1 ball BERROCO GINGKO (50 grs), #9615 Tourmaline

needles and notions

Crochet hook, size 4.50 mm (7) or size to obtain gauge

gauge

17 sts and 13 rows = 4" in Pat St TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK **GAUGE**

STITCH GLOSSARY

FPtr: Front Post Treble

Yo twice, insert hook from front to back around post of st indicated, * yo and pull up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times. (Skip hdc behind FPtr).

HEADBAND

Ch 19.

Pattern Stitch: Set-Up Row (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (counts as hdc), and in each ch across – 17 hdc. Turn.

Row 1 and all WS rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in each st across. Turn.


Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next 2 hdc, * skip next 2 hdc, FPtr around st one row below next 2 hdc; working in front of FPtr just made, work FPtr around st one row below each skipped hdc; hdc in next 3 hdc, rep from * once more. Turn.

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next 2 hdc, * work FPtr around next 4 FPtr, hdc in next 3 hdc, rep from * once more. Turn.

Rep Rows 1 – 4 until piece measures 18" (or desired length). Fasten off, leaving a 10" long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Sew 2 short ends of headband together. Weave in all ends and block as desired.
