

## COWL

With A, ch 240, join with a sl st in first ch, being careful not to twist ch.

Rnd 1: Sc in first ch, \* skip 3 ch, dc in next ch, (ch 1, dc in same ch) 3 times (shell made), ch 1, skip 3 ch, sc in next ch, rep from \* 28 times more, skip 3 ch, dc in next ch, (ch 1, dc in same ch) 3 times more, ch 1, skip 3 ch, join with a sl st in first sc – 30 shells + 30 sc's. Change to B.

**Rnd 2:** With B, ch 6 (counts as 1 dc + ch 3), skip 2 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, skip 2 dc, dc in next sc, \* ch 3, skip 2 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, skip 2 dc, dc in next sc, rep from \* 28 times more, ch 3, skip 2 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, skip 2 dc, join with a sl st in 4th ch of beg ch-6.

Rnd 3: With B, ch 2 (counts as 1 sc + ch 1), skip 3 ch, dc in next sc, (ch 1, dc in same sc) 3 times, ch 1, skip 3 ch, sc in next dc, \* ch 1, skip 3 ch, dc in next sc, (ch 1, dc in same sc) 3 times (shell made), ch 1, skip 3 ch, sc in next dc, rep from \* 28 times more, ch 1, skip 3 ch, dc in next sc, (ch 1, dc in same sc) 3 times, ch 1, skip 3 ch, join with a sl st in first ch of beg ch-2. Change to A. Working 2 rnds with each color, rep Rnds 2 and 3 until piece measures 8" from beg, end with Rnd 3. Fasten off.

### Knit

knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

**LH:** left hand **MC:** main color

**M1:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**M1pL:** Work as for M1p.

**M1pR:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**p:** purl

**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

**psso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

**sl:** slip

sm: slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**TBL:** through back loop(s)

**tog:** together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
