-\frac{3}{4}-\frac{1}{2}-\frac{1}{2})^{"}4(6-8-11-11-13-15)$ times more – 55(59-63-69-73-77-81) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 12″ from beg, end on WS.


Shape Raglan Cap: Bind off 4(5-5-6-6-7-8) sts at beg of the next 2 rows – 47(49-53-57-61-63-65) sts. Work 2 rows even, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1 – 2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 4th row 6(5-5-4-4-4-5) times more, then every RS row 7(9-11-14-16-17-17) times, end on WS. Bind off remaining 19 sts.

FINISHING

Sew raglan sleeve caps to raglan armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neckband: With RS facing, using circular needle, beg at left back raglan seam, pick up and k 114 sts evenly spaced around entire neck edge. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Work even in St st (k EVERY rnd) for 1". Bind off knitwise.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
