16 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Oakleaf
and Acorn Border Pat

20 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Eyelet

STITCH GLOSSARY

Drop extra yo: At beg of row, drop one yo, leaving single elongated yo on needle. Knit this yo as the first st of the following k3.

SHAWL BORDER

With straight needles, cast on 40 sts. Knit 1 row on WS.

Oakleaf and Acorn Border Pattern

Note: Due to the nature of this pat, the number of sts will vary from row to row. The number given after rows is the number of sts you should have after completing that row.

Row 1 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, kf&b, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k4, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k2 – 44 sts.

Row 2: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p18, [k1, p9] twice, k4 – 45 sts.

Row 3: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, [kf&b] 3 times, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, [yo, k2tog] twice, p1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, [yo, k5] twice, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k2, drop extra yo – 49 sts.

Row 4: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p20, k1, p8, k1, p13, k4 – 50 sts.

Row 5: K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, yo, k6, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2tog, yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2tog, yo, k7, yo, k6, yo, [k2tog, yo] twice, k2, drop extra yo – 50 sts.

Row 6: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p30, k1, p13, k4 – 51 sts.

Row 7: K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, yo, k6, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, SSK, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, transfer the last 2 sts on RH needle back to LH needle, then knit these same 2 sts tog, yo, k4, p1, k4, yo, k4, k2tog, yo, k1, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k2, drop extra yo – 49 sts.

Row 8: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p17, k1, p11, k1, p13, k4 – 50 sts.

Row 9: K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, yo, k6, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k3, k2tog, yo, k3, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k2, drop extra yo – 49 sts.

Row 10: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p18, k1, p10, k1, p4, [kf&b]



6 times, p3, k4 – 56 sts.

Row 11: K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, yo, p12, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k4, yo, SSK, k3, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k2, drop extra yo – 55 sts.

Row 12: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p19, k1, p9, k1, p4, [k2tog] 6 times, p3, k4 – 50 sts.

Row 13: K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, yo, p6, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k4, yo, SSK, k1, k2tog, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, k1, drop extra yo – 48 sts.

Row 14: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p18, k1, p9, k1, p4, [k2tog] 3 times, p3, k4 – 46 sts.

Row 15: K3, yo, k2tog, [k1, yo] twice, p3tog, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, kf&b, yo, k5, yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, k1, drop extra yo – 46 sts.

Row 16: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p19, k1, p9, k1, p10, k4 – 47 sts.

Row 17: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, k2, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, [Kf&b] 3 times, yo, k7, k2tog, [yo, k2tog] twice, k1, drop extra yo – 50 sts.

Row 18: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p22, k1, p9, k1, p11, k4 – 51 sts.

Row 19: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, [yo, k2tog] twice, p1, [k2tog, yo] twice, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k6, yo, k2tog, k3, k2tog, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, k1, drop extra yo – 49 sts.

Row 20: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p21, k1, p8, k1, p12, k4 – 50 sts.

Row 21: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k7, yo, k2tog, yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k6, yo, k2tog, k2, k2tog, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, drop extra yo, k1 – 48 sts.

Row 22: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p20, k1, p21, k4 – 49 sts.

Row 23: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k4, p1, k4, yo, SSK, sl 1, k2tog, psso, transfer the last 2 sts on RH needle back to LH needle and knit these same 2 sts tog, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k6, yo, k2tog, k3, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, drop extra yo, k1 – 46 sts.

Row 24: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p10, [kf&b] 6 times, p4, k1, p11, k1, p7, k4 – 53 sts.

Row 25: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2tog, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, p12, yo, k2tog, k3, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, drop extra yo, k1 – 51 sts.

Row 26: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p10, [k2tog] 6 times, p4, k1, p10, k1, p7, k4 – 46 sts.

Row 27: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, p6, yo, k2tog, k1, k2tog, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, drop extra yo, k1 – 43 sts.

Row 28: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p9, [k2tog] 3 times, p4, k1, p9, k1, p7, k4 – 41 sts.

Row 29: K3, yo, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, p3tog, yo, k1, yo, k3, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, drop extra yo, k1 – 40 sts.

Row 30: [Yo] twice, p2tog, p16, k1, p9, k1, p7, k4 – 41 sts.

Rep these 30 rows, dropping extra yo at end of each repeat of Row 1 for Oakleaf and Acorn Border Pat. Work even in Oakleaf and Acorn Border Pat until 30 rows of pat have been completed 15 times (450 rows total), end with a WS row. Bind off purlwise.

SHAWL BODY

With RS of border facing you and the cast-on edge at bottom, using circular needle, pick up and knit 451 sts along straight edge of border to your right. Purl 1 row on WS.

Eyelet Check Pattern (Multiple of 8 sts + 3)

Row 1 (RS): K2, * p3, k5, rep from * to last st, end k1.

Row 2: P1, * p5, k3, rep from * to last 2 sts, end p2.

Row 3: K2, * p1, yo, p2tog, k5, rep from * to last st, end k1.

Row 4: P1, * p5, k3, rep from * to last 2 sts, end p2.

Row 5: K2, * p3, k5, rep from * to last st, end k1.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: K1, * k5, p3, rep from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 8: P2, * k3, p5, rep from * to last st, end p1.

Row 9: K1, * k5, p1, yo, p2tog, rep from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 10: P2, * k3, p5, rep from * to last st, end p1.

Row 11: K1, * k5, p3, rep from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 12: Purl.

Rep these 12 rows for Eyelet Check Pat.

Work even in Eyelet Check Pat until 12 rows of pat have been completed 5 times total, then work Rows 1 – 5 once more, end with a RS row.

Top Edging: With WS facing, cast on 4 sts by knitting on.

Row 1 (WS): K1, yo, k2tog, k3tog, turn – 4 sts on RH needle.

Row 2 (RS): Knit. Rep these 2 rows until 4 sts remain, end with a WS row. Bind off knitwise on RS.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
CDD (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)
est: established
inc: increase
k: knit
k TBL: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
kf&b: knit in the front and back of the stitch (1 stitch increased)
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p TBL: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker
SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.
SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.
st(s): stitch(es)
TBL: through back loop(s)
tog: together
w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. With yarn held in back, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle, then bring the yarn to the back again. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row
Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.
Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.
Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
