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skill level: Easy

One size

finished measurements

Approximately 6½" wide x 5¼" high (with flap folded down, not *including fringe or strap)*

materials

1 hank BERROCO ESPRESSO (150 grs), #7956 Fico Straight knitting needles, size 101/2 (6.50 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN **GAUGE** Crochet hook, size 6.50 mm (K)

gauge

12 sts and 20 rows = 4" in St st TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK **GAUGE**

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NOTE: We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

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PURSE

With straight needles, cast on 23 sts. Knit 4 rows. Work even in St st until piece measures 5" from beg, end on RS. Knit 1 row on WS for turning ridge. Work even in St st until piece measures 51/4" above turning ridge, end on WS.

Flap: Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, k to last st, SSK, k1 – 2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row 8 times more, end on WS – 5 sts remain.

Next Row (RS): K1, CDD, k1 – 3 sts.

Last Row: P3tog. Break off yarn and fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold purse along turning ridge so that wrong sides are together. Sew side edges tog.

Strap: Cut six 60" long strands of yarn. Holding strands together, tie one end. Divide into 3 groups of 2 strands each and braid together. Tie the other end, then sew one tied end to the inside of each side of purse at seam.

Fringe: Cut one 22" long strand of yarn. Fold strand in half and, using crochet hook, draw center of strand through side edge of flap forming a loop. Pull free ends of strands through loop. In this manner, make fringe ½" apart along edges of flap.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
